Aligning KOB's work with West O Beer's mission to promote Lakes Area water quality efforts, "Blue Canoe" was a "no brainer" partnership, according to West O's owner Matt Matthiesen: "Keep Okoboji Blue's long-term vision and specific focus on the Okoboji area made for a natural partnership. Iowa Craft Brewing Benefits from 2022 State Legislation

Craft beverage entrepreneurs embrace greater business flexibility The Iowa Brewers Guild (IBG) is excited to announce the implementation of updates to state law supporting the Iowa craft brewing industry. The IBG supported the legislation, which was passed during the 2022 Iowa legislative session.

Governor Reynolds signed SF 2374 in early June and the Alcohol Beverages Division has released regulatory guidance allowing for its implementation. SF 2374 made several changes to Iowa law, including a reduction in licensing fees, easing restrictions on Iowa breweries to allow them more flexibility in the types and strengths of beers they can brew, and allowing native breweries the option to serve spirits in their taprooms under a new, consolidated license.

"Our member breweries are entrepreneurs in cities and small towns across the state. Flexibility and creativity are keys to growth in a challenging economic climate," said Noreen Otto, executive Director of the IBG. "Our breweries are grateful that the state of Iowa is moving in the right direction to allow our industry to grow and in turn, help our Iowa communities grow."

The new law also expands distribution rights to brew pubs to allow them to sell directly to customers for home consumption. Under this new law, Iowans can buy a craft beverage they love directly from the brewery that made it.

Formed in 2007, the Iowa Brewers Guild is an organization working to showcase and improve the quality of beer brewed in Iowa, foster communication among the state's brewers, advocate for the promotion of the local brewing community, and lobby for progressive changes in Iowa laws to benefit the craft brewing industry in the state. More than 100 members are located in communities across Iowa.

Texans take New Food prize

While Spencer's annual Clay County Fair has always been recognized as one of the largest Ag expositions in the country, entertainment and food have always helped bring large crowds, too. Saturday and Sunday's nearly perfect opening day weather helped hold the crowds all day and into the evening. The surprise of the day came only after the winning entry, in the World's Greatest County Fair New Food Contest was announced after a panel of local judges agreed that roasted corn sold by Ormic Concessions, of Brownsville, Texas, (which has three stands at the Fair) was Top New Food of the Year. While Ormic representative Rene Lerma was grateful for the award, it was several minutes afterward that he returned to the stage to let spectators in the Northwest Bank tent know that he forgot to mention that award-winning product was in fact Iowa Corn! That announcement drew a round of applause just before the Iowa-Iowa State football game got underway with viewers watching on big screens in the Midway Stage.

With the Clay County Fair closing this weekend comes an end to what we called the summer months -- some hotter, some colder, some wetter, some dryer than others. Not only will the weather change, but there will be fewer music events in the cooler months ahead after a summer of fun.

The Little Swan Lake Winery is still planning three music performances each week, on Thursdays, Saturdays and Sundays, with the Thursday and Saturday events running from 6-8:00, and Sunday shows running from 4-6:00 -- unless otherwise noted. This week and next will see Tanner Peterson appearing on Thursday, the 15th; *Duo Republic* on Saturday, the 17th, and *Dave & Ryan* on Sunday, the 18th. Sounds Fishy will be back on stage Thursday, the 22nd, while Adam and Jacob will return on Saturday, the 24th. Sunday, the 25th will put The South 71 Trio back on stage, followed by Chris Bertrand, who will close out the month of September on Thursday, the 29th...

In case you have yet to get the word, the Pearson Lakes Art Center's postponed Patsy Cline tribute show will take place on October 13th. Tickets for the postponed show purchased at the PLAC will be honored for this performance. With several days still on the calendar before the Clay County Fair ends there are a few good concerts -- after two nights of car races, tonight and Wednesday night, Vanilla Ice will take the Grandstand Stage at 7:30 with The Ying Yang Twins as special guests. Dwight Yoakam will take the stage on Friday night at 7:30, along with special guest *Runaway June*. Saturday will see Grand Funk Railroad & Blue Oyster Cult in the final musical event in the grandstand for the 2022 edition of the Clay County Fair.

The free stages have had some really good shows this year. And the free entertainment will continue though Sunday's closing.

The Farmers Bank stage will be hosting ventriloquist David Malmberg in rotation with *The Looney Lutherans* through Thursday, while the dueling pianos of Deully Noted will rotate with Country/ Bluegrass singer, songwriter/ artist Becky Schlegel through Sunday.

The Northwest Bank stage will have *Divas through the Decades* rotating with A Spoonful of Love -- in tribute to Lovin' Spoonful, The final three days of the Fair will have a '50s and '60s Rock Group, The Holy Rocka Rollaz rotating with The B2Wins, featuring Music and More! After last Tuesday's Veteran's program, pianist Glenn Henriksen will present a community worship service at 9:00 Wednesday morning in the Eurocast Ballroom.

According to research director RD, today is Positive Thinking Day, for which she immediately thought of lyrics from a Howard Dietz-Arthur Schwartz song:"When there's a Shine on your shoes, It's a wonderful way to start the day." Over the years their 1932 song has been recorded by Fred Astaire, Mel Torme, Sammy Davis, Jr., Tony Bennett, and most recently, by Jane Monheit, on her simply titled Home CD.

It was September 15, 1951, when Gentlemen Prefer Blondes closed on Broadway after more than 700 performances. The best remembered songs from the show included *Diamonds are a Girl's Best Friend*, written by Leo Robin and Jule Styne, and most famously on stage by Carol Channing, though Marilyn Maye has said she sang the song on stage more than anyone else. The most recent recordings include those by Susannah McCorkle, in 1985, and Nikki Parrott, in 2013...

Looking ahead a week to September 20th, RD cites that day as the day in 1922 that Myrtle Audrey Arinsberg was born in Philadelphia. After someone convinced her that with a name like that she'd have a hard time in the public eye, and the Lady's name became a much better known Gogi Grant, who had multiple hit records, including Suddenly There's a Valley, followed by Andy Williams, as well as her chart topping 1955 hit, The Wayward Wind, which has been re-recorded by at least 80 other singers, including Iowa's Everly Brothers, Connie Francis, and Crystal Gayle.

While RD has a couple more gems ready to go this week, we will hold back a few of special Iowa interest 'til the end of the month....





















New Pastor at New Testament Baptist







The newest addition to the West O menu is brick oven pizza. They offer 6 varieties of 12" pizzas on their menu, or you can build your own. They are prepared fresh in the new pizza kitchen and come out very quickly. It's a nice compliment to the beer. I tried the Queen (red sauce, fresh mozzarella, roasted cherry tomatoes, fresh basil, Parmesan, and olive oil), and the Terrace Beach (red sauce, smoked gouda, portabella & shiitake mushrooms, Parmesan, arugula, and balsamic drizzle). I added fennel-chili sausage to my Terrace Beach pizza for an added kick. Both were delicious! It's an Ugly, Cyclone State! If you were not a fan of either Iowa or Iowa State, and watched the Cy-Hawk game on Saturday, you probably feel like offensive football was set back a century or so. If you are a Hawkeye fan, you for sure feel that way after watching the Iowa offense muster a mere 316 total yards of offense in their opening two games of the season; if you are an Iowa State fan, you suffered through the highs and lows of the game to watch your team end their six-game losing skid in the series with an ugly 10-7 win in front of another sold out crowd at Kinnick Stadium.

I've never seen a Cy-Hawk game where both fan bases had very little confidence that their team would win heading into the game. I think ISU fans felt like they had the better team, but after losing six games in a row to their rival, and some of those losses coming in very strange fashion, you didn't feel like this would be the year to end the streak with so many new ISU starters on both sides of the ball. The game couldn't have started better for Iowa, forcing an ISU three-and-out, and then blocking the ensuing punt. Iowa would recover at the ISU 16yard line, and then Leshon Williams would take it into the end zone from nine yards out for the first Hawkeye touchdown of the 2022 season, and a very quick 7-0 Iowa lead. The Cyclones would continue to do ISU vs Iowa things when running back Jirehl Brock fumbled into the Iowa end zone on a 2nd and goal play from the Iowa one-yard line. Iowa State finally got on the scoreboard with a 22-yard Jace Gilbert field goal late in the second quarter to trim the lead to 7-3. Delaware transfer Colby Reeter would then intercept a tipped Spencer Petras pass and return it to the Iowa 12-yard line, but in a battle of NW Iowa kids, Iowa's Cooper DeJean would intercept a Hunter Dekkers pass in the end zone and secure a 7-3 Iowa halftime lead.

The second half was much like the first with ISU moving the ball but not scoring, and Iowa going three-and-out with poor line and quarterback play but strong punting by Tory Taylor and their elite defense would help Iowa keep their lead. The Hawks appeared ready to put their cobra-hold on the game after another Lukas Van Ness blocked punt set up Iowa at the ISU 20-yard line, but this time the Hawks would act like ISU and fullback Monte Pottebaum fumbled at the goal line on a 2nd and goal play from the ISU one-yard line. What happened next was something that will go down in Cy-Hawk lore as "The Drive" as Dekkers would lead ISU on a 99-yard, almost 12-minute drive that would culminate with the game's only touchdown, an eightyard pass to star receiver Xavier Hutchison with 8:27 left in the game. Iowa State had a chance to salt the game away late but was unable to convert a 4th down play deep in Iowa territory, and gave Iowa one last chance to tie the game when they were called for offsides and excessive celebration after recovering what they thought was a game-winning fumble. Those penalties moved Iowa into field goal range, but fortunately for Cyclone Nation, Aaron Blom's 48-yard field goal sailed wide-left on the last play of the game.

This was a game that ISU dominated but allowed Iowa to hang around, much like the last two Cy-Hawk losses. The Cyclones outgained Iowa in total yards, 313-150; held a 38:45-21:07 time of possession edge and had 21 first downs to Iowa's 11, but thanks to two red zone turnovers and the two blocked punts, the 'Clones nearly gave away another Cy-Hawk game. Fortunately for ISU, Iowa turned the ball over for the first time in this series since 2015 with three of their own turnovers while again struggling mightily to move the football on offense. After two games, Iowa's offense ranks dead last (131st place) in total offense with just 158 yards per game, as well as dead last in scoring offense with just 7 points per game. Hawkeye QB Spencer Petras is playing with zero confidence, and I'm guessing the Kinnick Stadium boo-birds are not helping that confidence. While Petras has played very poorly, often overthrowing open receivers or hanging on to the ball too long, he's not the only one to fault for Iowa's offensive struggles. The Hawkeye offensive line, normally a strong unit under Kirk Ferentz, has been below-average the last two years, and with All-American center Tyler Linderbaum now in the NFL, you really see the line struggle this season. Iowa's receivers are also below Power 5 caliber, some of this is caused by injuries, and some by transfers as several key receivers left the program last year, I'm guessing because they saw how bad the offense would be again this season. I'm not sure what the fix is for Iowa, if backup Alex Padilla could help Iowa win, one would think the coaching staff would give him a look. Iowa's offensive scheme is archaic and teams are now able to load up to stop the running game because their passing game has absolutely zero threat to go downfield. If Iowa can't figure something out on offense soon, they will waste an elite defense and punter and probably finish with 6-7 wins (thankfully for Iowa the B1G West is not looking very strong). Iowa State is off to their first 2-0 start since 2012 and should be 3-0 heading into Big 12 play with a home game against Ohio on Saturday. While the Cyclones have a lot of things to clean up (punt blocking, turnovers), they showed a lot of promise on Saturday with a stout defense and potential stars on offense with running back Jirehl Brock rushing for 100 yards, wide receiver Xavier Hutchison netting 98 yards on 11 receptions and quarterback Hunter Dekkers showing off his strong and accurate arm. While I'm not ready to name the Cyclones as a potential Big 12 title contender, I do like where this team is heading, and feel pretty good about them winning at least 7-8 games this season. One thing I do know, it sure is nice to finally say, "It's a Cyclone State, baby!"







Preparing for African Swine Fever



Pork producers are concerned about foreign animal diseases, so recently a workshop was held to help producers begin preparing for a future outbreak

One of the diseases most concerning to swine producers is African Swine Fever (ASF). The disease used to be confined to Africa, where it is endemic, but from Africa it moved north infecting wild pigs and commercial swine production in Russia. A few years ago, it spread to China and has since infected Southeast Asia and much of Europe in the wild pig population. A little over a year ago the disease entered the Dominican Republic and Haiti. The rapid spread of this disease and the proximity to the continental U.S. has producers concerned.

It is also a concern for those of us that like to eat pork and bacon. The good news is that pig diseases are typically not people

diseases, and there is no human health concern regarding an outbreak of ASF. The meat will still be safe to eat. However, what will happen for pork consumers is likely price swings based on supply and demand. If ASF comes to the U.S., the pork sold to other countries will have to be consumed locally because other countries do not want to risk infecting their own swine. Exports won't resume until producers can show

that U.S. pork is ASF-free, or a country decides to open U.S. pork imports. At first, pork prices will likely be reduced because of the drop in pork exports; however, the longer it takes to eradicate the disease, the more difficult it will be to maintain a large supply of pork, which will likely cause pork prices to increase.

To respond to this challenge, the industry has been working on prevention, which includes verifying premises identification, enhancing biosecurity, and maintaining detailed records. There is a Swine Health Improvement Plan, abbreviated SHIP, that will be used by the industry to lessen the impact (https://iowaagriculture.gov/ ship). Additionally, dogs are currently used at airports to stop infected product from entering the U.S.

Still, two major risks are garbage feeding and foreign travel. Thankfully, most states have outlawed garbage feeding to swine or have specific rules for cooking garbage. However, in states with wild hog populations, this is still a concern as the animals may consume trash that has been thrown on the ground. Foreign travel is a risk because the virus is hardy. Travelers coming back from an infected country should disinfect their shoes and stay away from all swine including wild pigs for a minimum of 5 days.

Whatever is done to lessen the risk, it is impossible to eliminate the risk. If ASF breaks in the U.S., there is a plan in place to eradicate the disease as quickly as possible. A team from the United States Department of Agriculture will work with the Iowa Department of Ag and Land Stewardship, and producers will be asked to stop moving pigs for at least 72 hours, to depopulate infected pigs, and to have a disposal plan in place. Producers are encouraged to work with Extension to help them with preparation plans in case

"We are excited about our partnership with The Iowa Lakes Corridor Development Corporation to bring more affordable housing to the residents in Storm Lake," said Russ Dierenfield, group manufacturing director for Tyson Foods. "High costs can burden working families as well as the economic health of the region. Tyson is committed to helping our team members and the community in the best ways we can."

West Winds Townhomes will be developed by Brash LLC, consisting of four buildings with two units per building, totaling eight single-family dwellings. The townhomes each feature two bedrooms, two full baths, 1,250 square feet and

a two-car attached garage. These dwellings are estimated to start construction this month with a predicted completion date of July 2024.

Kading Properties is in the process of constructing Sunrise Pointe Phase II, a 170-unit housing development on the northeast side of Storm Lake. All units will be offered as market-rate rentals to ensure affordability by the community's workforce. Unit types will include both three-bedroom/one-bathroom and three-bedroom/two-bathroom floorplans, all with an attached garage. The project also includes a greenspace parkland which will be dedicated to the city for the enjoyment of the residents and other members of the Storm Lake community, as well as a walking trail that will run the north, east, and west sides of the pepublic multiuse trail on the south.

"Kading is grateful for the support we've received from the entire Storm Lake community for the housing project we currently have under construction, which will provide 170 new rental townhomes for local families," shared Carrie Woerdeman, CPM, Director of Development with Kading Properties. "The housing grant provided through partnership between the City of Storm Lake, Tyson Foods, and Iowa Lakes Corridor will help ensure the success of the project and is particularly impactful in this time of volatile material costs and supply chain uncertainty. Dickinson County Taxpayers Association Earmarks \$25,000 for Eurasian Watermilfoil Fight

Yesterday at its September Board of Directors meeting, the Dickinson County Taxpayers Association (DCTA) announced its intent to grant \$25,000 to the Iowa Department of Natural Resources in its efforts to combat Eurasian watermilfoil infestations in East Okoboji, Minnewashta, Upper Gar and Lower Gar lakes in Dickinson County.

The Iowa DNR had previously announced that it had found Eurasian watermilfoil in the Iowa Great Lakes region. This noxious and invasive weed can choke off a lake making it very difficult to navigate. The DNR has already begun herbicidal treatments in Upper Gar Lake and is seeking financial assistance from county resources to pay for treatments which are estimated to cost approximately \$335,000. Dickinson County, the State of Iowa, the Okoboji Protective-Association and the East Okoboji Lakes Improvement Corporation had previously assigned funds to the project.

Mark Sullivan, incoming president of the DCTA, stated, "This is one of the most serious attacks on the lakes area environment in decades. While we have witnessed the growth of Curly Leaf Pondweed and zebra mussels in recent years, Eurasian watermilfoil, if not stopped now, has the capacity to negatively and significantly impact tourism, sales tax revenue, and property values. That's why the DCTA is earmarking this significant contribution to the fight.'
