Murfee, a wonderful smaller dog, lived as a stray in Eastern Tennessee. He was rescued from the street by two nice women; despite all of their efforts to find his owner, no one came forward. They contacted fifteen shelters about him, but the answer was always, "No, we are full." They widened the search and finally a shelter said "yes." We were that shelter.

A heartbroken family appeared at our door with their elderly cat. Time had caught up with their old friend, but they could not afford for the cat to be euthanized by a veterinarian. We are the shelter that said we would accept the cat and they could be with him as he entered heaven.

The Danville Area Humane Society operates the public animal shelter under contract with the City of Danville and has done so since 1984.

Thousands of time each year, our answer is "yes." There is no waiting period, no denial for any companion animal, and no fee required.

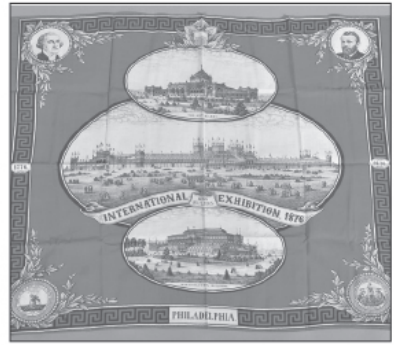

Centennial Exhibition

Nations, like people, have special parties and observances to celebrate birthdays and other successes. In 1876, the United States celebrated its 100th birthday with the Centennial Exhibition of 1876 in Philadelphia. There have been many other exhibitions and fairs, and some collectors specialize in souvenirs, posters and even pieces of buildings or exhibits from these important national events. Medals, photographs, postcards, even sugar packets and other special food-related items have been saved, as well as toys, books and clothing from the fairs, and they sell easily today. Many items, like this red cloth bandanna, had pictures of presidents Washington and Grant, images of some of the exhibition buildings and of course, the official name of the event. This bandanna souvenir sold at Conestoga Auction Co. for \$71. It can be stitched to a piece of unbleached muslin and framed as a picture (the stitching can be removed leaving it in nearly perfect shape), or it can be dry mounted and framed.

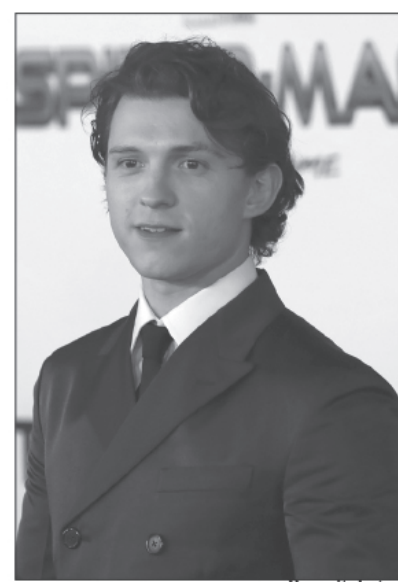

HOLLYWOOD — Move over, Tom Cruise, your aspirations to become a musical movie star at 60 are being challenged by 26-year-old Tom Holland (from the latest “Spider-Man” films). While Cruise hasn’t announced his project yet, Holland has committed to star in an untitled biopic on Fred Astaire. Unlike Cruise, who only toyed with singing in movies until he played a rock star in “Rock of Ages,” Holland portrayed the titular character in “Billy Elliot the Musical,” from 2008-2010 on stage in London. Ironically, Jamie Bell, who played the role of Billy Elliot in the 2000 film, is also set to star in an Astaire biopic for Amazon titled “Fred & Ginger.”

But, first, Holland has to deal with his mental health, admitting, “I find Instagram and Twitter to be overstimulating, to be overwhelming ... I spiral when I read things said about me online, and ultimately, it’s very detrimental to my mental state. So, I decided to take a step back and delete the app.” Social media was instrumental in catapulting his film “Uncharted,” with Mark Wahlberg (a \$120 million cost that lead to \$406.7 million grosses.) All this time, no one made a film about Fred Astaire, and now, there’s three in the works ... tap, tap, tap!

Bill Paxton was an amazing actor and a wonderful human being. Some of his most popular films were “Weird Science” (1985), “Aliens” (1986), “Tombstone” (1993), “True Lies” (1994), “Apollo 13” (1995), “Twister” (1996) and “Edge of Tomorrow” (2014). In early 2017, he entered Cedars-Sinai Medical Center to correct a damaged aortic heart valve caused by rheumatic fever that began at 14 years old. His family alleges the open-heart surgery was botched and caused him to suffer a fatal stroke on Feb. 25, 2017.

Paxton’s family sued the hospital, and a week before heading into a Los Angeles courtroom to decide the mat-

ter, Cedars settled for an undisclosed amount, which must have been more than the \$1 million that the anesthesiologist’s medical group paid them before their court date. The times I was fortunate to be in Bill Paxton’s company, he was cheerful, funny and an all-around regular guy who happened to be a movie star. It was a great loss.

In 1985, Paramount Pictures made a film based on the popular board game “Clue.” Despite casting some of the best comedic talents of the day — like Eileen Brennan, Tim Curry, Madeline Kahn, Christopher Lloyd, Michael McKean, Martin Mull and Lesley Ann Warren — the film fell short \$400,000 of recouping its \$14.6 million cost. Now, a remake of “Clue” is in the works, starring Ryan Reynolds. Will the creators improve on the screenplay of the original, or are they “Clue-less?”

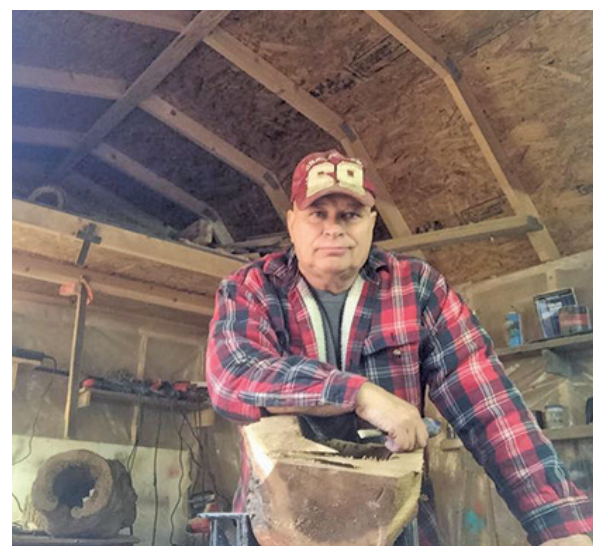

Animals Seized in Abandoned Pets Case

Upon arriving at a home in Callands for possible abandoned pets on September 6, officers from Pittsylvania County Animal Control and the Sheriff's Office discovered animals inside and outside the residence. The animals are currently in the care of the team at the Pittsylvania Pet Center, and we will announce when they are available for viewing and adoption. The Pet Center continues to operate normally and remains open to the public during this time.

Pittsylvania County Animal Control and the Pittsylvania County Commonwealth's Attorney are continuing the investigation.

David Malcolm Owen

OCTOBER 3, 1952 – AUGUST 17, 2022



David Malcolm Owen, born October 3, 1952, in Danville, Virginia, passed away on August 17, 2022, surrounded by family at Jennifer Moreno Department of Veterans Affairs Medical Center in La Jolla, California, after battling a staph

infection. He was born to parents Richard Howard Owen and Ruth Barton Owen of Danville, Virginia. "Rook," as his siblings affectionally called him, enjoyed playing baseball, fishing and was an avid hunter. He usually hunted squirrels and rabbits, bringing his bounties home so Mama could cook them. As a teen, he worked in a sawmill for Mr. John Albright, his employer and mentor. Mr. Albright helped fill the vacuum left by David's father, a much sought-after electrician, often absent from home to do the wiring for places such as the Pentagon and the Smithsonian Museums around the Washington D.C. area.

In June 1971, he volunteered to serve in the United States Navy at 18 with a friend in the "buddy program." The U.S. Navy wasn't his first choice of service. His goal was to join the U.S. Marine Corps, but his friend, on the other hand, wanted to join the U.S. Navy. So, they played Gin Rummy all night long with the idea that whoever won the most games by morning would join their preferred branch of service. He lost by a large margin, and both walked into the U.S. Navy recruiting office the following day and enlisted. For reasons unknown, his friend did not finish boot camp at Naval Station Great Lakes, but David made the U.S. Navy his career & family for over 20 years. After graduating from boot camp & advanced school, he was assigned to the USS Gurke DD-783 as a Sight Setter on a Five Inch, 38 Caliber gun. The USS Gurke saw combat during the Vietnam War, which included intense hostile fire throughout many of her naval gunfire missions and the destruction of several enemy gunboats & barges near the North Vietnam coast. His other duty stations included VFW 121 NAS Miramar CA, NAVSTA Subic Bay Republic of Philippines, USS Ranger CV-61, AFP Subic Bay Republic of Philippines, USS Okinawa LPH-3, Security Department NAS Miramar CA, and lastly, USS Merrill DD-976.

Upon retiring from the U.S. Navy, he continued his public service by joining the U.S. Customs and Border Protection (CBP) in San Diego, California. During his time with CBP, he became an expert on exporting items from the U.S. to foreign nations. Both officers and management personnel routinely sought his advice on general, military, export zones, and warehouse inspections. His proficiency as an inspector routinely captured prohibited items and detected illegal activities. His effectiveness helped amass millions of dollars in fines and penalties collected from these unlawful transactions, which resulted in numerous awards & accolades throughout his law enforcement career. His coworkers warmly called him "Chief," the last rank he held in the U.S. Navy. Chief retired in 2020 after more than 49 years of combined federal service.

David is a son, brother, father, stepfather, grandfather, and great-grandfather. However, the title he most enjoyed was being called the husband to his dear wife of 18 years, Joan Owen, whom he immensely loved. The union between these two brought him more than vigor, companionship & comfort. It brought him an endearing peace in the later part of his life. During one of the last moments of his life, he repeatedly reminded Joan that he loved her very much and would be home soon. David never made it back to his residential home but instead went onto his permanent home within the heavenly kingdom of The Lord God Almighty. "And I heard a great voice out of heaven saying, Behold, the tabernacle of God is with men, and he will dwell with them, and they shall be his people, and God himself shall be with them, and be their God. And God shall wipe away all tears from their eyes; and there shall be no more death, neither sorrow, nor crying, neither shall there be any more pain: for the former things are passed away." Revelations 21:3-4.

David is preceded in death by both his parents. However, he is survived by his beautiful wife Joan Owen, his former wife Teresita O'Farrell, his sons Richard, John, and Tony, his stepsons Charlie & Phillip, stepdaughter Gloria, and numerous grandchildren & a great-grandson. In mourning is his brother Michael "Switch" Owen and sister Judy Owen of Virginia. Also in mourning are his brother Gary Owen & his wife Susan of North Carolina, and many nephews & nieces. Miramar Memorial Services held David's services on September 12th and his burial took place at Miramar National Cemetery on September 13th.

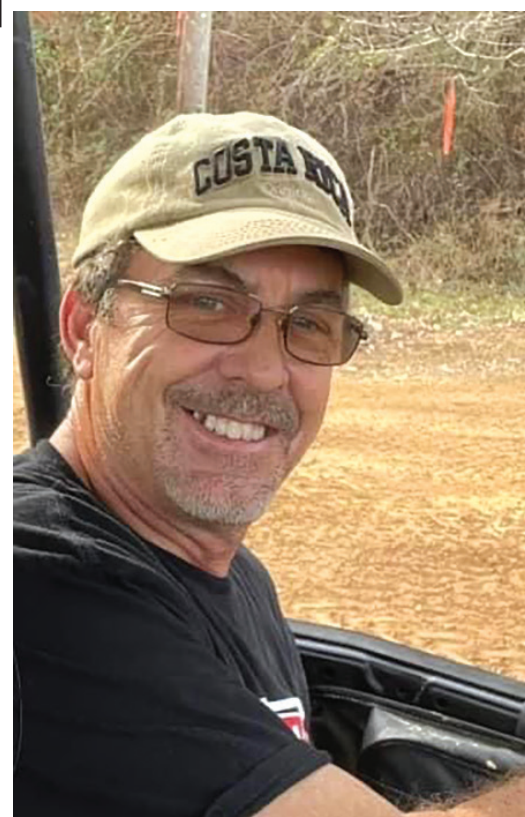

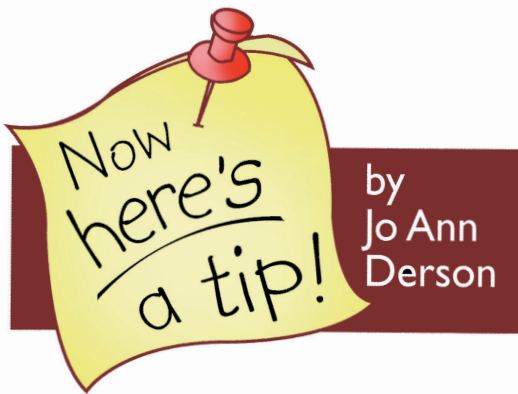

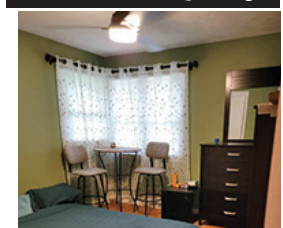

PUMPKIN CRISP



INGREDIENTS

- Pumpkin Filling
- 1 (15-oz.) canned pumpkin purée

(Can also beat with a hand mixer until crumbly if needed.) 3 Spread cinnamon streusel topping on top of pumpkin pie mixture in an even layer. 4 Bake until filling is set and top is golden brown, 40 to 45 minutes. 5 Let cool for 10 minutes, then serve warm topped with Homemade Vanilla Ice Cream.

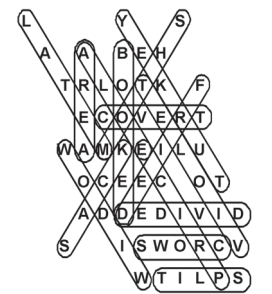

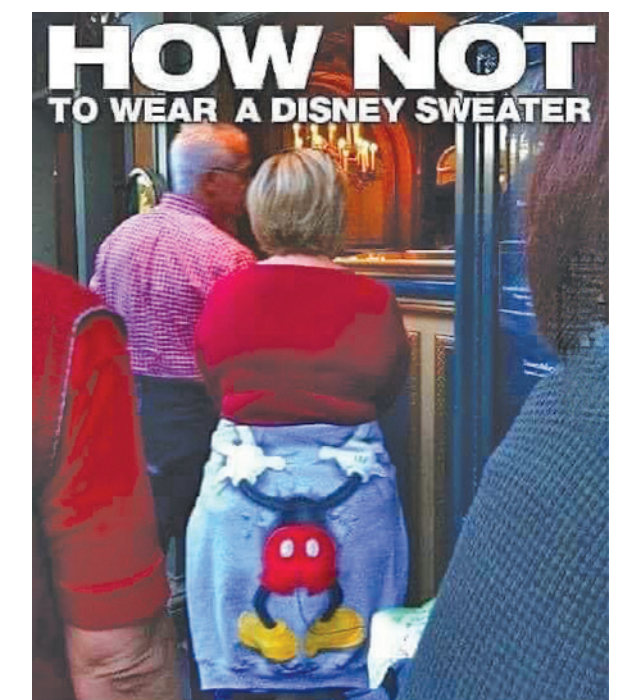
