"One World - One Week - One Festival" You Be the Judge!




Day each year and runs for nine days.


Michael Lorrain Noteboom was born September 27, 1929,









Cyclones Setup September Showdown Those of us who are Iowa State fans are well-aware of the fantastic job that head coach Matt Campbell has done in turning around this program; we are also aware of his September struggles, as before this season Campbell's September record at ISU was just 7-12 before the Cyclones would turn things around in "Brocktober" (not sure what we'll call that this year). Campbell got the Iowa monkey off his back last week when his team defeated the Hawkeyes in Kinnick Stadium for his first win over the in-state rivals, and now Cyclone fans hope that his September fortunes continue to turn around with the team's first


at Jack Trice Stadium on Saturday. Iowa State did what you should do to an inferior team on Saturday, starting fast with a 69-yard scoring drive on their first series that ended with Hunter Dekkers running it in the endzone from 6-yards out. ISU would score on four of their first five possessions to take a convincing 30-3 lead into halftime. The Cyclones would once again get a tremendous performance from their defense that included interceptions from Anthony Johnson and Colby Reeter, and another strong outing from Dekkers (268 yards, 4 total TDs) and his strong supporting cast that includes star receiver Xavier Hutchinson (9 catches, 93 yards and a TD) and a host of running backs who totaled 163 rushing yards. There were still things for this staff to be concerned about as special teams had another kick blocked, this time a PAT after an explosive touchdown reception from Sean Shaw, and the defense was sloppy in their tackling at times, especially in the second half. I have a feeling this is just what Campbell and his staff wanted, a dominant win and yet some things to keep the attention of this young team in the film room on Sunday.

Things will get much tougher for the Cyclones as #17 Baylor will come to Jack Trice on Saturday for an 11AM ESPN2 Big 12 opener. Baylor won the Big 12 Championship last year, and is a preseason favorite to repeat this year. The Bears started the year in the Top 10 before losing a 2OT thriller at #21 BYU in Week #2. ISU will have to clean things up in their special teams to beat teams like Baylor and the rest of the Big 12, as the conference looks very solid from top to bottom. The Cyclones were lucky that their two blocked punts at Iowa led to only seven points, and that their blocked extra-point on Saturday didn't matter much with their 33-point victory, but at some point, those blunders will cost ISU a game they should win. Baylor will be the best team that Iowa State has faced so far this season, with a diverse offense and a very strong defense. I definitely like where this Cyclone team is headed with Dekkers leading a pass-first offense that also has a very strong running back group, and a defense that is currently #3 in the nation in yards per game given up and #8 in total defense. Let's hope the Cyclones can keep things rolling against Baylor and put their September struggles in the rear-view mirror!






A general location map of the proposal is shown above.



ILCC Students Receive Over \$535,00 in Scholarships

The Future Ready Iowa Last-Dollar Scholarship program has paid off big for Iowa Lakes Community College students by awarding \$536,627 to more than 270 students attending the Fall 2022 semester.

The Last-Dollar Scholarship fills tuition gaps not covered by other federal and state grants and scholarships for eligible applicants enrolled in qualifying programs teaching the skills needed in high-demand industries. As a result, graduates of these programs carry minimal student debt when they enter the workforce and typically obtain good-paying jobs.

"The Last-Dollar Scholarship is not need-based, so it is available to all students who qualify, but to be considered for the scholarship, students need to complete the FAFSA by the deadline. The Last-Dollar Scholarship has helped many students get their degree with minimal to no debt," said Stephen Pelzer, Director of Financial Aid at Iowa Lakes.

Iowa Lakes has seen a significant increase in students taking advantage of the Last-Dollar Scholarship, with an increase of over 50 students and \$140,000 more awarded compared to

recipients in the Fall 2021 term. "This year, we have more students than ever before qualifying for the Last-Dollar Scholarship. The numbers went up because more programs are eligible to receive scholarships, and students are taking advantage of the opportunity by completing


