

As a community member we have always appreciated your support and are honored to serve you. Anyone who was treated by the Kendall Fire Department EMS and/or transported via Kendall Ambulance can obtain copies of those records by calling 585-659-8082.





# **Private Mortgage Insurance**

Primary mortgage insurance, or PMI, protects lenders in the event that borrowers default on their primary mortage by ceasing to make payments, resulting in homes ending up in foreclosure. But all borrowers do not have to pay PMI. Typically, home buyers must make a 20 percent down payment on a home when they buy it. However, some borrowers are unable to put down 20 percent. In such instances, the lender will require they pay PMI. This is because the lender views a borrower who cannot make an initial 20 percent down payment as a riskier investment, and lenders charge PMI in an effort to protect themselves should the borrower prove worthy of their skepticism. 



- 2 medium sweet potatoes, peeled and diced
- 3 large russet potatoes, peeled and diced
- 1/2 tsp. kosher salt
- 1/2 tsp. dried rosemary leaves
- 1/4 tsp. dried thyme leaves 1/4 tsp. dried rubbed sage
- 1/4 tsp. dried marjoram
- 1/4 tsp. ground black pepper
- 1/4 tsp. pumpkin pie spice
- 1 tart apple, diced(and peeled if desired)

### Instructions

1. Heat a large skillet over medium high heat. When the skillet is hot, add 1 tsp. of olive oil, the

sliced chicken sausages, and the diced onion (if using). Saute 5-6 minutes until the sausages are browned and cooked through, stirring as needed to prevent sticking and burning. 2. Remove the sausages and onion from the skillet. Add the water and remaining 2 tsp of olive oil to the pan. Add the sweet potatoes and russet potatoes then sprinkle all of the seasonings (kosher salt through pumpkin pie spice) on top. Place a lid on the pan and cook for about 4-5 minutes or until the potatoes are softened. Remove the lid and cook for an additional 5-8



Pumpkin Chocolate Chip Oatmeal Cookies Makes 24

1 cup all-purpose flour, spooned and leveled 1 teaspoon pumpkin pie spice 1/2 teaspoon ground cinnamon

12 teaspoon ground chimation 12 teaspoon salt 11/2 cups old-fashioned rolled oats 12 cup unsalted butter, softened 12 cup packed light brown sugar 14 cup granulated sugar 13 cup pumpkin purce, squeeze out the excess moisture with paper towels 1 large egg yolk, at room temperature 1 teaspoon purc vanilla extract 1 cup semisweet chocolate chips

1. Preheat the oven to 350 F. Line two large baking sheets with parchment paper or silicone baking mats and set aside.

2. In a large mixing bowl, whisk together the flour, pumpkin pie spice, ground cinnamon, baking soda, and salt until well combined. Stir in the old-fashioned rolled oats and set aside.

3. In the bowl of a stand mixer fitted with the paddle attachment or in a large mixing bowl using a handheld mixer, beat the butter, brown sugar, and granulated sugar together for 1 to 2 minutes, or until well combined.

3. Return the sausage and onion to the pan along with the diced apple. Stir to combine and

cook for an additional 1-2 minutes or until the apples are warmed through and slightly softened.

4. Mix in the pumpkin puree, egg yolk, and vanilla extract until fully combined, making sure to stop and scrape down the sides of the bowl as needed.

5. Mix in the dry ingredients until just combined, then mix in the chocolate chips on low speed until fully incorporated.

6. Using a 11/2-tablespoon cookie scoop, scoop the cookie dough onto the prepared baking sheets, making sure to leave a little room between each one. Gently press each ball of cookie dough down to slightly flatten it.

7. Bake for 9 to 11 minutes, or until the tops of the cookies are set. Remove from the oven, and allow the cookies to cool on the baking sheets for 5 to 10 minutes; then carefully transfer the cookies to a wire rack to cool completely.

8. Store the cookies in an airtight container for up to 5 days.
