Travel Thoughts By Kim

Let's go on an adventure together...to Monaco



Cathedral of Our Lady of the Immaculate Conception (a.k.a. St. Nicholas Cathedral) in Monaco - the church where Grace Kelly married Prince Rainier III. They are both also buried in this cathedral in the Grimaldi family vault.

This is the fifth in a series of articles from a Mediterranean Adventure I took in August. This post will focus on the third port of the Mediterranean cruise portion of the trip – Monaco.

As a young girl with stars in her eyes and an intense curiosity about the glamorous lives of Hollywood movie stars, I couldn't help but be captivated by the life of American actress Grace Kelly. While in Cannes for the annual film festival, Grace met Monaco's Prince Rainier. The couple had a fairy tale romance that captured hearts world-wide and they were married in 1956, giving America a princess to call their own. Princess Grace was loved the world over and there are many references to her throughout Monaco. The couple had three children - Princess Caroline, Prince Albert, and Princess Stephanie. Princess Grace died in 1982 at the age of 52 from injuries from a car accident after suffering a stroke and losing control of her car. Her teenage daughter, Stephanie, was with her in the car. She suffered some head injuries, but survived the accident. Prince Rainier was heartbroken and never remarried. He died in 2005. The current Prince of Monaco is their son, Prince Albert, who took reign after his father's death. So, it should be no surprise that I chose a shore excursion that allowed me to enjoy a full day exploring Monaco - the home of Princess Grace. The port was Cannes, France and offered tours of Cannes, Nice, Monte Carlo, and Monaco with

some other options around that area of the French Riviera. When I saw a 7.5 hour "on your own" tour of Monaco, I got so excited. It was the port I looked most forward to and it ended up being my favorite port of the trip. Don't get me wrong - Tuscany is still a very close second, but Monaco stole my heart just as I knew it would! Monaco is the second smallest country after Vatican City. It is officially named the Principality of Monaco and classified as a sovereign city-state. Monaco is bordered by France on the north, east, and west and covers an area just shy of one square mile. Monaco City sits high up on a rock (known as the Rock of

(known as the Rock of Monaco) overlooking the French Riviera and the Mediterranean Sea. From inside the parking garage where the bus had to park,






we took two escalators, one elevator, and one more escalator to get up to Monaco City. To get to the parking garage, we drove through Monte Carlo, which is also part of Monaco and located at the base of the rock. Monte Carlo is, of course, famous for gambling and the Formula One Grand Prix road race. The bus driver let us know when we were at each of the critical points on the race circuit. There was a young fan on the bus, so the driver stopped at the starting point and took off making the sound of a race car gaining speed over the microphone! It was cool and definitely thrilled the young lad! I took in all the sites of Monaco City and Monte Carlo via a hop-on-hopoff tour. I also wandered around Monaco City and had blueberry crepes for lunch at a little outdoor café across from the Royal Palace. It was an extremely

hot day, but there was a beautiful breeze up on the rock and lots of shade, so it was actually very pleasant to walk around and enjoy the amazing little country. I saw the Monaco Oceanographic Marine Sciences Museum, where Jacques-Yves Cousteau was the museum director from 1957 to 1988 and where much of his work is housed. I also saw his little yellow submarine - that was cool! Other sights were the Prince's Royal Palace (with the absolute cutest palace guards ever), the cathedral where Grace Kelly married Prince Rainier and where they are both buried, quaint little market streets and courtyards, beautiful gardens, and some of the most amazing views from the top of the Rock of Monaco overlooking the Mediterranean Sea. It was a relaxing and picture perfect day that I will remember forever. What a thrill to be there and walk in Princess Grace's footsteps and see the impeccable beauty of the second smallest (and the most expensive and wealthiest) country in the world. 






David Snell, a downtown Albion mainstay, honored by Chamber for 'lifetime achievement'

ALBION - When David Snell was in college at Baldwin-Wallace University in Ohio, he majored in health and physical education. He was expecting to become a coach and lead teams in athletics. Snell played fullback for Baldwin-Wallace football team. He enjoyed playing that role for a team that was nationally ranked and won its conference championship. Snell also spent a lot of time with his father, Peter Snell, in Albion. The elder Snell started a real estate business in 1958. When he was a senior in college in 1978, contemplating his next move after Baldwin-Wallace, David decided to get his real estate license and return to Albion and work with his dad. His mother Irene also was in the business as the administrator of the office, and David's siblings - Peter, John and Sue - all worked there too. (Sue recently retired.) David has stayed in real estate in Albion for 44 years now. He has fulfilled his goal of building a successful team. "I have a very excellent staff," Snell said. What is body mass index?

People who are attempting to improve their physical fitness may hear a lot about body mass index, or BMI, and wonder just how important a good BMI is to their overall health. That can be hard to determine, especially for people who are unsure just what BMI measures. According to the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention, BMI is a person's weight in kilograms divided by the square of his or her height in meters. For those unfamiliar with the metric system, that explanation of BMI might not be too helpful.

So how is BMI used and what purpose does it serve? BMI might be most useful in a screening capacity, as the CDC notes it is an inexpensive and easily performed method of screening for weight category. For example, by calculating a patient's BMI, doctors can quickly determine if the patient is underweight, has a normal or healthy weight, or is overweight or obese.

Conditions associated with being overweight include heart disease and diabetes, so an easily calculated index determining if a person is overweight (or underweight or obese) can be an effective tool in combatting some potentially dangerous conditions. Medina HS Library Hosts Author Keely Hutton

Medina Junior-Senior High School recently played host to Keely Hutton.

Mrs. Hutton, a children's book author and former English teacher, has written three books: Soldier Boy, Secret Soldiers and Don't Look Back.

School librarian Jennifer O'Toole invited middle school and high schools students to hear Mrs. Hutton talk about

her new book, Don't Look Back and to discuss her writing process. Don't Look Back was written with Achut Deng and is her real-life story about surviving war, living in a refugee camp from the age of six to sixteen and her journey from South Sudan to America. Hutton and Deng spent many hours every week for 18 months talking over the phone for the memoir. Hutton lives in the Rochester area and Deng lives in South Dakota where she works in human resources at a meat-packing plant. The final product is a powerful story about the ugliness and beauty of humanity and the message about not giving up no matter what the obstacles.

Deng's story was first mentioned in a 2020 New York Times article. Her emotional story about her flight from the Sudan, immigrating to the US as part of the Lost Boys program and

with. She chose Hutton to collaborate with. Hutton told students that she had to research the Sudan and the period of time that her subject lived there. She also filled several notebooks from her Zoom calls and interviews with Deng. It was then she was able to get to the heart of the story and began writing.

Mrs. Hutton told students that all her books are based on the real lives of her subjects. She said that even though she did not have the same experiences as they did, she does experience the same emotions which helps her write from their point of view. "Looking for shared, universal emotions helps me to build an emotional bridge for me and my readers. If you want to write think back to your own experiences and connect those emotions to your subject."

Mrs. O'Toole also invited another guest Julie Berry, owner of the Author's Note Bookstore in Medina. Mrs. Berry helped to facilitate Mrs. Hutton's visit to the high school. She hosted a book signing for Don't Look Back this week for Mrs. Hutton.

Place the cornflour and 80ml (1/3 cup) coconut cream in a small bowl and stir to combine. Add to the slow cooker and cook, with the lid removed, for 10 minutes or until thickened. Step 4

Divide the curry among serving plates. Drizzle with some of the remaining coconut cream (see note). Serve with rice and topped with extra curry leaves.
