





LRH Announces New Vice President and Chief Nursing Officer



He also was a Nursing Supervisor on Disaster Response to Hurricane Katrina. He holds a Master of Science Degree in Nursing from Chamberlain University and a Bachelor of Science Degree in Nursing from the University of Iowa College of Nursing.


Be a Tourist in Your Backyard

Buckeyes Blast Hapless Hawkeyes

It didn't surprise many people on Saturday when #2 Ohio State blasted Iowa 54-10 in front of 104,000 fans at the Horseshoe in Columbus, Ohio. The Buckeyes entered the game as a 30-point favorite with one of the most prolific offenses in











the ball right back to the Buckeyes just two plays later with an interception. Ohio State would turn that pick into a Marvin Harrison touchdown, and the route was completely on. It was too bad for Padilla that his first action of the year had to come at the #2 team in the country with his team already trailing by 16, and the defense knowing they could just tee off on him. Not surprisingly, Padilla struggled, finishing the day 5-10 for just 32 yards with one interception and a lost fumble. Where Iowa goes from here is anyone's guess. It is a shame that they are wasting such an elite defense with such an incompetent offense. I feel horrible for Spencer Petras, as he's obviously shell-shocked and playing with zero confidence. Iowa's offensive schemes are archaic, and for some reason Coaches Ferentz (Brian and Kirk) refuse to make any adjustments. The most frustrating play for Iowa fans had to be the first play of the game where, after a bye week to scheme new formations and plays, Ferentz calls for his struggling QB to roll to the left (his non-throwing hand) and throw a predictable pass to Iowa's only threat, tight end Sam LaPorta. Ohio State had two defenders sitting on the play and Petras threw it right to linebacker Tanner McCalister. The Hawkeyes should win their next game with 1-6 North-BLOODY western coming to Kinnick Stadium on Saturday, but after that Iowa will probably be an underdog the rest of the season. The

Iowa and Northwestern offenses are so inept that the opening under for the game was 31.5, which would be an all-time low in college football odds. I'm not going to beat a dead horse, as

happen to Kirk Ferentz, but he needs to take a long look in the

mirror this off-season and make some drastic offensive changes or Iowa will be in the same boat next season, and that boat looks


an awful lot like the Titanic!

we've talked plenty about Iowa's atrocious offense, but here are a few numbers that show just how historically bad they are; they are dead last in yards per game in the NCAA, they have not scored a touchdown on 28 straight drives; in B1G play they have scored only three touchdowns, which is matched by their defense, and their offense has scored just 42 points this year while their **BOGO FREE** special teams and defense have scored 56 points. Sadly, there is no quick-fix for this offense, the QB room is obviously low **BLOODYS & MIMOSAS** on talent, the offensive line is really struggling, and the offense is so predictable with their formations and personnel. I hate to ever call for a coaching change, and don't believe anything will



I am Colleen Lemkuil, a retired nurse, and I am up in the night remembering the night I assisted with a Dilation and Curettage. I am 79 years old and in 1964 at the hospital in Sioux City, Iowa I was on call to assist in any surgeries during the 11 PM to 7 AM shift at the hospital where I was in nurse's training. I get the call to go to the hospital and found only one small light on in the surgery room with no windows. Here was one of my favorite doctors and an anesthetist with a young woman about my age. She was a family friend of the doctor who came with her to the hospital to do the D & C which only takes five minutes, and to do to repair with stitches her cuts. I am a Christian and recently talked to a Methodist minister visiting our home. He too said he had helped with an abortion on a 14 year old girl impregnated by her father. He believes and says the Bible says you are not a child until the day you are born.

4.4 million pregnancies happen in the United States each year and 1 million of them end in miscarriages. When is it a miscarriage and when is it an abortion? Leave all this up to the doctors, nurses, surgical technicians, anesthetists and to the patient and her family. I have talked to Admiral Michael Franken who believes in good maternity care, birth control and fewer needs for abortions.

Divide the batter evenly between the prepared cake pans. Bake until the cakes bounce back, 30-40

minutes. Let cool completely in the pans. For the frosting and decorations: Heat the cream in a double boiler over low heat, whisking until it begins to steam. Whisk in the cocoa powder, chocolate, espresso powder, vanilla, and salt until it's smooth. Whisk in the butter then the confectioners' sugar until incorporated. Let the frosting cool. To assemble put one cake, bottom-side up, on a serving plate. Spread 1 cup of the frosting over the top. Top with the other cake, bottom-side up, and frost the top and sides with the remaining frosting. Microwave the marshmallows about 1 minute. Let sit a few minutes until cool enough to touch. Spray your hands with cooking spray. The Dickinson County **Board of Supervisors' Purchase of a NEW Public Safety Radio System**

FACTS about Dickinson County's proposed move to the Iowa Statewide Interoperable **Communications System (ISICS)**

- Moving to the Iowa Statewide Interoperable Communications System (ISICS) provides the best solution to the two biggest challenges to our current radio system has: Coverage and Capacity.
- The new system will provide countywide portable radio coverage on ALL talkgroups/channels. With our current radio system, no single channel can provide countywide coverage and we do not have uniform coverage between the different channels.
- The proposed system is public safety-grade communications technology that is already being used by many other jurisdictions in Iowa and this type of system as a whole is being used by many other states.
- Dickinson County is growing in terms of both population and calls for service. We need a radio system that can grow with us and will serve our needs for many years to come.
- The equipment we purchase remains the property of Dickinson County. It does NOT become the property of the State of Iowa.
- While the State owns and maintains the system core and several of their own tower sites, we have local control over our equipment and the setup and use of our own talkgroups.
- The proposal provides new radios to all Law Enforcement, Fire, and EMS personnel, replacing dozens of radios that are past end-of-life and can no longer be serviced.
- In addition, all schools in Dickinson County will receive radios for their buses and other vehicles, all of which will work with the radios they're receiving from the State through the Governor's School Safety Initiative. This will provide total interoperability between public safety and our schools.
- Public Works and local Utility Companies can join the system if they choose to invest in new radios — and we encourage them to do so.
- Every radio from every entity in Dickinson County that is using this system will have a set of common talkgroups in their radios ensuring that everyone can communicate when the need arises.
- If we do not join the state's radio system, we will still have to spend a great deal of money to replace our aging radios (both infrastructure-related equipment and all the radios being used by responders) and this would still not completely fix the coverage or capacity issues that we have.
- From Montgomery County, Iowa, who recently joined the ISICS system: "We've had too many good results locally...to name, I will say it's amazing...having a large mutual aid response and being able to talk to EVERYONE and have EVERYONE on the same talkgroup(s) or access to the same talkgroup(s)."
- From Arnolds Park/Okoboji Fire Chief Chris Yungbluth: "I was concerned about the change but we had a recent response in Minnesota and observing how the similar Minnesota State Radio system works I was impressed by the capabilities and interoperability of their systems across multiple agencies present on that scene. The capabilities demonstrated on that scene cemented my support for the changes being proposed to the Dickinson County Public Safety Radio System."
- From Michael Ehret, Dickinson County Emergency Management: "At a fire last winter on Little Spirit Lake, the Spirit Lake Fire Chief was trying to call dispatch from his portable radio on our main fire channel, the tower for which was 7.8 miles away. Dispatch was not able to understand him because the signal was too poor. I tried my portable radio, using the ISICS system and operating off a tower near Estherville, 13.7 miles away, and was heard loud and clear. This is just one example that clearly illustrates the difference between our current system and what ISICS can provide our public safety community."
- The leaders from all of Dickinson County's police, fire, and EMS departments were unanimous in the decision to pursue joining ISICS.
- We have letters of support from: Arnolds Park/Okoboji Fire Dept., City of Arnolds Park, City of Lake Park, City of Milford, City of Okoboji, Dickinson County Communications Center, Spirit Lake Fire Dept., Spirit Lake Police Dept., and the City of Terril.
- Our first responders have several tools at their disposal for the many different types of calls they respond to. There is only one tool, however, that is used by every single responder, at every single call. That tool is their radio. The radio is their lifeline, and it **MUST** work...every time, and everywhere.

What Happened to My Ornamental Corn?

by Beth Ellen Doran, Iowa Master Gardener and Beef Specialist Most fellow gardeners said 2022 was a hard year to garden The year started off dry and cool and continued dry, except with heat and wind. This made for tough growing conditions, and my ornamental corn is proof of this.

I started with high hopes of producing about a dozen colorful ears for fall decorations, but mother nature didn't quite cooperate. In August, I spied an ear with white growths (galls) which an Extension specialist diagnosed as common smut. The causal agent is the fungus Ustilago maydis.

Galls are abnormal fungal growths that can appear anytime throughout the growing season. They are especially active in young growing tissue (ears, leaves, stalks, and

tassels). The galls initially appear as white- to silver-growths, but later turn black as fungal spores develop inside the galls. What conditions favor common smut? It is usually most

severe when young tissue is wounded by hail, wind, or insects. The fungus typically infects corn ears via the silks when there are poor pollination conditions. Infection is favored by warm weather (79-93° F) and moderate rainfall. Hot, windy weather prevailed when my corn was pollinating. Once galls have formed, there is no



treatment. They should be removed and destroyed by burning or burying before they burst to prevent the spores from spreading and overwintering. Fungicides are ineffective in controlling common smut. The

disease is best managed by planting a resistant variety, avoiding plant injury, and rotating the garden crops.

Luckily only one ear had common smut, but heat stress affected the other ears. Heat stress during silking and pollination can interfere with successful pollination and reduce photosynthesis. Both may increase kernel abortion on the tip of the ear (called "tip back") and a reduction in the number of kernels on the ear. However, heat stress can also reduce kernel size.

At any rate - whether my ornamental corn is perfect or not, I will chalk 2022 up to experience. I disposed of the infected ear and plan to decorate with the "normal" ears. And for those that are not perfect, I'm sure the squirrels will enjoy feasting on them!







October 1st, 1955, saw the premier of the CBS Television series, *The Honeymooners*, staring Jackie Gleason, Art Carney, Audrey Meadows, and Joyce Randolf. The show's theme song, You're My Greatest Love, was written by Bill Temple-

man and Jackie Gleason, who was also a terrific orchestra leader! The theme was included in Gleason's 1958 Capitol LP, Music to Change Her Mind. The issue also includes two Arthur Schwartz and Howard Dietz songs, *Dancing in the Dark*, and **You and the Night** and the Music...

Be sure to remember to set your clock(s) back one hour when you turn off the lights on Saturday night. That'll let you get back that hour of sleep you lost last spring when you set your clock ahead one hour.

Last, but not least, One of RD's prized possessions is the car she calls Penny Lane. Yes, a reference to The Beatles' song. Some true genius has now instituted a legitimate Name Your Car Day, placing RD way ahead of the pack, even though she was not the first to name a car. 

Novel takes aim at Big Ag

As the saying goes, art imitates life. One could say Sandy Moffett's entertaining and enlightening novel, The Ghost of Craven Snuggs, has a whole lot of life to it.

Moffett, emeritus professor of theatre at Grinnell College in Grinnell, Iowa, has taken aim at vertically integrated Big Ag like triple-ought buckshot on an Iowa pheasant.

The story begins when Craven Snuggs'house and barn mysteriously burn to the ground. Just before he enters his barn to save his horses, Snuggs says prophetically, "You ain't seen the last of me." The flaming barn then collapses with Snuggs presumably still inside.

We segue to a series of missing portraits of the owners of multi-level livestock corporations - Hubert Wooten, James Schittman and Donald Birdseed. Two of the own-

ers, Wooten and Schittman, are later found half-eaten in hog confinements they own with their portraits hanging nearby Birdseed is discovered floating inside a bundle of garbage in a sewage lagoon. Co-incidents?

Maybe not.

What really turns up the heat on the case is the governor's missing portrait. He naturally believes he will follow the same fate.

With the governor commandeering the entire state's law enforcement team for his personal protection, it falls on smalltown sheriff Patrick Kavanaugh to solve the murders. Since his department is limited to a secretary and a pair of easily confused identical twins named Phil and Bill, Kavanaugh hires an unlikely trove of deputies, including Shawn Gallagher, former ag professor infamous for his demonstrations against Big Ag, including an appearance before a public hearing in a pig suit. Gallagher, incidentally, is the initial prime suspect in the murders.

Gallagher soon exonerates himself, though, as do the trophy-wife widows of the three corporate executives who seem more than happy to be shed of their husbands and inherit their

Still, the murders remain unresolved. As suspect after suspect is crossed off the pictures on Kavanaugh's wall, the only remaining suspect is Snuggs' ancient International pickup that seems to have appeared then disappeared at each crime scene.

Moffett's criticism of corporate agriculture is laced with gut-wrenching humor. Those unfamiliar with Iowa's ag policy will find the novel both entertaining and enlightening. Those who understand the DNR's Master Matrix that evaluates animal confinements will cringe at how closely Moffett has come to his target. Those involved in vertically integrated agriculture might have an entirely different take on the book.

This year, Menning and his construction students have taken on their largest building project to date by building a duplex for Emmetsburg Community Development Corporation (ECDC). So far, Hansen Quality Concrete, the owner of which is an Iowa Lakes Construction Technology graduate, has completed the concrete for the floors, garages, and

Seven full-time first-year students and three Career Academy high school students earning dual credit (by working two hours a day) have completed the framing of the walls and will be moving on soon to sheathing the walls and installing roof trusses.

"My students will be able to learn hands-on how the different tools and brands feel, which ones work best for them and learn about the price points of different tools, allowing them to make informed decisions before purchasing tools for their future businesses. These tools are a huge gift for our program,"

shared Menning. Students will learn all the skills needed to work in residential construction by the time the project is complete in May 2023. Skills learned will include wall and roof framing, concrete, exterior finishing, window installation, interior finishing, cabinetry installation, interior doors and trim installation, and the soft skills needed when speaking with customers.
