

Northport, AL, they'll be hitting the fishery at one of the best times of the year.

The field will include 2021 B.A.S.S. Nation champion and current Elite Series pro, Matty Wong. There will also be representatives from

nine foreign countries, 48 states, and Paralyzed Veterans of America Angler of the Year, Kurt Glass. All of the boaters will have one goal during the three-day event: land in the Top 3 to qualify for the 2023 Academy Sports + Outdoors Bassmaster Classic, scheduled for March 24-26 in Knoxville.

The B.A.S.S. Nation champion will earn the title of "Nation's Best," which includes an Elite Series berth and the use of a fully-rigged Nation's Best tournament boat for a year. The second and third place finishers and the nonboater champion will each earn paid entry fees for all divisions of the St. Croix Bassmaster Opens Series presented by Mossy Oak Fishing.

Pickwick Lake hosted the Nation Championship back in 2020. Since then it has been the site of two Bassmaster Elite Series events, with Brandon Lester hoisting a blue trophy earlier in 2022 with a four-day total of 86 pounds, 1 ounce.

While the famous ledges of the Tennessee River impoundment won't likely play a factor, there will be plenty of water for anglers to explore. The biggest key will be finding the bait, according to Hamner. "The bait is going to be pushed up shallow and you are going to see a lot in the backs of pockets and in the little bays, but the tailrace is going to be huge." With major flooding during the 2021 Elite, the tailrace at the Wilson Dam was a major factor. For the Nation Championship, Pickwick Lake will be in a drawdown phase as the Corp of Engineers tries to get the lake to winter pool, and that will allow for awesome tailrace fishing.

Look for anglers to target eddies behind boulders, logs and little islands with a variety of different baits including walking topwater baits, bigger swimbaits and spinnerbaits.

That also means smallmouth will once again be a factor, and Hamner said an angler could potentially win with only smallmouth.

"This time of year, the smallmouth start playing a role again," he said. "In the summer, they turn into ghosts for some reason. But now they are up there feeding and getting ready. You

can have 22 or 23 pounds of smallmouth. It is very possible."

The last few years, hydrilla and milfoil have played a big factor on Pickwick, but Hamner has noticed there isn't a vast amount of either grass in the lake this year. If he has caught bass around grass, it has been eelgrass.

That will make flats with stumps and shallow, hard-bottom river bars more productive as long as there's bait present.

Competitors will launch from McFarland Park each day at 6am and return for weigh-in at 2pm.

The full field will compete the first two days. The nonboater champion will be crowned after Day 2 and the Top 10 boaters, Top 2 boaters from each of the five regions (if not already in the Top 10), the nonboater champion and any nonboaters that have enough weight to be in the Top 10 boaters overall will advance to the championship round.

The 2022 TNT Fireworks B.A.S.S. Nation Championship is being hosted by Florence-Lauderdale Tourism.

A Disturbing Movement Picks Up Steam on Left

Voting has long been one of the privileges of American citizenship, but perhaps not for much longer. Left-wing activists are going all-in with their demands to let noncitizens vote, and Washington, D.C., just took up the charge.

The D.C. City Council advanced a bill to let anyone vote in local elections, regardless of citizenship and immigration status, as long as they live in the city for just 30 days.

The measure is so extreme, even the reliably liberal *Washington Post* editorial board called it “radical.”

If Washington, D.C. Mayor Muriel Bowser signs the Local Resident Voting Rights Amendment Act of 2022, an estimated 50,000 noncitizen residents—including those here illegally—would be free to cast ballots in local elections.

But that’s not all. As the *Post* pointed out,

Censorship? Why?

Last month I wrote to Congressman Mo Brooks requesting his vote to fund the Peace Corps. He sent a strange reply.

The purpose of this open letter is to raise the subject again with hopes his staff will take note, and to seek information about ongoing censorship of congressmen. I could not find any.

If you died today, according to the Bible would you be in heaven or hell forever?



IN MY LAST EXCITING INSTALLMENT, I EXPRESSED MY FRUSTRATION at an unnamed local bank for allowing the transfer of \$60,000 out of my client's online bank account directly into the hands of scammers via Western Union. Western Union is the undisputed king of aiding and abetting scammers. In 2017, Western Union settled a consumer fraud case with the Justice Department and Federal Trade Commission and forfeited over a half-billion dollars in refunds to victims of fraud. Millions of victims have gotten all of their money

back. Western Union agreed to implement anti-fraud programs designed to protect consumers from scammers. They are obviously not holding to the agreement.

On top of the ineptitude exhibited by Western Union in protecting my client, the unnamed local bank shares much of the blame, too. Banks have the technology to alert a bank employee of unusual transactions from a retail client—especially one involving Western Union. Of course, I understand that banks have

an obligation to move money rapidly at a client's request but, doggonit, it would have been so easy for someone at the bank to receive a beep on their computer alerting them that a local client wants to transfer thousands of dollars to a company known for aiding and abetting scammers. They failed.

So what can you do if you or a loved one happens to fall for a bank scam? Here are a few tips that you should keep in mind.

First, complain everywhere as soon as possible and provide

as much documentation as possible. If you're a victim of a computer scam, turn your computer off until a technician can look at your computer. Then call your bank, the local police (who generally won't be interested but call them anyway), and the FBI. Time is of the essence. Gift card companies, the FBI, the FTC, the Postal Service, and others are looking out for scammers and may have methods to block the victim's payment to the scammer or assist the victims in recovering money. But none of this can happen unless the victim issues a complaint with the appropriate entity, and you won't know who the appropriate entity is until you start complaining.

The government has a Consumer Financial Protection

Bureau (CFPB) that has a victim recovery fund that can be used to compensate victims of fraud. But, again, victims need to act fast. Even "cash card" fraud victims can get the funds reversed under some circumstances.

I really need much more column space to explain all the ways that victims can get help, but the main thing to know is that, if you become a victim, help is available -- but only to those who ask for it.



ASK THE ATTORNEY WILL CONTESTS

Ask the Attorney is sponsored by local attorneys, McCutcheon & Hamner, PC, as a service to the residents of NW Alabama.

Will contests can be good cases. I have tried several cases, some with a jury and some without a jury.

First, an attorney looks to see whether or not the Will in question was properly witnessed and executed.

Next, we ask about the legal capacity of the person making the Will to make a Will.

A person has the legal capacity to make a Will when he or she knows his or her estate and the property to be devised and bequeathed, 2) knows the natural objects of his or her bounty, and 3) understands that he or she is making a Will. *Smith v. Vice*, 641 So.2d 785, 786 (Ala.1994). The key inquiry is whether the testator (person making the Will) had testamentary capacity on the day the Will was executed, which may be inferred from a witness's observation of the testator's mental and physical condition either before or immediately after execution of the Will. *Fletcher v. DeLoach*, 360 So.2d 316 (Ala.1978).

Last, a Will may be contested if there is *undue* influence. In order to establish a prima facie case of undue influence, the person contesting the Will is required to offer evidence 1) that a confidential relationship existed between a favored beneficiary and the testator; 2) that the influence of or for the beneficiary was dominant and controlling in that relationship; and 3) that there was undue activity on the part of the dominant party in procuring the execution of the Will.

If prescription medication is alleged to deprive the person making the Will of the capacity to make a Will, the party must produce evidence showing 1) the specific medication the testator was taking at or around the time he or she made the contested testamentary decision and 2) how that medication affected the testator's mental acuity. *Maxwell v. Dawkins*, 974 So.2d 282, 287 (Ala. 2006).

Medicare Minute

"Medicare Advantage Plans Part 3"


A Medicare Advantage Plan (MA) is a type of Medicare health plan offered by a private insurance company that contracts with Medicare to provide you with all your Part A and Part B benefits. There are six things to consider when choosing a MA plan. We discussed three of those things last week; the premium, copays and coinsurance of the plan. This week we will talk about deductibles, provider networks and drug formularies.

A deductible is the amount you are required to pay for your health care services before your health insurance begins to pay. Most MA plans do not have a deductible on services as long as you receive the services from an in network provider. If you receive the services from an out of network provider you may have to meet a deductible before the plan pays or you may not have coverage at all depending on the type of plan you have.

The provider network of the plan is a list of doctors or health care facilities that have agreed to accept the plan. If you are considering a MA plan for the first time you will want to verify with your agent that any doctor or facility you may want to visit is in your plan's network. If you are already in a MA plan you will want to verify with your doctor that they will accept the plan in 2023.

A MA plan's drug formulary is a list of drugs that are covered by the plan. This will include the tiers and copays of the drugs and any deductible you may have to meet on the prescriptions you are taking. Don't overlook the formulary of the plan because MA plans do not cover every prescription drug that is manufactured.

there is nothing in the measure “to prevent employees at embassies of governments that are openly hostile to the United States from casting ballots. Or foreign students who are studying abroad in Washington for a semester.” There you have it: Our nation’s capital is ready to hand ballots to people working against our nation’s interests.

Why is the district

taking this reckless step? Pure politics.

The Left is looking for ways to shift the country’s politics by fundamentally changing who can vote. Even the Post concedes that “progressives hope that reshaping the electorate will allow them to reshape local politics, prodding [D.C.] further to the left on issues such as rent control and spending on social programs.”

D.C. is hardly the only place where the Left has realized the power that can be gained by changing the electorate. Under the euphemistic tag line of “expanding democracy,” left-wing activists across the country are working to hand the vote to imprisoned felons, children, and noncitizens—all groups they calculate are more likely to be liberal. After all, why let the people choose their government when you can have the government choose its people?

And there are plenty to choose from. Consider that over 5 million illegal immigrants have entered the United States in the two years since President Joe Biden was elected. Enfranchising them in local races creates a powerful perverse incentive for politicians to excuse or even demand an ongoing humanitarian crisis on the border so long as it feeds a steady stream of transient voters willing to back a far-left agenda.

When the Left is accused of backing open borders for the prospect of new voters, they retort that it is illegal for any noncitizen to vote in federal elections. True enough, but races for Congress or the White House are hardly the only ones that matter.

Americans have seen firsthand the great damage that can be done when the woke Left captures school boards and town councils. As the old saying goes, all politics is local.

At least 15 municipalities nationally have enfranchised noncitizens to vote in local races, including major cities like San Francisco and New York. The Big Apple’s law is virtually identical to Washington’s pending measure: Anyone in the city for 30 days can vote, including illegal

aliens.

That measure was challenged in court, and earlier this year a New York Supreme Court judge struck it down for violating the state constitution. Had it gone into effect, 800,000 noncitizens would have been handed the vote in New York City.

However, Washington is a federal district answerable directly to Congress unlike those other cities. Under the Constitution and the D.C. Home Rule Act, Congress can block bills passed and cleared by the City Council and mayor.

The question is, will it?

Conservative lawmakers in the House have denounced the measure, while Sen. Tom Cotton, R-Ark., has already pledged a resolution to overturn it. “Allowing illegal immigrants to vote is an insult to every voter in America,” he said. “Every single Democrat should be on the record about whether they support this insane policy.”

Absolutely. The American people deserve to know where their leaders stand on an issue this important. For two years, Democrats in Congress preached about the need to “save democracy.”

Now, with the nation’s capital city preparing to hand the vote to illegal aliens and foreign operatives, will they stand up for fair and honest elections? Or will they look the other way while progressives erode the foundations of our republic?

As long as Democrats control Congress, expect the latter, even though polling shows that only 9% of Americans think noncitizens should be able to vote.

Perhaps there is a silver lining, though. Washington, D.C., is showing the modern Left’s true colors. The Left believes that democracy belongs to them. The rest of just live in it.
