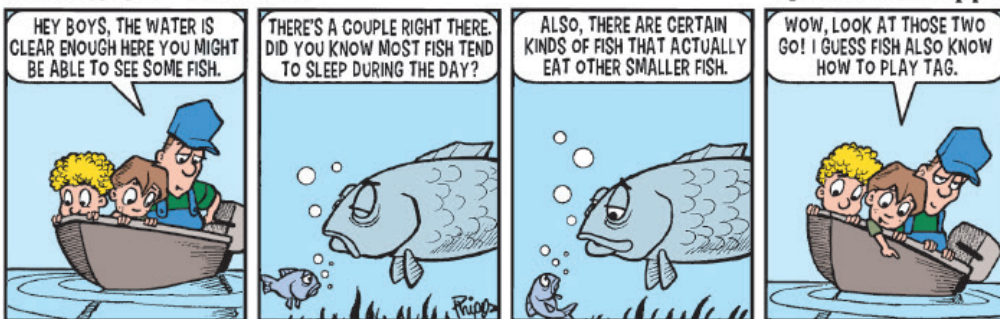

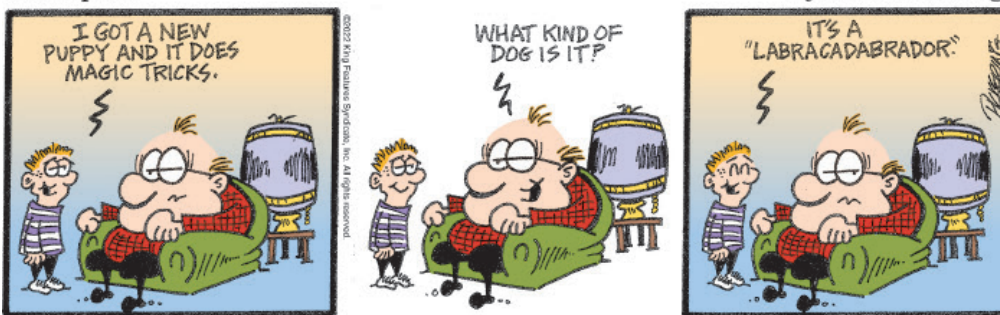

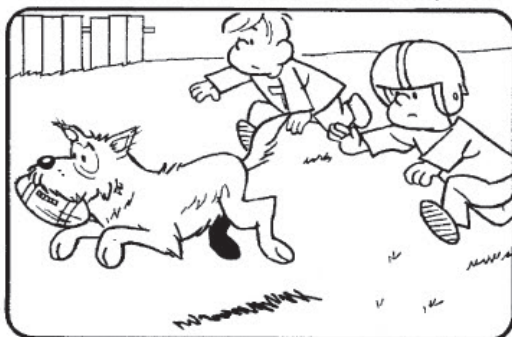

IALR Receives Nearly \$500,000 Grant to Expand Apprenticeships in 15 Southern Virginia Localities

The Tobacco Region Revitalization Commission (TRRC) has awarded the Institute for Advanced Learning and Research (IALR) a grant of \$497,890 for its ExTRA (Expanding Talent through Registered Apprenticeships) program to grow state registered apprenticeships within the 15 Southern Virginia localities throughout GO Virginia Region 3. IALR will create a regional apprenticeship consortium to recruit apprentices and employers, as well as serve as the Virginia Department of Labor and Industry's (DOLI) intermediary sponsor to help employers lacking capacity to fulfill the role as primary sponsor.

City awarded \$30 million in federal tax credits

The Danville, Virginia Community Development Entity (CDE) has been awarded \$30 million through the federal New Markets Tax Credits program. The Danville CDE was one of 107 community development entities selected from a pool of 199 applicants.

The tax credits will be used to attract private investment capital for real estate and business projects that produce jobs and leverage private investment.

"I am thankful that the U.S. Treasury has provided us with these tax credits and our team for making the application," said Mayor Alonzo Jones, who is chair of the CDE. "I look forward to working with the board to determine how to best use this resource."

Corrie Bobe, director of the Danville Office of Economic Development and Tourism, serves as executive director of the Danville CDE. Applications are being accepted for potential projects, she said.

"The purpose of the Danville CDE is to diversify Southern Virginia's economy by lending to entities that create quality jobs," said Bobe. "Through this new award, the CDE will be well positioned to assist in moving impactful projects forward across the region."

This award is the third of its kind for the Danville CDE, which was created to administer the program for the City of Danville. Previous allocations have been used for the River District Tower and Litehouse Foods projects.

"Danville is fortunate to have a community development entity that is able to invest in transformational projects in our region that would otherwise not be financially feasible," said City Manager Ken Larking, who serves on the CDE board.

About the New Markets Tax Credits program: Administered by the U.S. Department of the Treasury's Community Development Financial Institutions fund, the New Markets Tax Credits program was established by Congress in 2000. The program permits investors to receive a credit against their federal income taxes for making qualified equity investments in designated Community Development Entities. In turn, those entities must re-invest the equity investments in low-income communities.

ATKINS RESIGNS FROM SCHOOL BOARD

The Danville School Board accepted the resignation of member Brandon Atkins, effective Nov. 23, during Thursday evening's meeting.

"I would like to thank the citizens of Danville for the opportunity to serve," Atkins said. "The last four years have been challenging for sure, but I believe that Danville Public Schools is on the path to growth. The Board, Superintendent and staff have been a pleasure to work with, and I wish them the best."

Atkins was elected to the Danville School Board in 2018.

"I would like to thank Mr. Atkins for his years of service on the Danville School Board and to Danville Public Schools," Board Chair Crystal Cobbs said. "It has been a pleasure to serve with him, and the board wishes him the best in his future endeavors."

In January, Board Members elected in November will take office, filling Atkins' vacant seat.

HOLLYWOOD — Paul Newman speaks from the beyond. He died on Sept. 26, 2008, at 83, but has his new autobiography to serve as an oral history of his life. Entitled "The Extraordinary Life of an Ordinary Man," the memoir was released Oct. 18 with David Rosenthal, who began working on it with Paul 20 years ago. Rosenthal interspersed Paul's memories with those of friends and family, including his first wife, Jackie Witte (whom he left in 1958 to date, and eventually marry, Joanne Woodward).

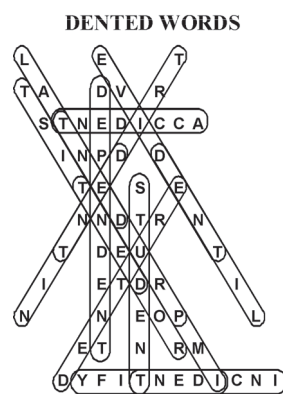

- 1 cup diced onion
- 3 cloves garlic, minced
- 1 pound ground turkey
- 1 cup finely diced carrots
- 1 medium green pepper, diced
- 1 medium red pepper, diced
