This strange piece of art pottery is a cornucopia vase, popular in the 1930s. It was made by the Roseville Pottery Company. The pattern name is White

Cornucopia Vase

Roseville Pottery Company started in Roseville, Ohio, in 1890. A second plant was opened in Zanesville, Ohio, in 1898. White Rose pattern was introduced in the 1940s. White Rose cornucopia vases were made in two sizes, 6 inch (143-6) and 8 inch (144-8). By the late 1940s, there were over 50 shapes in the White Rose pattern glazed in different colors such as sea blue, coral or autumn brown. Reproductions of Roseville pottery have been made in China and sold since the 1980s. The fakes are a different size, so they can be identified. A real, blue Cornucopia White Rose vase that is 8 inches tall sells for \$100 to \$125.

I have two boxes with 50 matchbooks. Are they worth more individually or as a set in the box? Are the covers worth more with the matches or without them? If I want to sell them, are there restrictions on shipping matches?

. Book matches were invented A and patented by Joshua Pusey in 1892. He sold the patent to the Diamond Match Co. of America in 1894. Matchbook collectors are called "phillumenists." There are local, regional, national and international clubs for collectors. The Rathkamp Matchcover Society is the world's oldest phillumenic organization. The Society's website, matchcover.org, lists swap meets and conventions. Collectors look for unused matchbooks with old ads, travel themes and other subjects. If there is a swap meet near you, you can see what covers are selling for and you might be able to find a buyer. Don't let someone pick out the best ones and leave you with a bunch that are not worth much and will be hard to sell. If you plan to ship your collection to a buyer, remove the matches before shipping.

She chronicled the trip in her book "Around the World in 72 Days."

On Nov. 15, 1949, Nathuram Godse, Narayan Apte and six of their coconspirators in the assassination of Mahatma Gandhi were hanged at the Ambala jail. Godse, unhappy over Gandhi's accommodation of Indian Muslims, had shot Gandhi the previous January while Gandhi was out for his evening prayers.

On Nov. 16, 1990, Fabrice Morvan and Rob Pilatus, known to the pop music world as Milli Vanilli, were humiliatingly stripped of their Grammy award for the "Girl You Know It's True" album when it was revealed they hadn't sung even a note of it.

On Nov. 17, 1827, the Delta Phi fraternity, America's oldest continuous social fraternity, was founded at Union College in Schenectady, New York. With just 10 active chapters today, it has resisted expansion in order to create an "intimate, personal experience" for its members.

On Nov. 18, 1872, American civil rights activist Susan B. Anthony and 14 of her brave female cohorts were arrested for voting illegally in the United States presidential election of 1872. Though she was fined \$100, she refused to pay a cent of it.

On Nov. 19, 1493, Christopher Columbus set foot on the island called Borinquen, which he had viewed for the first time the day before. He rechristened it San Juan Bautista, but today we know it as Puerto Rico.

On Nov. 20, 1805, Beethoven's only opera, "Leonore, or The Triumph of Marital Fidelity" (later known as Fidelio), premiered in Vienna — not to its originally intended audience of the aristocracy and Imperial court, who had fled before Napoleon's advancing army, but a small audience of French officers. Their unsurprising lack of enthusiasm shelved the project for nearly a decade.

City awarded \$30 million in federal tax credits

The Danville, Virginia Community Development Entity (CDE) has been awarded \$30 million through the federal New Markets Tax Credits program. The Danville CDE was one of 107 community development entities selected from a pool of 199 applicants.

The tax credits will be used to attract private investment capital for real estate and business projects that produce jobs and leverage private investment.

"I am thankful that the U.S. Treasury has provided us with these tax credits and our team for making the application," said Mayor Alonzo Jones, who is chair of the CDE. "I look forward to working with the board to determine how to best use this resource."

Corrie Bobe, director of the Danville Office of Economic Development and Tourism, serves as executive director of the Danville CDE. Applications are being accepted for potential projects, she said.

"The purpose of the Danville CDE is to diversify Southern Virginia's economy by lending to entities that create quality jobs," said Bobe. "Through this new award, the CDE will be well positioned to assist in moving impactful projects forward across the region."

This award is the third of its kind for the Danville CDE, which was created to administer the program for the City of Danville. Previous allocations have been used for the River District Tower and Litehouse Foods projects.

"Danville is fortunate to have a community development entity that is able to invest in transformational projects in our region that would otherwise not be financially feasible," said City Manager Ken Larking, who serves on the CDE board.

About the New Markets Tax Credits program: Administered by the U.S. Department of the Treasury's Community Development Financial Institutions fund, the New Markets Tax Credits program was established by Congress in 2000. The program permits investors to receive a credit against their federal income taxes for making qualified equity investments in designated Community Development Entities. In turn, those entities must re-invest the equity investments in low-income communities.

HOLLYWOOD

HOLLYWOOD — Paul Newman speaks from the beyond. He died on Sept. 26, 2008, at 83, but has his new autobiography to serve as an oral history of his life. Entitled "The Extraordinary Life of an Ordinary Man," the memoir was released Oct. 18 with David Rosenthal, who began working on it with Paul 20 years ago. Rosenthal interspersed Paul's memories with those of friends and family, including his first wife, Jackie Witte (whom he left in 1958 to date, and eventually marry, Joanne Woodward).

Paul wanted to "leave some kind of record that sets things straight. Pokes holes in the mythology that's sprung up around me." In the book, he reveals his parents were cold-hearted people. His mother viewed him as "a decoration for her house." Paul stated, "The damage for me has come when I've realized what people were clamoring for was not me. It was characters invented by writers." Is that insecurity rearing its ugly head?

He was amused he came in first place in a 1950s poll of women asked to choose which well-known personality they had sexual fantasies about. He added, "Joanne gave birth to a sexual creature. She taught me, she encouraged me, she delighted in the experimental." He also confessed, "And then, there's the celebrity aspect; being a movie star means you start out with three strikes against you ... the adulation, the recognition in restaurants these are completely unnatural."

He continued, "I never enjoyed acting; never enjoyed going out there and doing it. It's probably the reason I drank as much as I did. But, acting gave me a sanctuary where I was able to create emotions without being penalized for having them.'

I was assigned by magazines to get pictures of him, and he was rarely, if ever, amenable. I finally gained his respect by writing a nasty poem for him and Joanne about their conduct that they, unbelievably, loved and liked me for. Paul knew Joanne had

Alzheimer's two years before he died. It's been reported she doesn't even remember who Paul Newman was, but at 92, she's still hanging on. This autobiography is a must-read, if only to try to understand what made stars like Paul Newman tick.


