

"I think people really enjoy the hands-on part, that they get to make their own wreath," said Janelle Flammger, Master Gardener chairperson of the event, "It's just so neat to see everyone's final product - they all start out with the same materials and yet every single wreath turns out completely different and uniquely beautiful."

The Wreath-Making Workshop has been a Master Gardener tradition for years, a staple in the program lineup that stays constant despite

circumstances.

"We were really fortunate that we were able to hold the workshops in 2020 when so many other events and programs were cancelled because of Covid," said Katie Oakes, CCE staff coordinator of the Master Gardener Program. like they always have - in a big room, everyone all together, sharing creative ideas, and encouraging each other.

"I really love the social aspect of this workshop," said long-time Master Gardener Eileen Sorochty. "People are just so happy being together, and it brings back fond memories of being a kid, going to cut your Christmas tree, the smell of the greens. It's nostalgic." Master Gardeners wanted to offer the class shortly after Thanksgiving

so that participants could enjoy their fresh wreath for as long as possible before the holidavs.





### **Gift-Wrapping Tips and Tricks**

Much of the focus of each holiday season is on giftgiving, but all those gifts will eventually need to be wrapped. Stacks of presents just waiting to be covered with paper and ribbon can overwhelm gift givers, prompting them to put off wrapping gifts until the last minute.

#### Handle oddly-shaped items

Wrapping rectangular boxes can be a snap, but what about something that's round or full of angles? Think about placing oddly-shaped items inside another item to make the shape more uniform. Shoe boxes, coffee cans and even paper towel rolls can hold items. Then place the wrapping on these containers.

#### Cover prices

To enable easy exchanges or returns, do not cut off the price tags of gifts. Instead, place a festive sticker over the dollar amount, but leave the scan bar visible. This way the gift recipient can return the gift with ease if necessary.

### Keep supplies at the ready

Devote a bin or bins to wrapping supplies and tools. Having scissors, paper, tape, ribbon, and more in a designated spot will cut down on having to hunt and peck when it comes time to wrap. Martha Stewart suggests getting a rotary cutter to cut long straight or decorative edges on wrapping paper. Rotary cutters may be easier to use than scissors, especially when paired with a ruler.

*Wrap on a firm surface* Devote a table or counter to wrapping gifts. This will keep the paper taut and neat and make it easier to cut and position. You risk tearing the paper or puncturing it when working on carpeting or bedding.

### Color- or pattern-code gifts

It's easy to visualize who gets what gift when each recipient has his or her own special wrapping paper. This is also a handy idea when wrapping gifts from Santa, as it will differentiate the Santa gifts from the ones being given by Mom and Dad. ■







# **Travel Thoughts By Kim**

#### Let's go on an adventure together...when things don't go as planned!

I tend to paint a joyful, easy picture of traveling and probably 95+% of the time, that's absolutely correct. But..... it would be unfair to not tell you about some of the times traveling did not go exactly as planned. Oh, those times can certainly be challenging, upsetting, frustrating, and, yes, even a bit scary at the time! But, every one of them turned out to be times that I look back on with a chuckle and a reminder that sometimes it's the not so perfect things that become our most interesting of memories! You've got to try to keep calm and keep your sense of humor or you can risk totally ruining your vacation for something you have absolutely no control over. Here are just a few examples that

I now laugh about:

First: the issue of lost luggage. I've heard stories about this, but honestly, I've flown a LOT between all the years of off and on business travel and traveling for pleasure and it has only happened to me one time. I was flying from Raleigh to Buffalo when I lived in NC to come home to Albion for me! Christmas. I got to Buffalo

and my luggage didn't join me. The airline was great. They told me they would find it and bring it to me as soon as they got it back. Luckily, I was visiting my Mom and it wasn't an issue to not have my luggage – just a minor inconvenience. The airline found it right away and delivered it to Mom's the next day! I discovered that it went to California!!! I had a serious talk with that suitcase - I told it that I am nice enough to take it with me everywhere I go and it had the unmitigated gall to go to sunny California and let me continue on to snowy Buffalo! Hahaha But, seriously, this is something that happens from time to time.....it can be a lot more than a minor inconvenience, depending the situation. But, there isn't much you can do about it - the airline will usually find it and get it to you as quickly as they can. Plus, it's a good reminder to pack at least one good change of clothes and your medications in your carry-on bag. Also, ensure you have your name, address, and phone # on your checked bag with other visual things to distinguish it (stickers, ribbons, something).....AND - ALWAYS take a photo of your luggage with your phone before you leave in case you need to give it to the people who will be searching for it.

Getting lost: I am one of the most directionally challenged individuals on the planet. I have gotten lost all over the world - I used to say "all across the country", but I recently got lost trying to find my way back to my hotel in Rome, so I've upgraded the reference. One of my favorite stories was when

So, I looked around, got some great photos and tried to head back to Colorado City. Well....my GPS kept trying to put me on questionable looking dirt roads and the one highway it kept directing me to was the one between the two towns with no exits. I literally drove that one highway EIGHT TIMES between Cripple Creek and Victor and could not find my way back to Colorado City. I found myself singing the words to the Eagles' Hotel California - "you can check out anytime you like, but you can never leave!" Since the towns were literally closed, I couldn't find anyone to help direct me – I was on my own. I finally gave in and took one of the dirt roads, thinking my GPS must know what it's talking about. It ended up being a STEEP windy one lane path with lots of big boulders to maneuver around that ended with a fence that said "No Trespassing - Do Not Enter!" I had to do a very precarious three point turn and climb back up out onto the paved road luckily I had a SUV that managed the climb and the boulders very nicely. I did find my way back - without the help of my GPS, which I threw into the back seat after that mess - I just

kept turning in the direction I thought would get me there and bam - there I was! Moral of that story: I was pretty scared and worried at the time, but I survived and I now have a story that I really enjoy telling and I think of it every time Hotel California comes on the radio.

Flight issues: Flight delays and cancellations are never fun. But, please remember that it isn't the fault of the poor airline personnel who you have to deal with. Don't take it out on them. Our flight out of Glasgow was delayed enough that we knew before we left that we were likely going to miss our connecting flight in Amsterdam - and we did miss it! We lucked out having Mitzy from Orleans Travel actually traveling with us - it wasn't easy getting 17 people rebooked (2 didn't need to stay with us), but she worked her magic and got us all home. It wasn't without much more drama and the need to stay overnight in Amsterdam, but we all survived and eventually got home and we all have an awesome story to tell.

These are just a few examples that stick out as times things didn't go as planned for me. My point to this is that things are bound to happen from time to time. The important thing to remember is to not let it totally ruin your trip or your well-being. It is usually just one of those things - you'll survive - it will work out somehow.
