The camp is located in Monticello, Iowa, and they provide activities for those with special needs. Fill up for the holidays and together, we can make a difference.

Camp Courageous was founded in 1972 when 40 acres of land was donated for the sole purpose of establishing a camp for individuals with special needs. In 1973, five buildings were built with donated labor and materials. The first campers attended during the summer of 1974. There were 211 campers who attended this first summer. 



# View From The Bench by John Adams, Jr.

### Groundhog Déjà vu

Last week's Groundhog Day editorial held true again this past weekend with Iowa finding a way to win 13-10 at Minnesota (the Hawkeyes 8th straight win in this series for Floyd of Rosedale) and Iowa State found a way to lose 14-10 at home to Texas Tech. If you didn't watch the games and had to bet your mortgage on who won the games with the following stats you would probably have lost your house. Take a minute and ponder these stats for Team A and Team B. Team A had 13 first downs to their opponents 17; Team A was 3-11 on 3rd down conversions compared to 7-16 for their opponent; Team A was outgained 322-59 on the ground; Team A was outgained 399-280 for total yardage; and Team A lost the time of possession battle 35:13-24:47. Team B had 22 first downs to their opponents 14; Team B was 9-19 on 3rd down conversions compared to their opponents 3-13; Team B won the rushing battle, 128-105; Team B dominated the total yardage battle, 422-246; and Team B won the time of possession 36:05-23:55. Any sane person would look at those numbers and say Team A lost by probably two scores and Team B won by at least two scores. However, if you are told that Team A is Iowa and Team B is Iowa State, without knowing the final scores, but knowing how their seasons are trending, you would take your money and somehow place it on Team A to win and Team B to have lost.

I have no idea how it happens week after week, but Iowa's defense comes up with huge turnovers, and their special teams make field goals while also pinning their opponents deep inside their own territory time after time, while also getting big punt returns from star-in-the making Cooper DeJean. It happened again on Saturday as Minnesota was driving for what appeared to be a game clinching touchdown, but All-B1G running back Mohamed Ibrahim, who rushed for a career-high 263 yards in the game, fumbled at the Iowa 9-yard line with 5:00 left and Iowa recovered. The Hawks, whose offense was listless in the last three quarters (186 total yards) after looking sharp in the first quarter, were forced to punt the ball and the Gophers took over near midfield. Minnesota again drove deep into Iowa territory, but this time All-American Jack Campbell picked off a tipped pass and returned it 70 yards for what looked like a game-winning touchdown. Campbell was somehow ruled out of bounds at the Minnesota 45-yard line (he didn't step out), but it didn't matter as Spencer Petras threw a strike to tight end Luke Lachey for 33 yards that allowed the Hawks to run the ball up the middle and run the clock down before reliable freshman kicker Drew Stevens booted the game-winner from 21-yards out for the 13-10 Iowa victory. Iowa now just has to beat 3-8 Nebraska for an improbable return to the B1G Championship game, and the Hawkeyes have now won an amazing 14 games in a row in November.

While Team A, Iowa, has found ways to win their last four games, Team B, Iowa State found another way to lose their sixth one-possession game of the season on Saturday. The Cyclones dominated Texas Tech in almost every category, except scoring in the red zone, as ISU went a meager 1/5 with just three points in their red zone trips, while the Red Raiders made the most of their only two red zone trips, scoring two touchdowns. For some reason still not released, Iowa State had a new kicker on Saturday in Drake Nettles and he looked like someone kicking his first field goals of the season, missing a 30-yard attempt in the first quarter and then a 34-yard try right before the half. As bad as Nettles kicked, ISU still wins the game if they score on two second half possessions inside the Tech five-yard line. Iowa State ran six plays inside the five and didn't gain a yard on any of them, twice being stopped at or near the goal line. The only ISU touchdown came on a 24-yard pass to tight end Easton Dean, who made a great play, hurdling a defender, to reach the end zone so we didn't have to suffer through another first and goal! The Cyclones were once again killed by pre-snap penalties on an offense that continues to underachieve and shoot themselves in the foot, while an elite defense watches helplessly from the sidelines.

As we've discussed ad nauseum, these two teams are extremely similar with Top 10 defenses that are constantly put under pressure by underwhelming offenses. Iowa State's offense can put up more yards than Iowa's, but Iowa's is more productive when they do reach the red zone. The major differences in 4-7 Iowa State and 7-4 Iowa are that Iowa has much superior special teams' units (this has definitely cost ISU two wins) and the Hawks simply don't lose themselves the game. Tim Brando, the Fox announcer, said it best at the end of the Iowa game when he stated that the B1G West isn't really "how the West was won, but how it wasn't lost." Iowa State either turns the ball over (five at Oklahoma State), has too many offensive penalties (too many games to list), can't convert in the red zone (Texas Tech) or has special teams' blunders (Iowa, Kansas, Texas, Texas Tech). You have to give Kirk Ferentz and his staff a ton of credit for keeping this Iowa team together after they were 3-4 following a 54-10 dismantling at Ohio State. This team didn't point fingers at the struggling offense, instead they kept plugging away, got to an easier part of the schedule (sorry Iowa fans, but the B1G West is not very good), and they have found ways to not lose games. Hawkeye fans can complain all you want about how you are winning and how bad your offense is, and I don't blame you one bit, but as a Cyclone fan, it's a heck of a lot better to "not lose" ugly than to find a new way to lose each week!


### WE CANNOT FORECAST THE WEATHER Holiday music is in the air!





#### **Crop Advantage Series Will Help Producers** Make Smart Decisions for 2023

by Brent Pringnitz

The 2023 Crop Advantage meetings will give producers a solid foundation of current research-based crop production information to help make smart, informed



decisions for their farming operation.

The meetings are an opportunity for farmers and crop advisers to hear current research and crop production information from Iowa State University. Iowa State University Extension and Outreach specialists will travel to 14 locations around Iowa from January 3-26, providing updated management options and recommendations on crop production issues facing Iowa growers.

Crop Advantage Series. Meetings include continuing education credits for Certified Crop Advisers and pesticide applicator recertification. All sites offer private pesticide applicator continuing instruction which is included in the registration fee. "There is no other program in our crop production education"

year where we are able to bring this many Iowa State University Extension and Outreach specialists together to sites across the state. We're excited to provide the quality, in-person education farmers have come to expect," said Meaghan Anderson, field agronomist with ISU Extension and Outreach.

Over 1,500 individuals attended one of 14 Crop Advantage meetings across the state in 2022, representing all 99 Iowa counties and surrounding states. Approximately 85% of attendees said information from Crop Advantage would likely save them between \$5 and \$20 per acre.

"Our goal is always to prepare producers to manage potential issues when they arise, or even before they arise, by sharing the most up-to-date scientific knowledge from Iowa State University researchers," said Anderson. "Each location's program is unique as content is driven by local needs and production issues."

Program topics vary by location and are selected for regional issues. Topics on this year's agenda include tar spot in corn, crop market outlook for 2023, changes to P and K guidelines, soybean gall midge, climate outlook, risks and rewards of ag carbon credits, weed management issues and many more. For locations, times and program details visit www.aep.iastate.edu/cas.

Early registration for each location is \$75; late registration made less than seven days prior to the meeting, or on-site, is \$100. Crust:

2/3 cup amaretti cookie crumbs (about 16 cookies) 2 tablespoons butter, melted

1 tablespoon sugar Cooking spray Filling:

2 (8-ounce) blocks fat-free cream cheese, softened and divided

1 (8-ounce) block 1/3-less-fat cream

cheese, softened 2/3 cup sugar

### **Spirit Lake Protective Association Receives Donation** from East Okoboji Lakes Improvement Corporation

At a special meeting of the Spirit Lake Protective Association (SLPA) on Saturday, November 12, Terry Wilts, secretary of the East Okoboji Lakes Improvement Corporation (EOLIC), presented a check for \$5,000 to the SLPA in support of the Spirit Lake North Watershed Project, a crucial 195.5-acre tract of land located just across the border (Minnesota side) which became a reality this past May.

A little history

Located east of the Mini-Wakan State Park entrance (north side of Big Spirit Lake) on the Grade Road or Stateline Road, this parcel was one that conservationists, clean water groups and lake homeowners in the Iowa Great Lakes Watershed had worked for years to secure.

Finally, in May of 2022, Pheasants Forever Minnesota worked out an agreement with the owners to purchase this 195.5 acres of farmland using their internal land loan fund and additional partner funding. Eran Sandquist, Minnesota state coordinator for Pheasants Forever, is excited that the property has been secured. "Although Pheasants Forever purchased the property, there are so many other groups that have come together with this project. Even though the land is in Minnesota, it is in the Iowa Great Lakes Watershed and directly affects Big Spirit Lake and all the lakes in the Okoboji chain. We have partners in both Minnesota and Iowa that have worked to make this happen. It truly is an example of conservation without borders."

As a major partner in this acquisition, the SLPA is taking the lead to help fundraise for the Spirit Lake North Watershed Project. Wilts noted, "Representing the EOLIC, I am excited to present a check for \$5,000 to help support the Spirit Lake North Watershed Project. Upon completion, this project will positively impact the entire watershed. Nothing is more important than this project right now."

According to John Smeltzer, SLPA Vice President, "The SLPA greatly appreciates our partnership with the EOLIC. Quality of Water - Quality of Life ... is the SLPA motto and the core of our existence since 1930. This Spirit Lake North Watershed Project strikes at both core elements. 'Quality of Water' for the entire Iowa Great Lakes system will be improved by reducing silt, phosphorus and nitrogen runoff directly into Big Spirit Lake. And the area 'Quality of Life', that day to day enjoyment of the area, will resonate for everyone who enjoys the beauty of nature and drives by on that State-line highway with satisfaction in their hearts that they were a part of a legacy project."

Smeltzer noted that the SLPA has already made a \$20,000 donation to the project. "We thank the EOLIC for their donation and their support for this important project. We hope that the SLPA members and our friends in the community will help with our fundraising efforts. Over many years, people in the Iowa Great Lakes area and beyond have stepped up to help complete clean water projects. We hope that this will happen with the Spirit Lake North Project.'


