## COWBOY COOKIES

## Yield 3 to $31 / 2$ dozen cookies Ingredients

- 3 cups all-purpose flour
- 1 tablespoon baking powder
- 1 tablespoon baking soda
- 1 tablespoon ground cinnamon
- 1 teaspoon salt

- $11 / 2$ cups butter, room temperature
- $11 / 2$ cups granulated sugar
- $11 / 2$ cups light-brown sugar, packed
- 3 eggs
- 1 tablespoon vanilla extract
- 3 cup semisweet chocolate chips
- 3 cups old-fashioned rolled oats
- 2 cups sweetened flake coconut
- 2 cups chopped pecans


## Directions

1. Heat oven to $350^{\circ} \mathrm{F}$.
2. Mix flour, baking powder, baking soda, cinnamon and salt in bowl.
3. In 8-quart bowl, beat butter on medium speed until smooth and creamy, 1 minute. Gradually beat in sugars to combine, 2 minutes.

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4. Add eggs, one at a time, beating after each. Beat in vanilla.
5. Stir in flour mixture until just combined. Add chocolate chips, oats, coconut and pecans.
6. For each cookie, drop 1/4 cup dough onto ungreased baking sheets, spacing 3 inches apart.
7. Bake in $350^{\circ} \mathrm{F}$ oven 17 to 20 minutes, until edges are lightly browned; rotate sheets halfway through. Remove cookies to rack to cool.

## SEVEN LAYER BARS

## Yeild 36 bars

## Ingredients

- $1 / 2$ cup unsalted butter
- $11 / 2$ cups graham cracker crumbs
- 1 cup semisweet chocolate chips
- 1 cup butterscotch chips
- 1 cup chopped walnuts
- 1 (14 ounce) can sweetened condensed milk
- $1 \frac{1}{3}$ cups shredded coconut


## Directions

1. Preheat the oven to 350 degrees $F$ ( 175 degrees $C$ ).
2. Put butter in $13 \times 9$-inch baking pan and place in oven until melted. Swirl to coat bottom and sides with butter.
3. Spread graham cracker crumbs evenly over bottom of pan. Layer chocolate chips, butterscotch chips, and walnuts over crumbs. Pour condensed milk over walnuts and sprinkle with coconut.
4. Bake in preheated oven until edges are golden brown, about 25 minutes.
5. Cool and cut into bars.

## PEANUT BUTTER-CHOCOLATE NO-BAKE COOKIES

Yeild about 60 cookies
Ingredients

- 2 cups sugar
- $1 / 2$ cup milk

- 1 stick (8 tablespoons) unsalted butter
- 1/4 cup unsweetened cocoa powder
- 3 cups old-fashioned rolled oats
- 1 cup smooth peanut butter
- 1 tablespoon pure vanilla extract
- Large pinch kosher salt



## Directions

1. Line a baking sheet with wax paper or parchment.
2. Bring the sugar, milk, butter and cocoa to a boil in a medium saucepan over medium heat, stirring occasionally, then let boil for 1 minute. Remove from the heat. Add the oats, peanut butter, vanilla and salt, and stir to combine.
3. Drop teaspoonfuls of the mixture onto the prepared baking sheet, and let sit at room temperature until cooled and hardened, about 30 minutes. Refrigerate in an airtight container for up to 3 days.

## OLD FASHIONED BROWN SUGAR CANDY

## Yeild 36 Squares

## Ingredients

- $3 / 4$ cup (1 $1 / 2$ sticks) unsalted butter, cubed
- 3 cups brown sugar
- 1 (5 oz.) can evaporated milk
- 1 pound powdered sugar
- 1 teaspoon vanilla extract
- $1 / 4$ teaspoon salt
- 1/2 cup walnuts, chopped



## Directions

1. Line a 9-inch square baking dish with parchment paper or butter or non-stick spray.
2. Stir milk, brown sugar and butter together in a large saucepan over medium-high heat and bring to a boil.
3. Reduce heat to medium-low and cook for 5 minutes, stirring continuously.
4. Remove from heat and use a hand mixer to beat in powdered sugar, vanilla extract, salt and walnuts. Beat until just thickened.
5. Pour/transfer mixture to prepared baking dish and let cool until set.
6. When ready to serve, slice into squares and enjoy.

## MAPLE-NUT-PUMPKIN CANDIES

## Ingredients

- 1 c light brown sugar
- 1 c granulated sugar
- $3 / 4$ c maples syrup
- $1 / 4$ c butter
- $1 / 2$ c solid packed pumpkin
- $1 / 2$ c heavy whipping cream
- 1 tsp pumpkin pie spice

- $1 / 4$ tsp salt
- 1 c walnuts, toasted and chopped


## Directions

1. Line an $8 x 8$ inch metal pan with parchment paper. Spray paper with non-stick cooking spray.
2. In a medium pot, combine sugars, maple syrup,butter, pumpkin, cream and pumpkin spice over medium heat. Stir until butter is melted and all ingredients are combined. Bring to a simmer and cook 12 minutes or
until temperature reaches 238 degrees on a candy thermometer. Stir in walnuts.
3. Pour mixture into lined pan. Cool 1 hour on the counter. Cool an additional 1 hr in fridge. Slice into squares.

## OKLAHOMA NUT CANDY

## Ingredients

- 6 cups sugar, divided
- 2 cups heavy cream
- $1 / 2$ cup unsalted butter
- $1 / 4$ teaspoon baking soda

- 1 teaspoon vanilla
- $1 \frac{1}{2}$ cups chopped walnuts or pecan


## Directions

1. Grease a $9 \times 13$ baking dish and set aside.
2. In a small saucepan (with a heavy bottom if you have it!), pour in 2 cups of sugar and cook over low heat while stirring often. Cook until sugar is completely melted, about 20 minutes.
3. As sugar cooks down, add the 4 cups of remaining sugar and heavy cream to a large saucepan (or dutch oven, you want a big pot here!). Simmer over low heat until the sugar in your small saucepan has melted. Add melted sugar to a large saucepan with continuously stirring.
4. Bring the heat up to medium and cook mixture until 244 degrees F or softball stage.
5. Remove from heat and stir in baking soda until completely combined.
6. Add butter and vanilla. Stir until butter has melted and the mixture is smooth.
7. Let rest for 20 minutes.
8. After the mixture has rested, stir in nuts and mix until the sheen has gone. Transfer to prepared baking dish.
9. Let cool 1-2 hours or overnight. Cut into small squares to serve.
