Holiday Mindful Eating: Savor the Flavor



Have you heard about mindful eating? Mindful eating is not a diet, but the practice to approach food with the intention of enjoying it, savoring it, paying attention to what is being eaten,

hunger and fullness. Mindful eating has little to do with calories, carbohydrates, fat, or protein. It is eating without judging (self or others). The purpose of mindful eating is not to lose weight, but to savor food and the experience of eating. (Although studies show that people who practice mindful eating often do eat healthier and lose weight.)

Parks Marina Raises Over \$45,000 in Toys







Cyclone Holiday Hoops

The football season is mercifully over for us Cyclone fans and we have plenty to be excited about with our men's and women's basketball teams this season. The women, who were a preseason Top 10 team, have looked very good so far, starting out 5-1 with a national ranking of #5 that could drop some after they lost 73-64 to #8 North Carolina on Sunday night in the Nike Phil Knight Invitational Finals. The Cyclones led by as many as 17 points in the game, but the Tarheels got hot in the second half and ISU couldn't buy a bucket as they watched their lead melt away. This team is loaded with All-American Ashley Joens returning for her fifth year along with returning All-Big 12 guards Emily Ryan and Lexi Donarski. The missing piece for this 2022 Sweet 16 team was a post who could score inside and outside, and they definitely have that in 6'6" transfer Stephanie Soares, who is averaging 17.7 points and 8.8 rebounds through her first six games. If you want some must-see TV, be sure to tune into ESPN2 on December 7th to watch their Top 10 matchup with Iowa at 6:00pm.

We all know about the amazing turnaround that men's coach TJ Otzelberger did last season with their 20-win improvement from 2021, and Sweet 16 appearance. The Cyclones lost some big-time talent with graduation and transfers, and then had a key injury to Temple transfer Jeremiah Williams, who tore his Achilles in the preseason and is out for the season. No one expected much of this year's group, but it looks like this new team continues to build on winning through hard-nose defense and positive energy culture. I had the opportunity to go watch this year's team practice in October, and walked away thoroughly impressed with their energy and effort as well as the extremely strong culture that permeates from the managers to the players and to the coaches. The Cyclones picked up two huge wins over the Thanksgiving Holiday when they took down two 2022 Final Four teams in Villanova and #1 North Carolina before falling in the championship game of the Phil Knight Invitational to #18 UCONN. Granted, Villanova is down from last season and battling some key injuries, but to beat a program like that was a big-time win for Otzelberger and this fairly new team. The 70-65 win against #1 UNC on Friday night was a classic for the Cyclones, and showed that they can once again play with anyone in the country. Caleb Grill went absolutely crazy from the 3-point line, hitting 7/11 on his way to a career-high 31 points, as the Cyclones rallied from a 57-49 deficit with 5:45 left to pull off the upset. Transfer Jalen Holmes added 22 points, and ISU continued to get strong play from backup center, Robert Jones, who added 10 points and 4 rebounds while helping hold All-American Armando Bacot to 13 points.

After suffering through an extremely disappointing football season, it's so nice to have something to look forward to this winter with these two basketball teams. I love how both teams play so unselfishly, and you can tell that they thoroughly enjoy playing together as a team, which will definitely help them as the season progresses. I think the women have enough fire power to be a serious Final 4 contender while the men appear to be similar to last year's team, winning through defense and energy while probably losing some games when they struggle to score like they did against UCONN when they hit just 3/13 from the 3-point line. Let's hope both teams can continue to play this well and bring Cyclone fans an exciting winter full of Hilton Magic!
