Additional deer hunting harvest opportunities in December

Following confirmation of CWD-positive deer in Bemidji, deer permit area added to late-season hunt only one or two deer.

> unfilled archery, firearms, muzzleloader or landowner deer hunting license. Unfilled bonus permits and early antlerless permits also may be used. The hunting method used must match the license.

> Hunters also may use any unfilled disease management

permits or they may purchase a disease management permit for \$2.50. During this hunt, individuals using disease management permits may hunt by archery, firearms or muzzleloader, and do not need any additional deer hunting license or permit.

Unlike other hunts, disease management permits may be used to tag both antlered and antlerless deer. Bonus

permits and early antlerless tags can only be used to tag antlerless deer.

Some public lands in southern Minnesota where deer hunting is otherwise not allowed will be open to hunting by a limited number of people during the late-season CWDmanagement hunt. Special, no-cost permits to access these areas will be available Continued on Page 3

Entitled "Cold Hands Warm Heart", this concert begins with classical music depicting winter in Russia. Nikolay Rimsky-Korsakoff,






