NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that pursuant to a resolution of the Board of Fire Commissioners, an election of the qualified voters of the Murray Joint Fire District, New York, County of Orleans, will be held at the Murray Joint Fire District's Firehouse located at 7 Thomas Street, Holley, NY on the 16th day of January, 2023, between the hours of 6 p.m. and 9 pm. to vote on whether to approve the following resolution adopted by such Board of Fire Commissioners:

### RESOLUTION FOR PURCHASE OF A PUMPER

RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF FIRE COMMISSIONERS OF THE MURRAY JOINT FIRE DISTRICT, IN THE TOWN OF MURRAY, ORLEANS COUNTY, NEW YORK (THE "FIRE DISTRICT"), AUTHORIZING THE PURCHASE OF A PUMPER IN THE ANTICIPATED MAXIMUM AMOUNT OF \$680,000, AND APPROPRIATING SAID AMOUNT THEREFORE; AND AUTHORIZING THE FINANCING BY ISSUANCE OF A SERIAL BOND OR STATUTORY INSTALLMENT BOND UP TO TWENTY YEARS, OR THE USE OF AN INSTALLMENT PURCHASE AGREEMENT FOR UP TO TWENTY YEARS, FOR THE MAXIMUM AMOUNT OF \$680,000 PRINCIPAL, AND TO UTILIZE BOND ANTICIPATION NOTES FOR UP TO FIVE (5) YEARS.

All persons registered to vote in the district and residing in the fire district for at least thirty (30) days prior to the day of the vote may vote in such election.

Pursuant to Local Finance Law Section 80, the validity of such bonds or notes or any bond anticipation notes issued in anticipation of the sale of such bonds May be contested only if such obligations are authorized for an object or purpose for which the fire district is not authorized to expend money; or if the provisions of law which should be complied with as of this date are not substantially complied with, and an action, suit or proceeding contesting such validity, is commenced within twenty days after the date of such publication; or such obligations are authorized in violation of the provisions of the constitution.

You may be surprised to know that a family of four, earning \$52,000 per year or less qualifies for free health insurance (Medicaid) through the New York State of Health. There is no monthly payment. Another example is if you are a family of three and earn about \$43,000 or less, you would also qualify for Medicaid.

If you earn more than the income limits for Medicaid, then you may qualify for the Essential Plan or the cost share reduction plan. With the Essential Plan, there may be co-pays depending on income levels. The bottom line is that there are many options, so talk to an Insurance Enroller at Oak Orchard Health to find out what is right for you and your family.

#### What do I need for my insurance application?

Your application will require your contact information, Social Security number, and basic household size which is based on your tax status. So, if you are married, put two but if you claim dependents on your income tax then you need to add them. NYS will verify what is in your application including your income.

#### Child Health Plus

Child Health Plus is for kids under 19 years of age. There are no out-of-pocket costs, no co-pays, or deductibles through this program. Like Medicaid, qualifying for it is based on income.

New York State has been automatically recertifying Medicaid

Yes, during COVID, NYS has been automatically recertifying everyone so that you did not have to file a new application. We will find out on or about November 15th how NYS will manage this moving forward.

#### College Students and Graduates

If you are in college or graduated, how can you get health insurance? The first question is whether you are a dependent on your parent's insurance. If you are not a dependent, then the insurance application is filed with the student's income which is typically low. Look to the New State of Health website to apply or an insurance enroller at Oak Orchard to help.

#### Key Enrollment Dates

The 15th of the month is especially important. If you are eligible for a qualified health plan like the Essential Plan or Child Health Plus, you must file before the 15th if you want insurance to start the first of the following month. If you want insurance to start on January 1, your application needs to be filed before December 15th. The earlier the better.

For Medicaid, they typically backdate to the first of the month that you applied. For example, if you applied on November 15th, your Medicaid insurance will start on November 1. If you choose a managed care plan (like the Essential Plan), then it would start on December 1st.

We hope this has helped but if you have questions, we can help you enroll in health insurance coverage. Insurance Enrollers are here and trained to educate and provide enrollment assistance to everyone applying for coverage through the New York State of Health. ## Why breakfast still matters

Many adults recall being told "breakfast is the most important meal of the day" when they were youngsters. Though the accuracy of that phrasing hinges on what people eat during their morning meal, scientific evidence supports the notion that breakfast is important to overall health.

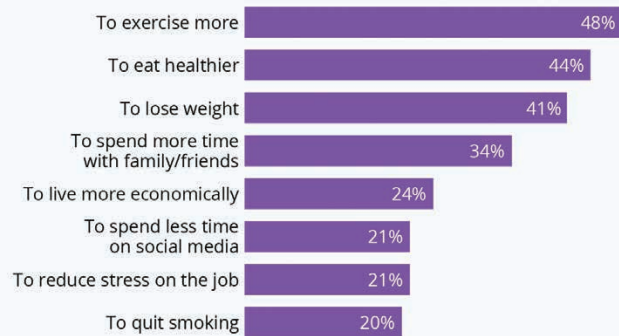
