

Notice is hereby given that I, Tamara McCallum, the undersigned Collector of Taxes in and for the Town of Nunda, have received the tax rolls and warrant for the collection of taxes for 2023.

Taxes may be paid, by cash, check or money order in the following manner:

- In-person payments will be collected Monday through Friday from 9:00 AM until 4:00 PM at the Government Center, 4 Massachusetts Street, Nunda.
- Mailed payments should be made payable to Tamara McCallum, Tax Collector and sent to PO Box 699, Nunda, NY 14517.
- For your convenience, there is a locked drop box located outside the Government Center front door.


There is no penalty if postmarked by January 31, 2021. All taxes received after that date shall incur a 1% penalty for postmark on or before February 28, 2021: 2% penalty, for postmark on or before March 31, 2021.

Pursuant to Section 987 of the Real Property Tax Law, a delinquent notice will be mailed on or after the thirty-first day following the expiration of the period of interest-free payment of taxes. The law mandates that the expense of mailing such notice shall be an additional two dollars (\$2.00) against the parcel. There will be no payments accepted in the Nunda Tax Collector's office after March 31, 2022.

Further Notice: pursuant to the provisions of law, the tax roll of the Town of Nunda will be returned to the Livingston County Treasurer on the 1st day of April 2023.

First Day Hikes at Letchworth State Park! Sunday, January 1, 2023 - FREE!

Sunrise Hike, 7-8:30 AM, meet at *Humphrey Nature Center*, 1 mile south of the Castile entrance. Witness the first sunrise of 2023 from Archery Field Overlook, the breathtaking "Grand Canyon of the East" view at Letchworth State Park. This easy hike on mostly-level ground offers wonderful views and great photo opportunities. 1 mile. Due to the possibility of temporary road closures for winter weather, please use the Mount Morris entrance for north end hikes and the Castile entrance for south end hikes: Mount Morris entrance: 130 North Main Street, Mount Morris, Castile entrance: 6787 Denton Corners Road, Castile.

Hike Around Trout Pond, 10-11:30 AM, meet at *Humphrey Nature Center*, 1 mile south of the Castile entrance. The human-enhanced wildlife habitat, fishing pond, and water source for the fountain at the Glen Iris Inn. This moderate hike covers mostly flat ground but follows a complete loop around Trout Pond. 


