Families who are interested in enrolling their child in Geneseo Central School District's Universal Pre-Kindergarten (UPK) program for the 2023-24 school year can find the application on the District's website. Your child must be born between December 2, 2018 and December 1, 2019 to be eligible. If your child is eligible *and* your family is already in our student management system (SchoolTool), you will automatically receive an application in the mail.

If there are more eligible applicants than can be served in a given school year, the District will conduct a lottery draw to determine who attends the program. Completed applications are due to the district **no later than MARCH 22, 2023.**

Incomplete applications will result in your child being excluded from the lottery. The lottery will be conducted **on MARCH 24, 2023.**

All applicants will be notified of the results. Families of the lottery-selected students will be mailed a registration packet to complete and return to the District.

About the UPK Program

UPK is a federally- and state-funded program that introduces young learners to the school environment and focuses on intellectually, socially and emotionally preparing children for Kindergarten.

The District partners with Pride & Joy, an early education community-based organization, to administer its UPK program. The program will follow the New York State Pre-Kindergarten Learning Standards.
