

Acetaminophen **Class Action**

We have had several people ask us about the class action suit involving Tylenol. However, it's not only Tylenol that's included in this class action. This article will provide the general criteria to help determine if you may have a claim.

The ideal time frame for these claims is when the minor child was either born or diagnosed between 2013-2020, which is when the relevant medical literature surfaced. Regardless, we still investigate cases that fall outside that time frame. We are currently investigating cases where the mother of the injured child took at least one of the following throughout her pregnancy (must include use during second and third trimesters):

Tylenol®, Generic Acetaminophen, NyQuil®/ DayQuil®, Alka-Seltzer Plus®, Robitussin®, Generic Paracetamol, Excedrin, Mucinex, Goody's

We are investigating the following injuries as a result of using the above products:

Autism/ASD, Kanner's Syndrome, Childhood Disintegrative Disorder, ADHD, Asperger's Syndrome, Pervasive Developmental Disorder, Not Otherwise Specified (PDD-NOS)

We cannot investigate cases where:

· The mother does not have custody of the child and/or is not the representative or is not willing/able to pursue the claim on the injured child's behalf, **OR** the mother is not the legal guardian of an incapacitated child. OR the mother is deceased and the next of kin is not willing to pursue the claim on her beĥalf.

Medicare Minute

"Signing up for Medicare Part 2"

Most Americans qualify for Medicare by turning 65 but there are other ways to qualify such as being disabled, having End Stage Renal disease (ESRD) or ALS. Today we are going to look at how you would sign up if you are disabled.

If you are under the age of 65 and disabled, you will automatically be enrolled in Part A and Part B after you have received Social Security or Railroad Retirement Board (RRB) benefits for at least 24 months. If you are disabled, covered by your or your spouse's group health plan and wish to stay on that plan, my suggestion is to contact the plan and confirm that you can remain on the plan even though you have Medicare. This may allow you to delay your Part B until a later date.

You are eligible for Medicare if you have End Stage Renal Disease and you've worked the required amount of time under Social Security, RRB or as a government employee OR you're already getting or are eligible for Social Security or RRB benefits OR you're the spouse or dependent child of one of the previous requirements. You should contact Social Security or the RRB for the amount of time worked to be eligible for Medicare.

If you're under 65 and have ALS your Medicare benefits should begin the first month you start receiving your Social Security or RRB benefits. Again contact Social Security or RRB for a list of the benefits.

Whether it's SSI or RRB disability, ESRD or ALS, I would encourage you to NEVER voluntarily leave your current health plan until you have covered all your bases with your current plan and Medicare. In most cases once you leave you cannot go back!! If you are faced with any of these 3 situations and need additional assistance feel free to contact





reputation for not enforcing international laws against this kind of activity. The scammer will create a fake identity of an attractive teenage female on social media platforms such as Facebook and Instagram, or gaming platforms such as Twitch and Discord.

The "hot girl" scammers will then befriend teenagers, gain their trust through messages, get the hormones raging, then offer to exchange dirty pictures. This is the modern version of "I'll show you mine if you show me yours." Once the scammer has collected a few pictures, they will then extort the teenager by threatening to send all the dirty pictures to their friends unless they pay a ransom, usually in the form of gift cards.

This has evidently happened to about 3,000 kids in 2022 which is a tenfold increase over previous years. The victims are mostly between 14 and 17 years old. About a dozen of those victims committed suicide.

So what can a parent or grandparent do to prevent this from happening to their loved one? Nothing new here; we have to keep a close eye on our kids and we have to let them know that this happens. So many of us parents are ignorant of the dangers that await our kids when we hand over the keys to the internet and let our kids freely roam around. Heck, even many of my very adult Facebook friends fall for hot girl scams. We ought to know better.

The good news is that you don't have to be a tech guru to protect your kids. There are free parental controls that can be implemented on almost all smartphones, tablets, and laptops. More advanced tools will inform you of literally everything your child does

on the internet. The details of how to do all this are a little much for this little column but the main thing you need to know is that these options exist and it's your job to figure out the best one to implement. I know I don't have to inform either of my readers that there will never be a substitute for a watchful eye from a loving parent, but here's your reminder.

"He cut him across the hand with a butcher knife and Jones fell. The man was about to bury the knife into Jones chest when I shot him," Singleton said. "He died from the gunshot wound.







The Shelter Responsibility

Editor:

On Christmas day there was a *Times Daily* article, entitled, "Betterton: County should pay half." The cost the mayor is speaking of is for the county to pay half the cost to operate the Florence-Lauderdale Animal Shelter.

Apparently, there was a meeting with city and county officials where the city proposed that the cost be based on population with the county paying 57% of cost; with the city paying 43%. county rejected this offer. As a result, the mayor proposed that the cost be split 50/50 among the city and county. Prior to the county reaching a decision on the new offer, the mayor shared the offer with the *Times Daily*.

The article quotes our mayor as follows: "State law requires each county in Alabama to operate a shelter and provide animal control services, not each city." This statement is not clear! Florence is in Lauderdale County and the city citizens vote for the county commissioners.

The county commissioners also purchased the land for the current shelter. This was the site the city council wanted even though the site was in a flood zone and contained a large depression. believe T this site is within the city limits. Also, has the amount of county spending within the city been considered?

If the county approves the 50/50 split, they should be involved in hiring, firing, and other policy actions at the shelter.

I prefer the current system and not setting a precedent. Also, if a staff writer is not at their meetings, the commissioners should consider having a press release prepared on their actions and forwarded to the *Times Daily* and *Courier Journal* for printing.


Dear Dave,

I'm not a lawyer, so the first thing I'd do is talk to a couple of probate attorneys in your county. Find out what they'd charge to handle things. I wouldn't spend thousands of dollars to get this done, but I would pay \$500, maybe \$1,000, to let someone who knows what they're doing handle things. If your county affairs people are right and everything's easy and straightforward, it's not a lot of legal work for an attorney.

On top of that, if the attorney you work with knows folks at the courthouse

and is familiar with how things work there, then it's kind of like traffic court, you know? It's almost automatic. I mean, we're only talking about three assets here—a bank account that's already been handed off, a car and a house that's mortgaged. For me, it'd be worth a little money to have someone on my side who knows the path through the woods.

I'm sorry to hear your friend and neighbor passed on, Steven. But I hope I've been able to help.



"In my memoirs I have been writing, I talk about how my courage and honesty and integrity were all tested that first year. It was a difficult year, but I think that defined me as an officer."

He went back to college and helped his father with his restaurant. About a year later, Singleton returned to work under a new sheriff.

That sheriff died a year later, and Singleton ran for the position at age 26, finishing fourth in a 12-man race.

"Like I thought I was qualified to be sheriff," he said, laughing.


leaving After department, sheriff's Singleton continued his law enforcement career with the Florence Police Department. He rose through the ranks going from a patrol officer to deputy chief within seven years.

Singleton was named police chief in 1996, where he stayed until he retired in 2012.

His retirement from law enforcement didn't last long.

Singleton was elected become the first Republican Lauderdale County sheriff in 2014 and then was reelected in

"The inmate said, 'You saw us and shook our hands and thanked us for washing cars," Singleton said. "He decided on that day he was not coming back to jail. He felt self-

"These officers make a difference in the community, and that's what it's all about."

One of the most difficult times Singleton's career came when capital murder suspect and Lauderdale County Detention Center inmate, Casey White. along with former assistant corrections director, Vicky White, corrections came up missing on April

That led to a nationwide manhunt that ended in

Indiana on May 9 when Vicky White died from a self-inflicted gunshot, and Casey White was arrested.

Singleton found fielding himself interview requests from across the world while trying to cope with the knowledge that Vicky White, who had been one of the most respected and trusted jailers at the detention center, was involved.

"A lot of times you think you know people and you really don't,' said Singleton. sure every one of us has things people don't know about us, and you never know what's going through someone's mind.

"My heart was telling me that she was being coerced, but my head was telling me, no she's not."

Throughout

ordeal, Singleton m a d e himself as available as possible, and released any information could without jeopardizing the search.

always believed in being transparent," he said. "Obviously, in our line of work there are times when you can't tell everything you know about an investigation, for either legal or investigative reasons."

In a life that even included a professional wrestling stint as "Dr. Death" in his younger days, Singleton wonders what he will do when he hangs up his sheriff's hat for the last time.

"Maybe I'll get out the old Dr. Death mask," he said with a laugh.

Singleton then turned serious, pondering that moment.

"I'm sure it's probably going to be emotional, he said of retirement. "It's like leaving family," he added. "Some of these guys up here are young enough to be my grandkids. When I look at them, that's sort of how I consider them. I'm concerned about their safety. Outside of their family, I think I worry more about them than anybody."

"I've been known to get a little emotional. It's been a long time coming, but I'm ready for it.
