Where to start? Gary is one of those people whom everybody feels that they know, I'm sure. When I first came to Aitkin, I've often remarked that it was like stepping back in time. Many of the downtown stores hadn't changed much and reminded me of shopping in Brainerd in the 1960s.

ware was like that, with its tile floors and vintage vibe. It was a mainstay for those of us who worked downtown. I'd often stop in after work to pick up a doohickie or bobble, and Gary was there to help.

Despite Gary and his wife Ihleen working long, long hours at the store, he found time to devote himself to his church. Once the Lutheran Brethren Church, now Aitkin's New Life, the little church by the park in Aitkin is a part of Gary. Who knows the countless things he's done for the church, and the endless ways he's toiled, hours he spent, things he's fixed and money he's given.

When a shrinking congregation led to the closing of the original church, New Life breathed new life into the building. The new congregation was a mix of Lutheran Brethren and folks from different denominations from all around the area. Although it is part of the Christian and Missionary Alliance, it is truly a community church, welcoming everyone. And Gary was part of making it so. He must have been so excited to see the new congregation grow and the plans to build a new church building in the Bunker Hill area of Aitkin near the hospital come to fruition.

Different times my life has touched his, as I'm sure yours has. When I worked at a local nursing home, he faithfully visited residents he knew every Sunday. When their downtown location closed and a new hardware store

opened at Southgate, I once saw Gary taking his elderly mother around the store, pushing her wheelchair gently and showing her all the products.

Don't forget about the community. Active in the chamber of commerce, Gary was elected Riverboat captain and took his duties seriously.

Growing up in country schools, he was a native but never made outsiders feel like outsiders as some locals tend to do. He had his smile for everyone and distributed it fairly, just as God's rain falls on all of the people of the earth.

He was a man's man who loved to hunt and fish and ride his motorcycle. When he found the time to have fun I'm not sure -- but he worked it in somehow.

Not too long before he died they took a trip to see the Noah's Ark and Creation Museum, which must have been a dream come true for him.

Soon, it's time for his funeral. It's bound to be packed. It might have been more practical to hold it in a larger venue, but the little church that he loved so much is where we will say goodbye to Gary.

The backbone of Aitkin County is a little weaker today. One of the strong ligaments that held it together is gone. But to fulfill Gary's legacy, let us accept everyone, let us help others, let us love our community, despite its flaws. Let us work together to rebuild the backbone of a community that is both a little sadder and a little wiser today.

If the goal is to catch and release, barbs can cause more damage in the fish's mouth. hook Removing the barb, by either purchasing barbless hooks or taking a pair of pliers to flatten barbs on hooks can reduce the amount of time it takes to remove the hook from the fish's mouth. This gets the fish back in the water more quickly allowing them to recover more quickly. • If you need any additional reasons to go barbless, think about how often barbs get stuck in nets or clothing or even... fingers! Not having barbs on hooks can save equipment and potentially a trip to the ER.

Hospitals radiology department. He was the first dentist to open a practice in Baxter in 1980. Joe married his wife Susan in 1987 and they lived in Brainerd before moving to Gull Lake in 1990 and returned to Brainerd in 2014. Dr. Dudding performed a wide range of dental services to the residents of Crow Wing County. He provided endodontic treatments. In addition to his private patients, Dr. Dudding would go to the Crow Wing County Jail for emergency extractions. He would also maintain the dental x-ray units in the jail. Dr. Dudding provided dental services to developmentally disabled patients one day per week for approximately 15 years, first at Brainerd State Hospital and then at Central Lakes College. In addition to treating patients, Dr. Dudding shared his expertise with dental assisting students at CLC, by giving lectures and teaching x-ray techniques, and checking students' work. Joe was a member of the Masonic Lodge as well as the Elks Lodge, Lions Club, and American Legion in Brainerd. He was also a member of the American/Minnesota/Indiana & Chicago Dental Society. He was a member of Trinity Lutheran Church, volunteering in many capacities. Joe enjoyed boating, fishing, and snowmobiling. He loved classical music and relaxing in his hot tub daily all year long.




