Dear "Speak Out",

KINDNESS from Five Strangers in Mount Morris

On Monday, January 16, 2023, I was running an errand to the Walgreens in the Village of Mount Morris, New York. I took my two-year-old German Shepherd, Cyrus with me. When I got out of my truck, I thought I had Cyrus secured so that he could not get out when I returned with my items. Well, I was wrong, as soon as I opened the door he rushed pass me before I could grab him; and he was off for an adventure. You see, Cyrus is a country dog. The only other people he knows up close are a few of my Amish neighbors. He has never been around a commercial building or parking lot. The new surroundings was a playground for him. I immediately called my sister, told her Cyrus was loose and to please start praying to help me catch him.

Cyrus's adventure started at 10:40 AM. First, he circled around the Walgreens by the drive thru and then came out front. Another customer, Sharon (also a dog owner) immediately offered to help me; and she even had some dog treats so we could try to bribe Cyrus to come to us. I told Sharon he was a picky eater and did not know if he would respond but we could try. All the time I prayed to Jesus to help Cyrus come to me. I opened the truck door to encourage him to get in (he likes riding in the truck) but the parking lot and surrounding area was more interesting to him.

Sharon let me know she could help me since she did not need to pick up her son for another hour or so. Cyrus would come near us but not close enough to catch him. Then to our horror, he crossed over 408, into the large parking lot with the empty grocery store, dollar store and Chinese restaurant. One car was coming! The driver was very observant, slowed down to a stop; then, Sharon and I could cross over the street. GOD provided the first miracle; since it was, the Martin Luther King holiday there was little to no traffic. Cyrus, Sharon and I were now safe in the large parking lot.

We both got down lower in our stance, and called to Cyrus. Our efforts to bribe him with the dog treats was failing. Sharon found a baseball. I asked her to throw it to him to see if he would bring it back to her or to me, as Cyrus loves playing tennis. I hit the tennis ball with a racket and he runs after it and brings it back to me. We continue until he gets tired. Unfortunately, Cyrus was not tempted he kept running around the large parking lot checking things out.

An employee from the dollar store saw what was going on and immediately she tried to help us. She even went to her car opened the door to see if Cyrus would get in. Cyrus did not know her so he kept running around checking things out.

The next thing I knew, I saw a Mount Morris Police vehicle pull into the parking lot, two officers got out, and they both started helping me try to catch Cyrus. It was a GOD incident that they appeared so quickly! Now, there were five of us trying to contain Cyrus in the parking lot so he could stay safe. Cyrus is a smart dog, and is not easily fooled. Three of us were down low, me on my knees so that Cyrus would not be intimidated. He would come just close enough to us at different times but not close enough to grab him. The dollar store employee had to get back in the store and I thanked her for her help. (continued...)

Sharon, the 2 officers and myself continued to encourage Cyrus to come to us. Cyrus was on an adventure and was not ready to end it. Then a young girl got out of her family's vehicle that was parked near the bank. She playfully sat down on the grass, opened up her arms and called out to Cyrus. She did not try to bribe him with food instead she created a playful atmosphere. Even though Cyrus did not know her, he gently walked up to her. This caring girl grab his collar and held him until I reached her and I could put the leash on Cyrus now secure in my control. I thanked her and asked her name, she said Willow. I told her again, how grateful I was and that she was great with animals!

Cyrus did not get close enough to any of the adults, but he came up to a child. This was the second miracle! Because it was a holiday, Willow was out of school, and her family just happened to be at the bank when Cyrus was on his adventure. Only GOD knows how long it may have taken us to catch Cyrus if Willow had not been there. She had good instincts and was brave. Cyrus was non-aggressive the entire time of his adventure. However, when he is at home he is an amazing watchdog and can be intimidating to any strangers approaching the property

I thanked the officers, and Sharon and I walked back across the street to the Walgreen parking lot with Cyrus. I thanked Sharon so much for helping me. She stated that she would want someone to help her if she was in the same position. It was now 11:07 AM. I texted my sister that I had Cyrus and all was well.

I am first grateful that GOD protected Cyrus and all of us trying to catch him.

I am forever grateful to the five strangers who did not know me, but were willing to help me: Sharon, the dollar store employee, the two Mount Morris Police Officers and Willow.

On January 16, 2023, I experienced the kindness of strangers, which has added to the reasons I love living in Mount Morris! For pet owners, are pets are part of our family! So thanks again to the wonderful five strangers who helped my family!
