Piedmont Pets

January 19, 2023

We receive many notices about pets that have wandered away. We also see many more posts on social media about lost pets. Many owners tell us that their animal must have been stolen because their dog or cat has never just wandered away; however, most of the time the animal has become lost for a variety of reasons.

A dog will sometimes just follow a scent his nose has picked up, sometimes they have been scared by other animals, and sometimes they just wander away. Cats who are allowed outside can also become frightened by other animals or loud noises and run away in fear. In addition, cats do get into car engines and are given a very dangerous ride to destinations far away.

There are many reasons why dogs and cats become strays. The best line of defense is to provide a collar and identification information. Even in areas that permit dogs to wander require a current city or county tag. Microchipping a pet is becoming increasingly important because of the increase in people picking up strays and either keeping them or placing them in rescue groups.

If the worst happens and your dog or cat is missing, contact all animal shelters within a 50-mile radius. It may be very helpful to make copies of a recent picture and take them to the shelters. Sometimes, owners describe an animal and the person hearing the description gets a different picture in their mind. Coming to the shelter is wise.

People are beginning to rely just on social media, and this is not a good idea. Walk or drive through your

Most veterinary clinics will allow notices about lost pets to be placed on a bulletin board. advertisements in local newspapers and with radio stations. Include a lot of information about your pet, including age, sex, size, breed, and color. It is sometimes wise to leave out one identifying feature so if someone calls claiming to have found your pet, you would be able to spot calls from people who merely seek a monetary reward.

A reward for finding a returning a lost animal is always a good idea, and should be included on all notices and advertisements.

Life as a stray animal is not pleasant, and owners need to be diligent in doing everything they can to search for their pet and bring them safely home.

New identity unveiled for iconic White Mill at groundbreaking ceremony

The City of Danville and The Alexander Company held a groundbreaking ceremony on Thursday to celebrate the commencement of construction that will transform the long vacant White Mill in Danville's River District from its original role as part of a sprawling textile operation along the Dan River into a community hub with a mixture of complementary uses including housing, office, and retail, nestled within a planned new riverfront park to be enjoyed by all.

At the ceremony, "Dan River Falls" was unveiled as the site's new identity. The name is a nod to Dan River Fabrics, the textile powerhouse of which the White Mill was a part; Wynne's Falls, the name of the first settlement along the river that became Danville; and the use of the Dan River, the banks on which the mill building sits, as an economic engine.

Mayor Alonzo Jones made the announcement and proclaimed Thursday as "Dan River Falls Day" in the city.

"This monumental redevelopment effort that we celebrate today is injecting new energy and investment into a site that was left behind," Jones said of the mill building, which was Dan River Mill No. 8 but had been commonly referred to as the "White Mill." "Rather than cling to the name "White Mill," we celebrate the site's history along the Dan River and look toward its future."



Betty Lamps

Think how difficult it was before 1800, when you had to have light to work at night and there were only candles or several kinds of oil lamps. By the 1850s, it was easier. There were kerosene lamps, gas lamps and finally

electric lamps. The Betty lamp is one of the earliest portable light sources. It usually is made of brass or iron. The bottom layer is a pan that shapes to a point: the spout. A second pan is on top to hold the wick, usually a twisted piece of fabric placed in the spout to soak up some fuel. The lamp also has a hook so it can be hung on a wall.

Antique Betty lamps are sold in many auctions for \$40 to about \$150. A wrought iron, copper and brass Betty lamp sold at a recent Hess auction for \$2,000 after 21 bids. It was made by craftsman Peter Derr of Pennsylvania (1793-1868), making it a prize for a collector. A new, reproduced Betty lamp sells for about \$40 to \$100.

By 1910, it was the largest wholesaler and retailer of china and glassware in the U.S. The company sold commemorative plates for Lenox and other companies until about 1960. The border, signature or provenance can add value. Some sets have sold at auction for over \$1,000.




- * Make ice cubes out of punch when you are entertaining. I like to make different combinations, which can be adapted for adult and child parties. The other is to lower your electric bill, because the water heater will not have to work as hard to keep that big tank of water so hot. -- T.D. in New Mexico


