## Plan ahead for winter fishing outings on Mille Lacs Lake

An unusually warm January has led to some slush forming and water standing on Mille Lacs Lake. It is recommended that you call and speak to the resort owners, if you plan on a winter fishing outing.

### North Mille Lacs

James Dougherty, 35, manages the Red Door Resort on Mille Lacs' North Shore.

He said he has a system where they let out increasingly heavier vehicles and ice houses. "Currently, we are open to public traffic," he said.

"We run out of the north end of Mille Lacs. Our ice is fairly stable, obviously not

quite as thick as years past. We are open to the public with limited numbers. Conditions are good, some slush, a little flooding, but the ice is fairly stable."

Conditions, however, vary throughout the lake and some areas have restrictions.

Red Door has ice anglers register online and then they get plowed out when they arrive. The resort specializes in great service and renting out top-of-the-line houses, he said. "We have the staff and we are on duty from 4:30 a.m. to dark."

Now, they can handle one-ton trucks and tandem-axle wheelhouses. They are taking it day by day to see when diesels are allowed on the ice.

He said the bite was slowing now but they are hitting on small walleyes and perch.

"I know this year is tough on resorts due to the quality of ice. Some have more snow and water than others. Unfortunately, some places don't have their rentals out there yet. We have already had three weekends. If you are coming up to Mille Lacs,

call ahead and check with your resorts – they are out there pounding pavement every day to make sure it is safe. Definitely check with resorts before you venture out – some areas are no-go – there may be unsafe cracks."

### South Mille Lacs

Paul Wandowski manages Northern Skys, a resort with fish houses on the southeast shore.

"The conditions are good. There's lots of snow with

14-18 inches of ice under snow-covered areas, some slush and flooding. Our roads are open to all vehicle traffic with wheelhouses."

Wandowski said early season has been a decent bite. "Like most years, 10 percent of the anglers catch 90 percent of the fish. They need to get out and look for active fish. Guys that are doing that with snowmobiles and wheelers with tracks have been doing really well."

## Ice Fishing Extravaganza

The Brainerd Jaycees Ice Fishing Extravaganza in conjunction with local officials have been closely monitoring ice conditions and are excited to announce they are satisfactory for the Saturday, Jan. 28 contest.

Chairperson Tad Johnson states, "Our first and foremost priority is to ensure the safety of all participants, volunteers and community members. We are excited that mother nature has been on our side."

While ice conditions are acceptable on the contest site, the ice across Gull Lake, and many area lakes, is inconsistent. Please exercise caution when driving on

the lake, and always check depths to ensure your safety. Officials request that everyone in wheel houses leave ample room between each other, suggesting at least twenty feet between houses on ice.

First held in 1991, this event is hailed as the world's largest charitable ice fishing tournament; event organizers have donated over \$4.3 million to charities, most notably Confidence Learning Center, in its 32-year history. The volunteer-run event is organized by the Brainerd Jaycees who have over 50 members contributing more than 75,000

River Oaks Dental now occupies the former St. Joseph's Catholic church in Deerwood.

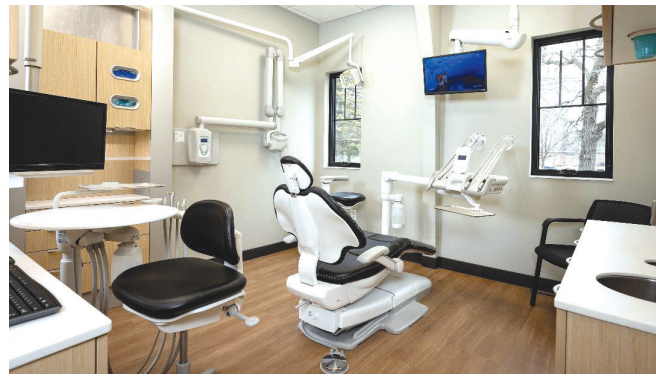

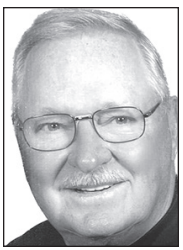
Shirley is survived by her children: Sheila

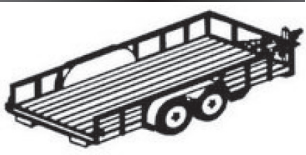
