TRAVERSING THE TACO TRAIL

s a Lake County resident for over 15 years, I've eaten at more restaurants in the area than I can remember. From lunch or dinner on my own to meetings for work to dining out with my family, I've been to restaurants in literally every city in the County. So, when our staff first started discussing the idea of promoting the numerous Mexican restaurants in our area. and the concept of creating a "Taco Trail" came up, I had to think back to how many different Mexican restaurants I had been to myself.

I can check off Don Tequila (Eastlake and Mentor), El Palenque, Taco Vago, Cocos Locos (Willoughby and Mentor), El Rodeo,





Compadres (Painesville Township), El Taco Macho, Barrio, and one trip to the original La Casita. Most people have their one or two "go-to" Mexican restaurants they visit when they're craving Mexican food so my 11 restaurants sounds like a lot right? Well, there were still 12 other authentic Mexican restaurants I had never visited! Seriously?! Yes, a total of 23 Mexican restaurants located in the smallest county by size in the state of Ohio!

So, it was time to get to work and traverse more restaurants along the Lake County Taco Trail. Some work assignments are more challenging than others. Working through budgeting, preparing for Board meetings or assembling a comprehensive marketing strategy for the year can be stressful at times. On the other hand, trying new authentic Mexican restaurants and eating tacos is a project that quickly moved to the top of the to-do list!

With our Remarkable Lake County, OH offices located in downtown Painesville, the heart of the Taco Trail, my staff and I are located within 10 minutes from many of the restaurants I had yet to visit. This list included La Mexicana, Picante, Casa Agave, El Paladar de Mexico, Cocina Elvis, La Cocina de Mama and the new La Casita.

First up, La Mexicana (El Senor's Tacos) which is only a block from our offices. Since my first visit to La Mexicana, I've probably ordered food from there a minimum of 25 times! Mostly a carryout

restaurant, plus a Mexican grocery store, their unique meat and vegetable offerings, extremely affordable prices and flavorful tacos make it an easy place to go back to again and again. My favorite tacos here are bistec (shredded beef) and tinga (shredded chicken) or try a torta for something a little different.

Picante and El Paladar de Mexico are both less than two blocks from the Painesville square and are great sit-down or carryout options. My favorite choice at El Paladar de Mexico is definitely the birria tacos and Picante has very unique and flavorful ground beef and chicken tacos. Picante will even give you the option for "American" tacos which come with lettuce and shredded cheese versus the traditional onions and cilantro on authentic tacos. Do me a favor if you go there...go traditional and skip the American tacos!

La Casita, which means "little house," moved into its beautifully renovated location in 2020 from a literal little house a block away from its current location in Painesville. I'll never forget my first trip to the original location with my son and wife where they were cooking tacos outside and dozens of people were sitting under a tent eating tacos. My wife, who isn't nearly as adventurous as me when it comes to food, wasn't so sure about La Casita so she said she was going to pass. So, my son and I ordered our food to go and we took it home. The second we got home and opened our tacos, the amazing



smell of chicken and chorizo filled my kitchen, and my wife instantly regretted her decision. I only got to eat half of my order that night because I politely shared my food with my wife, and she's never missed a trip to La Casita since. The new location is amazing and features the same authentic food in a clean, bright dining room adjacent to their grocery store. La Casita should be on your "must-visit" list as their al pastor and chicken are absolutely amazing. The restaurant has been honored with numerous awards during its time and you'll understand why after just one visit. For locals, stop by the store and grab a pound or two of their prepackaged, marinated meats (chicken, al pastor, or chorizo), cheese and homemade tortillas and make your own delicious tacos at home.

The next stop on the Taco Trail was Casa Agave which was a lunch visit with my co-workers and we tried a little bit of everything on the menu. Al pastor, shrimp and carne asada were the flavors-of-theday at Casa Agave and no one left hungry with the generous lunch portions. Casa Agave is located in a busy shopping plaza, but don't let that fool you as you'll find a clean, beautiful interior inside with a large bar featuring numerous Mexican draft beers and a large selection of tequilas.

A similar story can be told about El Taco Macho which is located in the adjacent shopping plaza to Casa Agave. The interior of El Taco Macho is Luche librethemed with bright colors and luchador masks located throughout the restaurant. This is one of my family's favorite locations on the Taco Trail and my go-to options here include the birria tacos or if I'm really hungry, the Macho Quesadilla which is filled with amazing, chicken, chorizo and cheese.

Other restaurants I've recently trekked to as part of the Taco Trail include Wild Burrito, Condado Tacos, Azteca, and Hola Tacos. Wild Burrito features a beautiful Tex-Mex themed interior and a beautiful bar area. This newer restaurant has already garnered an extremely loyal local following along with welcoming many guests who are in the area visiting the wineries of the Grand River Valley which are mere minutes from the restaurant.

Condado Tacos, Azteca and Hola Tacos are all relatively new restaurants and feature a little more modern feel inside with each restaurant putting their own unique spin on Mexican cuisine. Condado has really diverse flavor pairings and shell offerings for their tacos as well as amazing queso! Try the queso...trust me! The outdoor patio at Azteca is terrific on a nice day and a great spot to enjoy a cerveza or margarita along with an



amazing meal. Hola Tacos is bold and bright inside with a robust menu full of flavorful options and they also have a sister craft brewery on-site, Pulpo Beer. I personally love good craft beers and the brewery specializes in taking traditional craft beer styles and putting their own Latin-inspired twist on them. While every beer I've tried here is remarkable, my favorites are their Morir-Sonando, a Hazy IPA with an orange creamsicle flavor and their Pulpo Libre which is a lighter, easy-drinking Mexican lager so you can have a couple with your amazing tacos.

While I'd love to write detailed descriptions about all of my travels along the Lake County Taco Trail, I assure you eating tacos is better than reading about them! So, if you're a "local" I'm challenging you to step outside your comfort zone a little bit and the next time you're in the mood for Mexican food, start your own journey on the Taco Trail and try a new Mexican restaurant here in Lake County. If you're visiting or thinking about visiting the area, I guarantee you the tacos are worth the trip and you won't go wrong visiting any of the 23 Mexican restaurants along the Lake County Taco Trail!

MUST TRY TACOS

Feeling Adventurous? Our restaurants have your traditional favorites like Bistec, Chorizo and Al Pastor but there are also some very unique tacos for those brave enough to try them!

Tacos de Cabeza

Cabeza refers to an entire, cooked head of an animal, usually of a cow though sometimes of a pig. For tacos de cabeza, the entire cow's head is slowroasted until the meat that surrounds the skull becomes fall-apart tender.

Tacos de Tripa

Tripas, in Mexican cuisine (known as chitterlings in English-speaking countries), are the small intestines of farm animals that have been cleaned, boiled and grilled.

Tacos de Buche

Tacos de buche are Mexican pork stomach tacos. Tacos made from offal, organ meats, are a hallmark of taquerias.

Tacos de Lengua

Classic Mexican tacos de lengua, beef tongue which has been braised with garlic and onions, finely chopped.

Tacos con Nopales con Papas

Nopalito con papas is a Mexican taco featuring cactus and potatoes.



Fall Color and Scenic Rivers Winter Sports

Fall brings brilliant reds, oranges and yellows to the maple-beech-birch forests of Lake County, and the temperate weather makes it the perfect season for a rugged hike. The 981-acre Hell Hollow Wilderness Area is alive with foliage and offers stunning views across the park's densely forested, 100-foot-deep glacial ravine. Hogback Ridge's Hemlock Loop trail bursts with golden leaves in mid-October. Chagrin River Park's varied habitats bring forest and riparian tree species together for spectacular fall colors.

Another way to make the most of autumn's splendor is to see it by canoe or kayak. Even during dry years, the fall foliage is often most spectacular in the river bottoms and flood plains of the Grand and Chagrin rivers. Both rivers form deep gorges, with sandstone and shale cliffs adding to the natural beauty. A popular paddle on the Chagrin River starts at North Chagrin Reservation and ends seven miles downstream at Daniels Park, A Grand River route often casts off below Harpersfield Dam and ends either at Hidden Valley Park for a moderate eight-mile paddle or Indian Point Park for a longer challenge. Canoe rentals are

available on both rivers.

When winter rolls around, snow is abundant in Lake County, especially in the higher elevations at the southern edge of the county. That means the immense Lake Metroparks system becomes a haven for cross country skiers, snowshoers and winter hikers. Chapin Forest Reservation in Kirtland is home to 6 miles of groomed snow trails, with skis and snowshoes available to rent at the park's Pine Lodge





Springtime Wildflowers and Birding

Spring brings blooms of all kinds to Lake County's unique ecological landscape. Between April and June, find spring ephemerals like Ohio's state flower, the trillium, spring beauty and the trout lily. From mid-April to mid-May, explore carpets of bluebells at both Indian Point Park in Painesville and Hogback Ridge Park in Madison.

The marshes and beaches of Lake Erie are vitally important staging grounds for migratory birds as they make their way north from their winter homes. Lake County is home to three parks designated as Important Bird Areas by Audubon Ohio — Chagrin River Park, Hell Hollow Wilderness Area and Girdled Road Reservation. Lake Erie Bluffs Park features a 50-foot observation tower with sweeping vistas over the coastline. Spot loons and bald eagles in March, sparrows and warblers in April and orioles and tanagers in May.

No off seasons here!

No matter what time of year you visit, Lake County is jam-packed with experiences that help you connect to nature.

Summer Beach Days and Canopy Walks

The summer sun beckons many people to Lake County's beautiful beaches. Headlands Beach State Park is the longest stretch of natural sand beach in Ohio, and the adjacent Headland Dunes State Nature Preserve is also an important habitat for sea birds. Lake Erie Bluffs and Lakeshore Reservation offer secluded beachy coves and excellent sea glass hunting.

At 3,600 acres, Holden Arboretum in Kirtland is one of the largest arboretums and botanical gardens in the United States — 19 miles of trails traverse various ecosystems and gardens. Lace up your shoes before climbing the 120-foot tall Kalberger Emergent Tower, which offers panoramic views all the way to Lake, then head over to the 500-foot-long Murch Canopy Walk and hang out amongst the treetops on an elevated walkway 65 feet above the forest floor. Back on the ground, Holden Arboretum's botanical collection includes more than 10,000 plant species. Its rhododendron collection is a particular standout.

MADISON VILLAGE


