Easy Mushroom Soup

3 tablespoons butter 2 garlic cloves, minced 1 shallot, finely chopped 4 ounces crimini mushrooms,

chopped 4 ounces white button mushrooms,

2 tablespoons all-purpose flour 3 cups chicken stock



Melt 2 tablespoons butter in a large pot over medium-high heat. Add the garlic and shallot, cook for 1 minute. Add the mushrooms and cook for about 3 minutes, until tender and browned. Transfer all the contents of the pot to a bowl. Add the remaining 1 tablespoon of butter to the pot. Once melted, sprinkle in the flour and



time, whisking out the clumps between each addition. Increase the heat to medium-high and allow the soup to simmer for 3 minutes. Add the mushrooms back to the pot and continue to cook for 2 minutes more until creamy. Let cook for 3 to 4 minutes, then ladle into bowls. Garnish with mushrooms and

Winter Games have come and gone!

As we were out-of-town late last week, we had no real first-hand experience of this year's J of O Winter Games. Even with the frigid temperatures, though, we understand fun had by all. Buttons and Bows was penned by Jay Livingston and Ray Evans, for the 1948 Paramount Studios motion picture, The Paleface, starring Bob Hope and Jane Russell. Not only was B&B a Number One Hit, for Dinah Shore, but it also won an Academy Award as Best Original Song of the Year!

1,000 Books Before Kindergarten

The Spirit Lake Public Library invites you to participate in this free program which encourages you to read 1,000 books with your child before s/he starts kindergarten.

The concept is simple; the rewards are priceless. Read a book (any book) to your newborn, infant, toddler, or preschooler. The goal is to read 1,000 books (yes, you can repeat books!), before your little one starts kindergarten.



Does it sound hard? Not really, if you think about it. If you read just one book a night, you will have read 365 books in a year. That is 730 books in two years, and 1,095 books in three years. If you consider that most children start kindergarten at around 5 years of age, you have more time than you think. But you must get started!

You begin by stopping by the Spirit Lake Public Library to register. You will receive all the program materials, including a reading log. The friendly library staff will help you and answer any questions that you may have. Next, begin reading with your child! Studies have shown that reading with our children provides a great opportunity for bonding. Reading together is fun and will create life-long memories for both of you. Keep track of the titles you read on the log. If you are able, record all books being read to your child. This includes teachers, siblings, babysitters, etc. After you finish each sheet of 100 books, bring it and the folder to the SLPL. The log will be signed and dated by library staff, and you will receive a sticker for the folder to represent the 100 books read. Then with a new reading log in-hand, you can continue to read more books. At different milestones along the journey, your child will receive some special extra rewards.

After you complete that 1,000th book, come back to the library. Your child will receive a certificate and will be recognized on the 1,000 Books Wall of Fame. Annually, all "graduates" of the program will receive an invitation to a celebration that is held at the Spirit Lake Elementary School. After that, just keep reading! Literacy and a love of books are great gifts we can give to all our children!

To The Editor:

'The Lakes News Shopper' and the 'Dickinson County News' have both had articles and notices reminding snowmobilers that snowmobiling on private property without the property owner consent is prohibited. That said, two weekends in a row, in four separate instances, I have had snowmobilers on my personal property. First and second, on Saturday, January 21st, at about 4:15pm, I had a group of 6 or 7 snowmobilers, heading north, go through my side yard and out between young lilac bushes. One lilac lost half its branches on one side and 3 others had several branches broken off. At least one member of the group drove almost the entire length of my side yard before turning to go through the lilac bushes. Given my side yard is not very wide, they were within a few feet of my house and AC unit. Then, at about 8:15PM a group heading south came through. This time, in addition to going through the lilac bushes and doing more damage, at least one rider did a circle around the spruce tree in my backyard. I called the police both times to report the incidents. Third, on Friday, January 27th at about 8:00PM a group heading north came through. This time they went the length of my side yard, between a pile of snow and my house, out over my sidewalk and driveway, across the street, up over the pile of snow at the end of the driveway across the street and through the neighbor's yard. The tracks left in my yard are within inches of the corner of my house, AC unit and gas meter; the downspout on the corner of my house has been run over and squashed. Again, I called the police to report the incident. Fourth, on Saturday, January 28th at about 11:30AM a single snowmobiler came up my driveway diagonally and used the track left by the group the night before. And, yes, the police were called again. (I thank the Spirit Lake Police for their prompt response all four times.) I'm writing this to ask snowmobilers of all ages and event organizers to be good neighbors by respecting private property and ensuring event participants know they are not to be on private property.



The cold and snow can limit opportunities to get on our bikes and enjoy the

great cross country skiing trails in the Iowa Great Lakes to enjoy during the winter months. Groomed trails are available at Brooks Golf Course up to the Dickinson County Nature Center and at Kettleson Hogsback WMA on the west side of Big Spirit Lake.

The Brooks-Nature Center Trail offers classic (traditional) cross country ski tracks and a wide skate

ski lane. Recently, the DCTB sold our old snowmobile at Hogsback which enabled us to get a new groomer and track setter

at this location. It was a much needed improvement to the operation that was also supported by a number of donations trails, however, we are fortunate to have to our cross country skiing fund.

DNR area, in my mind, is probably one of the best areas that I know of in Northwest Iowa to cross country ski. There are flat trails, somewhat hilly trails, and one loop that has 2-3 big hills that are pretty challenging. All told, there is just shy of five kilometers of skiable trails, all on public land. We have been setting classic

tracks for over 15 years now and, being in the woods, it is fairly protected from

the wind making for more comfortable skiing on windy days. And, there is usually wildlife to be seen as well." Hoien adds, "This year is one of the best snow years I have seen in years, if not decades, and the skiing has been excellent. Being skiers as well, we always get out to groom the best trails we can as the weather allows, and people have really come to enjoy it." These trails are possible thanks to local

volunteers Bob Waters, Eric Hoien and Finley Hoien along with support from the DCTB. The DCTB continues to provide updates on snow and trail conditions on our Facebook site as well.
