Motion clocks

Most clocks have hands that move to tell the time, but a group of clocks that also had moving eyes were popular about 1850. Most of these figural iron clocks were made by Bradley and Hubbard of Meriden, Connecticut. A few others were made by Chauncey Jerome. The clocks are popular with collectors because they are so entertaining yet, because they are iron, hard to damage.

This owl motion clock with green glass eyes that move back and forth in a silver-plated case sold in 2021 for \$1,900 in a Morford's auction. Twentieth-century clocks with moving eyes have been made of wood or plastic, and some modern versions feature cats, dogs or cartoon characters. But the clock with moving eyes that is most remembered because it was used in many nurseries for the past 79 years is the black plastic cat called the Kit-Cat Klock. It was first made in 1932, and new versions are still made.

Q. My son got Capcom's "Resident Evil" PlayStation game for Christmas in 1996. It fell behind an entertainment system and was found about four years ago. We've taken it to many places to find out the value, but have been told no one has ever seen a sealed copy of this game, and they couldn't even begin to give us a price. Rarity, desirability and condition determine the price. They sell better if they have been graded by an authorized company. Games that are the first in a series or are sealed in the original package usually sell for more than a used copy of the same game. Contact an auction house that sells video games to see if they can give you an idea of the value. An unopened copy of Nintendo's 1985 "Super Mario Bros." game, graded 9.4

Chatham High School Varsity Wrestling competes at the 2023 Highlander Invitational

Danville, Virginia - The Chatham High School varsity wrestling team traveled to Salem, Virginia, on Saturday, January 28 for the 2023 Highlander Invitational. The invitational featured 15 teams and approximately 224 athletes in an aggressive one day format. The meet was hosted at Glenvar High School and featured many of the top teams in western Virginia.



As a 2A division school, Chatham competed against other 2A, 3A, 4A, and 5A schools. Annual 1A powerhouse Grundy High School won the invitational with six firsts, three seconds, one third, and five 5th place finishes. CHS managed one 3rd place and three sixth place finishes.



The CHS varsity wrestling program is in its second year under the guidance of Coach Marcus Clements. He entered the tournament to push his young team, build experience, and prepare them mentally for Regional and State competition.

“One goal was to humble them and season them for Regionals,” Coach Clements said. “I was hoping for growth and I got that. Going into the next week, I want a rest week, touch on the small things, and be detail oriented.”

Regionals are scheduled for February 11th. Regionals is a qualifying meet for the CHS’ state tournament at the Salem Civic Center on February 16-17.

Sophomore Matthew Marlowe took top honors for the team with a 3rd place in the 157 weight class. He only fell to Glenvar’s Jake Cline, the 157 tournament winner.

“When he is patient, Matthew is one of the best wrestlers in the state,” Clements said. Going into this week I knew he was going to face a tough opponent, a past state champion. And afterward, I feel confident about his postseason chances.”

Every member of the CHS team faced a big challenge at the Highlander Invitational. The team gained valuable experience with higher level competition. Three team members broke through and made it to the final rounds. They were Colin Bisson (126), Tyler Medlin (120), and Sam Wiebking (190). Each wrestler earned a 6th place finish.

“I’m pleased with how the team performed. Just placing in this tournament was a feat in itself,” Clements said. “We had several upsets led primarily by Colin Bisson, Shauntae Pyles (132), and Sam Wiebking.”

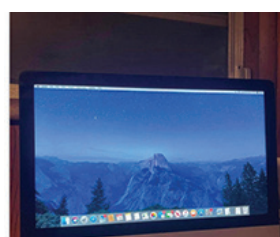



Broccoli Cheddar Soup

Ingredients

- 1/4 cup unsalted butter
- 1 softball sized yellow onion chopped
- 1/4 cup flour
- 3 cups chicken stock
- 1 cup milk
- 1 cup heavy cream
- 5 cups chopped broccoli (both the florets and stalks)
- 1 cup grated sharp cheddar cheese*
- salt
- black pepper

Instructions

In a large pot, melt the butter over medium heat. Add the chopped onion, season with 1/4 tsp salt, and cook for 5 minutes, until the onions are soft and translucent. Stir in the flour until it combines into a blond paste, and cook for two minutes. Turn the heat to high and add the chicken stock, milk, and heavy cream. Bring this mixture to a boil, then reduce to a simmer. Add the broccoli and simmer for 10 minutes, until the broccoli is tender. Remove the pot from the heat, and stir in the cheddar. Taste and make any necessary seasoning adjustments with salt and pepper. Enjoy!

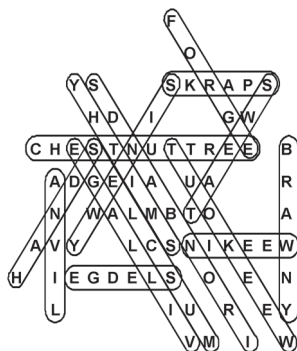

In fact, making smart choices when cooking at home can give you more control over the types of tasty, heart-healthy dishes you put on the table. High cholesterol is one of the major controllable risk factors for heart disease and stroke, with about 38% of American adults diagnosed with high cholesterol, according to the American Heart Association. These cooking tips can help you prepare heart-healthy meals that could help improve cholesterol levels by reducing excess saturated fat and trans fat.

Cook Fresh Vegetables the Heart-Healthy Way

Roasting, steaming, grilling or baking can help bring out the natural flavors of vegetables. Adding herbs and spices can also help make veggies tastier, including combinations like basil with tomatoes, oregano with zucchini, dill with green beans or rosemary with peas and cauliflower.

Reduce Saturated Fat in Meat and Poultry

The amount of saturated fat in meats can vary widely, depending on the cut and how it's prepared. Opt for poultry and fish over red meat and look for lean cuts of meat with minimal visible fat, which

should be trimmed away before cooking. Also limit processed meats such as sausage, bologna, salami and hot dogs, which are often high in calories, saturated fat and sodium.

Use Liquid Vegetable Oils in Place of Solid Fats

Some fats are better for you than others. Liquid vegetable oils such as canola, safflower, sunflower, soybean and olive oil can often be used instead of solid fats, such as butter, lard or shortening. If you must use margarine, try the soft or liquid kind.

Frozen Yogurt Bark

Servings: 8

- 1 1/2 cups 2% low-fat plain Greek yogurt
- 2 tablespoons honey
- 2 tablespoons chopped, unsalted almonds
- 1/2 cup chopped mango
- 1/4 cup blackberries or raspberries
- 1/2 cup blueberries

In medium bowl, mix yogurt and honey.

Line 9-by-13-inch baking dish with parchment paper. Use spatula or knife to spread yogurt over entire bottom of dish.

Pour chopped nuts over yogurt. Use fingers to slightly press into yogurt. Top yogurt with mango, blackberries and blueberries and slightly press into yogurt.

Cover with plastic wrap or foil and place in freezer overnight.

To serve: Lift parchment paper from baking dish onto cutting board. Use hands to break bark into pieces.

Grilled Tequila-Lime Chicken with Grilled Asparagus

Recipe courtesy of the American Heart Association
Servings: 4

- 1/4 cup tequila or white vinegar
- 2 teaspoons lime zest
- 1/2 cup fresh lime juice
- 2 medium garlic cloves, minced
- 1 tablespoon chipotle pepper canned in adobo sauce, minced, plus 2 tablespoons adobo sauce
- 1 1/2 pounds boneless, skinless chicken breasts, fat discarded
- nonstick cooking spray
- 3 bunches asparagus spears, trimmed
- 1/4 teaspoon salt
- 1/2 teaspoon black pepper, divided
- 2 tablespoons canola oil or corn oil

In small bowl, stir tequila, lime zest, lime juice, garlic, chipotle pepper and adobo sauce. Pour into large resealable plastic bag. Add chicken and seal bag tightly; turn bag to coat. Refrigerate 2-12 hours.

Preheat grill to medium-high heat. Lightly spray grates with nonstick cooking spray. In large dish, sprinkle asparagus with salt and 1/4 teaspoon pepper. Drizzle with oil. Turn asparagus over to coat.

Remove chicken from marinade. Discard marinade and wipe most of it off chicken. Sprinkle chicken with remaining pepper.

Grill 8-12 minutes, or until chicken is no longer pink in center. Transfer to plate and cover with aluminum foil.

Place asparagus on grill, facing opposite direction of grates. Grill 7 minutes, or until tender crisp.

Serve asparagus with chicken.
