

60-DAY NOTICE OF INTENT TO FILE AN APPLICATION

AES Clean Energy Development, LLC ("AES") is proposing to construct the Somerset Solar Project, a major solar electric generating facility, under Section 94-c of the Executive Law (Section 94-c). This notice announces that on or about April 4, 2023, AES intends to file an Application with the Office of Renewable Energy Siting (ORES or the Office), pursuant to Section 94-c seeking a Siting Permit from the Office authorizing the construction and operation of the Project. The 94-c process has been implemented by rules enacted by the Office and establishes a review process with uniform standards and conditions for all renewable energy projects. The uniform standards and conditions are available at 19 NYCRR 900-6 and www.ores.ny.gov/regulations.

The Somerset Solar Project is proposed to be an approximately 125 megawatt (MW) solar photovoltaic electric generating facility proposed to be located in the Town of Somerset, Niagara County, New York (the "Project"). The Project will span approximately 693 acres ("Facility Site"). The Project is anticipated to positively impact both the environment and the local economy by reducing carbon dioxide emissions by an estimated 131,000 metric tons each year – the equivalent of taking approximately 28,000 cars off the road – and producing significant tax revenue and other economic benefits for the area. The Facility will include, among other components, solar panels, access roads, substation, inverters, transformers, electrical collection lines, and temporary construction staging and storage areas.

Upon filing the Application, AES will provide funding in the amount of \$1,000/MW proposed in the Application to be deposited into a local agency account to be made available to local agencies and potential community intervenors for the purpose of contributing to a complete record leading to an informed permit decision as to the appropriateness of the site and the facility, and for local agencies, shall include the use of funds to determine whether a proposed facility is designed to be sited, constructed and operated in compliance with applicable local laws and regulations. 19 NYCRR 900-5.1

Any local agency or potential community intervenor shall submit a request for initial funding within thirty (30) days of the date of application filing and such requests can be made to:



Main Street lift bridge removed in Albion

ALBION - In the top photo a massive crane on Jan. 27 picks up the two trusses on the Main Street lift bridge in Albion. Clark Rigging & Rental used a big crane with a 400-ton capacity to lift the 53,000-pound trusses, which were set on land on the north side of the canal. The corroded steel beams will be removed and replaced with new steel. Much of the bottom part of the trusses and other beams are badly deteriorated from road salt and from more than a century of use. The removal of the bridge means there isn't a sturdy span over the canal on Main Street for the first time since at least 1914. When the bridge was built in 1913-1914, there was a temporary companion bridge next to it to allow for some traffic. This could be the first time since the Sept. 28, 1859 bridge collapse that there isn't a bridge on the canal on Main Street. Workers will put new steel on the bridge and it could be

reset on Main Street in August or September, said Jon Long, the engineer in charge for the state Department of Transportation. The bridge closed to traffic in November for the 18-month rehabilitation project. A similar effort will start in April in Brockport. The state DOT is paying \$28.3 million to contractors for the two projects.



Travel Thoughts By Kim Let's go on an adventure together....Hunting For Treasures!

I admit, when I travel I do enjoy visiting the tourist spots - you know, those places that are famous (or infamous) that everyone wants to see at least once in their life. But, I also like to seek out what makes wherever I am stand out from any other place. I like to find the quirky little out of the way place you can only find there or someplace that tells a story of that town's past or showcases local heroes, artists, or chefs.

So, I like to do my homework before I go. I like to visit the area's tourism website and also Google the area to see what comes up. I also visit sites like TripAdvisor to search for "Things To Do" in the area and use the website "Roadside America" to find the not-so-well known points of interest. If I have a car, I take time to just drive around town

looking for murals, statues, and signs pointing me to points of interest that didn't come up on any searches. If I don't have a car, I try to do tours, such as hop-on-hop-off type bus tours or other ways to see the local attractions - my hotel usually will have lots of great suggestions, too.

I get especially excited when I find things like art walks or themes throughout a town or city. Here are just a few of the cool things I've found in my travels:

Rapid City, SD has branded itself "City of the Presidents" to build on the Mount Rushmore attraction. Downtown Rapid City has a wonderful life-sized statue of a President on every street corner representing every President in a pose that showcases his personality. My two favorites were John F. Kennedy depicted walking with young John-John holding a toy airplane and Abraham Lincoln sitting in a chair with his young son kneeling beside him in a Civil War costume and Lincoln handing him a toy canon.

Plymouth, MA had sculptures of huge lobsters hand painted by local artists scattered throughout their downtown area. There was one painted like a rock star holding a guitar above his head, one painted like a sea captain, and others with historic scenes on them.

San Francisco, CA had an ongoing annual fundraiser called "Hearts of San Francisco" with large hearts painted by local artists that sell for enormous sums of money to benefit vulnerable residents through a fund associated with Zuckerberg San Francisco General Hospital. At the time I was there, the hearts have raised over \$220 million to date and can be found throughout the city. One in particular caught my eye when I was there in 2017 that was painted by singer Tony Bennett and sold for about \$3 million!

In Louisville, KY, I found Cave Hill Cemetery a gorgeous garden styled cemetery established in the mid-1800s. It has rolling hills, lakes, streams, abundance of nature, and lots of stunning statues and memorials - some of the most unusual memorials I've ever seen! It is where Muhammad Ali and Colonel Sanders of KFC fame are buried. I spent a couple hours driving through and looking at all the cool statues and memorials. It was quite

Sioux Falls, SD has an amazing Sculpture Walk through their downtown area. Some sculptures depicted historical references of the area, some were quirky, some cultural, and some were even interactive. The sculptures line multiple streets in the downtown section of the city and is worth the stroll to see them all.

In Dubuque, IA, I enjoyed a stroll along the city's River Walk on the banks of the mighty Mississippi River looking at various sculptures created by local artists and loads of art scattered throughout the downtown area.

These are just a few examples...I find wonderful treasures like these just about everywhere I go! Many cities and towns across the country love to showcase their local artists and history with murals, art walks, and themes. Even our own Albion has the beautiful downtown benches painted locally and the wonderful Santa themed murals downtown. Another fairly local example is the town of Chittenango, NY - the birthplace of L. Frank Baum - author of the Wizard of Oz books. They have yellow brick sidewalks, loads of Oz themed shops, and a wonderful Oz themed library - they even have an annual Ozstravaganza festival the first weekend in June
