

BRIEF DESCRIPTION OF THE PROJECT

MRSEC will construct the Facility in the Town of Mount Morris in Livingston County. When completed, the Project will be comprised of 14 solar arrays with a proposed area of approximately 700 acres and a maximum generating capacity of approximately 177 MW. The Project will also consist of approximately 24 miles of perimeter fencing, 8 miles of access roads, a 23-mile 34.5 kilovolt (kV) collection line corridor linking the Facility's inverters, and a collection substation and point of interconnection (POI) switchyard. All Facility components will be located within an area encompassing approximately 2,720 acres (the "Facility Site").

CONSTRUCTION SCHEDULE






