

BHS alumna receives Minnesota women in sports award 'punches above their weight'



Sherece (Shari) Lamke, Brainerd High School alumna, was named a 2023 National Girls & Women in Sports Day Minnesota award winner.

The honorees, representing some of Minnesota's most inspiring and influential individuals, groups, and organizations in girls' & women's sports, was recognized at the National Girls & Women in Sports Day - Minnesota Celebration on February 1.

Lamke will received Kwame McDonald Media Award at the 37th Annual celebration event.

Kwame McDonald was a civil rights activist and pioneer in covering women's sports. This award is presented to members of the media or Minnesota media

outlets that have consistently provided coverage that both promotes and supports girls' and women's sports.

Lamke started her career in television with Twin Cities PBS in 1982 where she worked her way from the Master Control Operator to Director of Operations and Managing Director of Production Services. While there, she helped launch the Minnesota Channel, where she worked with the U of M's Tucker Center for Research on Girls and Women in Sport. She worked with the Tucker Center to use their data in the creation of three documentaries that have all been nominated for regional Emmys, and her documentary 'Media Coverage and Female Athletes' won the Sports

Documentary Emmy in 2015. In 2021, Lamke accepted a position as the President and General Manager at Pioneer PBS in Granite Falls. PBS President Paula Kerger once commented that Pioneer
