
IN MEMORIAM







Is tea or coffee the healthier choice?

Millions of people consume coffee or tea, with some even enjoying multiple cups of these caffeinated beverages daily. Coffee is known to perk a person up in the morning, while tea is touted as a relaxing drink that can ease away stress. Some may wonder if one of these popular beverages is more beneficial for



overall health than the other. Both, it turns out, have distinctive benefits.

Coffee and certain teas contain caffeine, a powerful stimulant for the central nervous system. Caffeine may improve endurance exercise outcomes and improve mental alertness. Healthline says that caffeine may reduce type 2 diabetes risk by improving insulin sensitivity. In addition, moderate caffeine intake has been linked to protective effects against dementias, metabolic syndrome and non-alcoholic fatty liver disease. Since coffee tends to have higher concentrations of caffeine than black tea (95 mg vs. 47 mg in an eight-ounce serving), it can provide more caffeine-related benefits than tea.

Both tea and coffee have high levels of antioxidants that can help people reduce their risk for certain illnesses. Tea may help lower cholesterol and the polyphenols in tea could boost good bacteria in the gut, according to Eat This, Not That! Since tea has less caffeine, it might make for a better choice.

Fill it up. And let's start this day right... TOGETHER!

She explained that she had noticed that some people who had come in after us were already finished and paying their bill so she went to find out about our order only to We assured her that it wasn't a problem and that we were not upset. We also asked what her husband's name was so that we could pause and pray for him right then. After we finished our meal and went to leave she cashed us out and proceeded to give each of us hugs stating that we were the perfect table for that to happen to.

Now you might not think that we would enjoy being labeled as the perfect table to have our ticket lost but it was obviously a compliment, not only because of how we responded but also because of how we didn't respond. Think about it... we could have been angry, we could have demanded that we get our food for free, we could have not left a tip, we could have got up and left, or we could have passive aggressively posted a bad review on social media. There are a number of ways that we could have reacted poorly in the moment, and I wish I could tell you that I have never been guilty of any of these things in the past, but any negative reaction would not have allowed us to offer comfort and kindness to someone who was obviously in need of both. Beyond that, how bad would we have felt after finding out the reason behind our order being lost?

I know that we all have times when we get busy and ate not as kind or as patient as we would normally be but it is in those moments that we have the opportunity to positively affect someone's day by purposely slowing down, trying to picture the situation from the other person's point of view, and then treating them the way that we would want to be treated. Go on and give it a try because, as Aesop the famous fable writer once observed, "No act of kindness, no matter how small, is ever wasted."




