To All Who Responded to Our Recent Fire

February 15th started as any other normal day on Silver Meadows Farm. The cattle were milked, their pens cleaned, bedded down, and the feed bunks filled. As fate would have it, that day would turn into everything except normal. As the fire scene unfolded, the face of Silver Meadows Farm would be changed forever. The old farmstead that has stood overlooking silver lake for almost 200 years would not see the end of the day.

For generations, those barns housed cattle and produced milk. They've stored hay, straw, oats keeping everything dry for countless New York winters. For the last 50 years they've raised the young calves breathing new life into the dairy farm. They have given many of us stories that will last a lifetime... If only those massive old hand-hewn beams could talk...

We watched the smoke roll away in plumes, carrying with it the end of an era. To really comprehend all that burned in such a quick amount of time would take days, but what happened almost immediately after the fire call went out was nothing short of extraordinary.

Within minutes there were fire trucks in the driveway, and before long the line of fire companies stretched a half mile down West Lake Rd. Almost as soon, the firemen arrived, our farm driveways started to fill with trucks, cattle trailers, and an entire local community of people who dropped everything they were doing that day just to come and help. A small army of people rallied to corral the loose cattle, treated the injured, and make sure everything was safe! As the Firemen beat down the flames and saved any more buildings from being consumed, food and water poured in from unknown donors all afternoon, to ensure all that came to help would have something to eat.

Watching those barns burn was emotional, but to see the astounding response to tragedy from the entire county and beyond was enough to bring anyone to tears. To attempt to name all of you that sacrificed your day to lend a hand, that brought food or supplies, and gave words of encouragement and support.... would be fruitless. On behalf of the Klein Family, and all at Silver Meadows Farm, we want to give out the most humbling, and sincere thank you to everyone. There are no words that can express our gratitude for what everyone did that day.

On the evening of February 15th, at around 6pm, all of our cows were brought back into the barn. By 9 o'clock ... the cattle were milked, their pens cleaned, bedded down, and the feed bunks filled. February 15th reminded us of what an exceptional amazing community we live in.

We will forever be in your debt, and forever be thankful!



The Opossum

North America's only marsupial is our opossum. Their babies migrate to the pouch when they are the size of a bee and mature over eighty days. They are not a rat. Their tails are fifth limbs. They have higher intelligence than most pets and groom themselves often. They only live a couple years or so and are so beneficial to our environment. If you had lyme disease just once, you'd want many of them out there destroying ticks.


