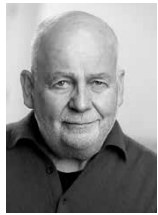

William O. Brownell, PhD, age 79, formerly of Medina and New York City, entered rest on Feb. 20, 2023. Born Oct. 31, 1943, in Buffalo, he was a son of the late Abbott F. and Louise (O'Donnell) Brownell. He graduated from Fay School, Class of 1958, where he had been a trustee, and Phillips Exeter Academy, Class of 1962. An international scholar with both military and academic experience, Dr. Brownell served in Vietnam with the U.S. Army from 1966-68 as a translator/interpreter. He earned a BA from Cornell University and later obtained a Doctorate in International Affairs at Columbia University in New York City under Roger Hilsman, President Kennedy's Undersecretary of State for Asia. Dr. Brownell studied in Europe for several years and earned awards as a French literary translator. He was the author of the book *So Close to Greatness: The Biography of William C. Bullitt* (1988). He co-authored the book *The First Nazi: Erich Ludendorff, The Man Who Made Hitler Possible* (2016) with Denise Drace-Brownell. Considered by his colleagues and students to have a powerful mind with a capacity to quickly understand a wide range of complicated concepts, Dr. Brownell was a beloved teacher, academic contributor, and mentor. He shared a passion with Denise Drace-Brownell, his wife and longtime companion for their work in binocular vision disorder and climate change. In addition to his parents, he was predeceased by his brother, Abbott Brownell, Jr. Survivors include his sister, Teresa "Terri" Brownell of St. Petersburg, FL; brother, George Brownell of Medina; and several other extended family members. 

When planning spring landscapes, homeowners should always group plants with similar water needs together. According to the U.S. Department of Energy, grouping plants with similar water needs together helps to conserve water, which can be an especially useful strategy if or when drought restrictions go into effect in summer. Homeowners also can embrace additional strategies to landscape with water conservation in mind. For example, aerating soil helps to improve water flow to plants' roots and reduces water runoff, helping to ensure that plants get all of the water they need while reducing the likelihood that homeowners will have to use excessive amounts of water to keep plants healthy. In addition, using low-water-using types of grass can help homeowners who live in areas prone to drought conserve water while still maintaining lush, green lawns. ■



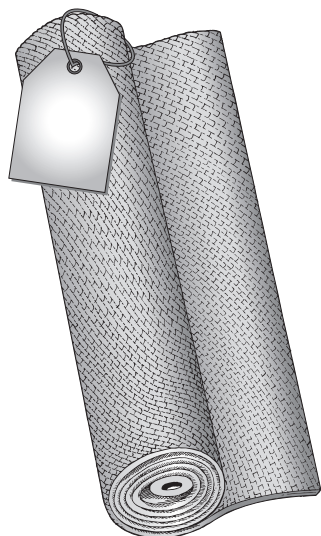

Back in 2011 some members of my church decided to start a Couch to 5K program for the community called "Run 4 God". Some of you may have participated as it was very popular at the time. The goal was to get people physically fit in time to finish The Strawberry Fest 5K. As the pastor I felt like I should be supportive and participate but, as someone who was out of shape and had never felt the desire to run without being chased, I was also dreading the process. Sure enough, it was a hard fought battle but come June I ran the race and even beat the Strawberry! And just like that I was hooked.

I continued to train with friends and increased my distance. By the end of the summer one of my favorite routes was to run from my home to Albion Free Methodist Church, which was exactly 3.1 miles (5K), where I would meet up with a friend to run the Strawberry Fest 5K route and then I would continue on back home. I actually enjoyed running longer distances enough that when some friends invited me to run the Hospice Dash Half-Marathon with them that September I accepted. I was feeling pretty confident having run 10 miles a couple of times already and figured one more 5K (13.1 miles total) added to the end wouldn't be that big of a deal.

Fast forward to September 24th when I am running with a crowd through Fort Niagara exactly halfway to the finish line at exactly the 1 hr. mark. I was feeling fantastic and then, a little while later when the Runmeter App on my phone said I had hit the 10 mile mark ahead of schedule, I was even more elated! But then it happened, after running almost 2 miles more I stopped dead in my tracks as I saw the "You made it 10 Miles!" sign and realized that my app must have been malfunctioning. I still had 3.1 miles to go and it felt like forever. I just stood there feeling like my feet were stuck in tar and all of the thirst and pains I was able to ignore when I thought I was almost done overtook me and made it difficult to walk let alone run. Eventually I got moving again and sputtered along for the next couple of miles but when I still couldn't see the finish line I stopped again feeling exhausted and discouraged. And that's when my friends showed up.

Having already finished the race well ahead of me my friends had run back to where I was and started cheering me on and telling me that the end wasn't far off. As they ran side by side with me I picked up the pace and soon enough I was crossing the finish line with a still respectable 2:24 time. What my friends did for me was they gave me hope and they let me know that the end really was in sight which helped me to persevere and finish the race. (On a personal note - one of those friends was Wayne Burlison who finished his race not long after when he died from colon cancer. Fast forward to last Saturday where I had the privilege of bringing some friends from the First Baptist Church in Medina, where I am currently the Interim-Pastor, to help out on the Hands 4 Hope Street Ministry Truck. For anyone not aware, H4H is a mission run by my good friend John "Jack" Burriss and a trusty core of helpers, including Kevin Lemcke and Brian Stewart, where we drive the big blue truck to a different part of the County four Saturdays every month offering food, clothes, prayer, and HOPE.



Yes... hope. Just like I needed others to come beside me to encourage me and let me know that I could make it to the end there are those in our own backyards and neighborhoods who may have hit some hard times and need to know that they are not alone—they are seen, they are cared for, they are prayed for, and they are loved. Offering hope to others isn't often convenient, my friends found this out as we battled through the ice and snow from the storm the night before, but it is worthwhile and I would encourage any of you to make the effort.

Whether you volunteer some Saturday at Hands 4 Hope, help out with another local mission like the OK Kitchen, or simply stop by a friend's home to offer them encouragement for what they are going through, you can bring hope to someone which might be all they need to persevere past their current circumstances. After all, "we all get by with a little help from our friends."

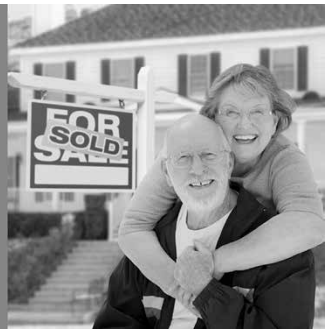

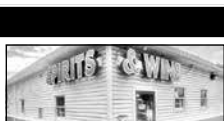

- 1 KNOW YOUR SKILLS AND STRENGTHS**
Be able to talk about your strengths, most proud accomplishments, areas of interest, personal values, areas for development.
- 2 RESEARCH, RESEARCH, RESEARCH**
Research the company, the position and your interviewer to be able to talk about them in-depth during the interview.
- 3 MASTER THE PHONE INTERVIEW**
Enunciate clearly, talk slowly and go to a quiet place where you can concentrate and listen well.
- 4 PRESENT YOURSELF WELL**
First impressions are formed by 7% of what you say, 38% of your eloquence and confidence, 55% how you dress, act and walk through the door.
- 5 PREPARE QUESTIONS TO ASK**
Interviewing is a two-way street. What is important for you to know about the workplace, role, team? Be sure to ask those important questions.
- 6 PREPARE YOUR ANSWERS**
Your answers need to prove your skills and knowledge, aptitude for success in the role, and personality "fit" in the company.
- 7 USE THE S.T.A.R METHOD**
A good answer to behavioral questions includes stating the situation, task, actions, result.
- 8 ASK FOR THE JOB**
Examples: Do you have any remaining concerns? What are the next steps? How do you see me fitting in with your company?
- 9 FOLLOW UP**
Be sure to get your thank you note out in less than 24 hours. The sooner the better. If things drag out, check in periodically.

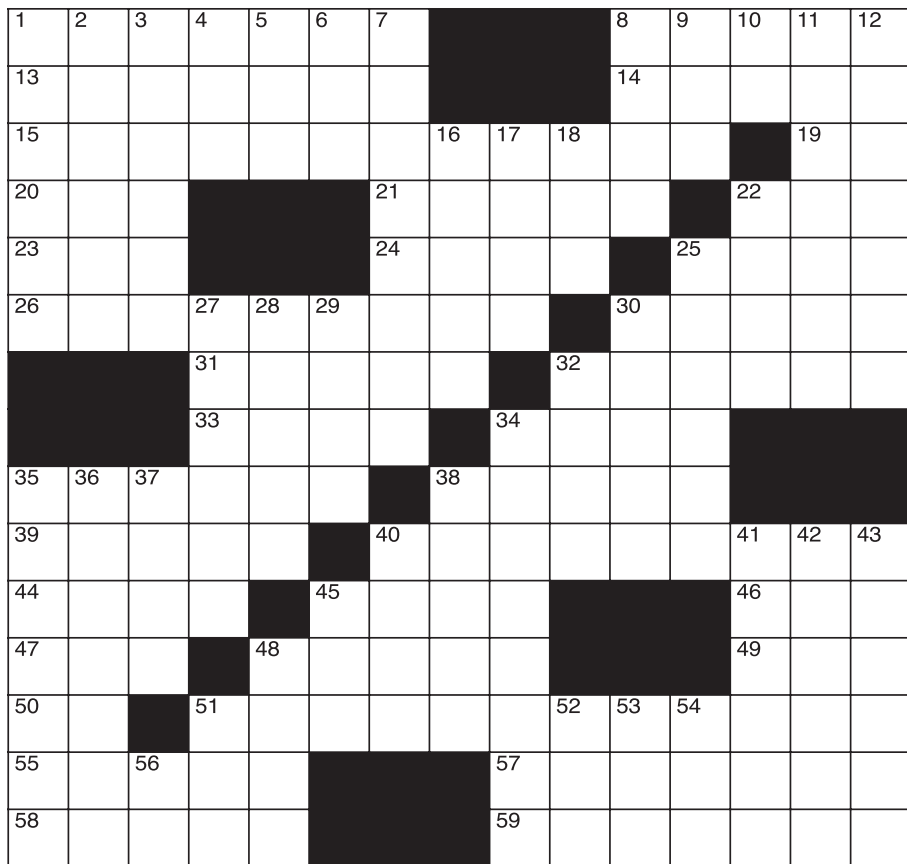

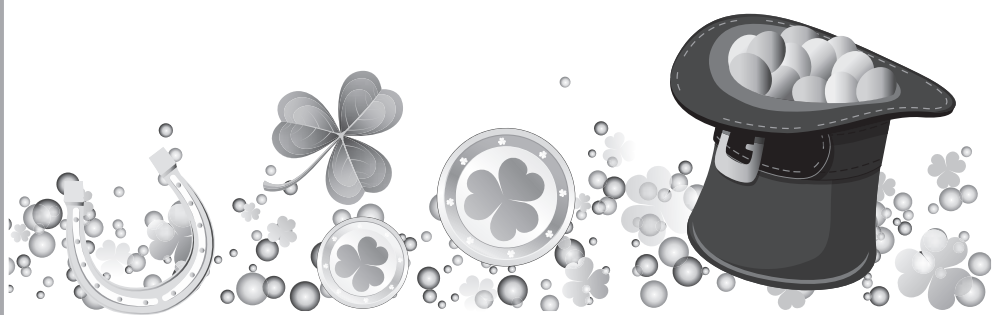

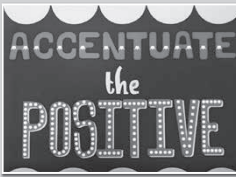
