Nora Davis enhances performing arts offerings

The Laurel School District has plans underway to enhance the performing arts offerings at Nora Davis Magnet School. Beginning in August, the arts focused school will take performing arts to a new level. Long known as a Model School for the Arts, Nora Davis Magnet School has a unique focus of using the arts as a tool to provide high-quality instruction that reaches all learning styles. The new offerings will enhance the school's ability to meet the artistic needs of Laurel's creative and talented students.

Beginning the upcoming school year, Nora Davis will create a speech and debate team, a competition show choir, a dance troupe, a strings ensemble with an emphasis on violin, and will produce two Broadwaystyle musicals.

"Our goal is for Nora Davis to become the premier performing arts magnet school in the country," said Superintendent Dr. Chuck Benigno. "Nora Davis has always had a strong arts focus and it has played a huge role in the school's academic success. We now want to take the performing arts to a whole new level. By adding a fall and spring Broadway-style musical production and performance teams in the areas of speech and debate, show choir, dance, and violin, Nora Davis will now be able to offer an educational experience that is second to none."

The district will also form the Laurel Speech and Debate League that will focus on developing the oral, written and critical thinking skills of fourth and fifth grade students. Teams will be formed at all four elementary schools, providing students the opportunity for competition and skills development. The league will perform inter-district meets as well as explore competitive avenues outside of Laurel and the state.

"I am especially excited about the creation of the Speech and Debate League. The league will consist of teams from Mason, Maddox, Oak Park and Nora Davis who will compete among each other and travel to competitions both locally and nationally. The world of speech and debate is truly the training ground for the future leaders of our nation. I can't wait to see our talented young people showcase their skills in this important educational arena," Benigno said.

In other enhancements, Nora Davis will now feature two Broadway-style musicals each school year increasing the audition and

performance opportunities for students. One will be held in the fall and one in the spring. In addition to the music and dance classes students participate in during the regular school day, Nora Davis will also enrich the music and dance programs by offering jazz, ballet, modern dance, and other performance-based classes after school.

To lead the charge of organizing and facilitating the enhanced arts offerings, the

Believe or not, it has been 10 years since Hurricane Katrina forever changed the way we think about the severity of hurricanes. Although, we certainly remember the pain and frustration brought by this devastating storm, we often forget the importance of preparing for hurricane season each year.

At Dixie Electric, we are currently updating our Emergency Response Plan, continually clearing the trees and underbrush from around our power lines and adapting new technologies that allow us to respond more quickly during power outages.

Just as we are preparing for hurricane season, we encourage you to be prepared in the event of one of these dangerous storms heads our direction. Keep your family safe with these handy

tips. **Before the Storm:**

- Put together an emergency kit and plan. Communicate the plan with your family.
- Know the elevation level of your property and whether the land is flood-prone.
- Secure your home: cover all windows with either storm shutters or boards, clear loose and clogged rain gutters, and bring all outdoor furniture indoors.
- Learn your community hurricane evacuation routes.

During the Storm:

- Listen to the radio or TV for information, if possible.
- Avoid using the phone, unless there is an emergency.
- Turn off utilities if instructed to do so. Otherwise, keep the refrigerator ther-

mostat on the coldest setting and keep the doors closed.

After the Storm:

- Keep away from loose or dangling power lines and report them immediately to Dixie Electric or your power company.
- Drive only if necessary and avoid flooded roads. Watch out for fallen objects, downed power lines, and weakened walls, bridges, or sidewalks.
- Drive slowly and cautiously around utility line crews and other emergency personnel as they work to make repairs after

sissippi will have the distinction of being the first southern state to host the World Series. Metro Area Community Empowerment (MACE) in partnership with the Institute for Disability Studies at the University of Southern Mississippi, and the National Wheelchair Softball Associa-

tion (NWSA), will host the 2015 Wheelchair Softball World Series August 6-8 at the Mississippi Coast Coliseum and Convention Center in Biloxi.

MACE CEO and Founder, Antonio Wright, said last year, the 2014 NWSA World Series was held in Minneapolis, Minn., and over 400 wheelchair athletes, from 20 states, and three countries, including Japan and Australia, participated in the event. He expects that many athletes, if not more, to converge on the Gulf Coast in August.

"It is truly an honor and privilege to host this year's World Series," exclaimed Wright. "It really says something when it was a unanimous vote for us, a two-year old team, to be this year's

The Deep South Hurricanes is composed of outstanding wheelchair athletes from Mississippi, Alabama, and Louisiana, and is sponsored by the MACE Foundation.

MACE is a 501(c)(3) taxexempt organization created

to assist individuals with spinal cord injuries (SCI) and provide youth character building through mentorship, community involvement, and goal formation.

"Through MACE, we are able to offer wheelchair users an opportunity to participate in sports such as wheelchair softball, tennis, basketball, golf, and other sports and recreational activities," said Wright.

"MACE literally saved my life," exclaimed LaFitte. "When I saw those guys playing the sports that I used to play and having so much fun, it totally changed my perspective on my situation. It's like taking the gun barrel out of your mouth when you see them out there having fun."

"I'm looking forward to competing in the World Series this year," said LaFitte. I missed last year's World Series in Minnesota. By the time they announced the dates, I had already made reservations and was committed to competing in the National Veterans Wheelchair Games (NVWG) that week."

LaFitte stays busy all year round competing in different sporting events. Even a broken leg can't keep him down for long. Two months ago, while at his daughter's soccer game, he was thrown out of his wheelchair when it hit a hole on the soccer field, and he landed awkwardly on his left leg, breaking it just above the knee. But, in the later part of June, he traveled to Dallas to again participate in the NVWG in the 2015 Games. He was a little disappointed to bring home the Bronze Medal in Hand Cycling, because, last year, he won the Gold.

LaFitte, a Marine Corp veteran, suffered a spinal cord injury after returning to the states from a deployment in the African country of Djibouti. On March 9, 2008, LaFitte and his company were being transported from a training session at Fort Rucker when the bus they were riding

in rolled over in Bessemer, Alabama. Nine members of his company, including LaFitte, were injured, and one killed in the crash. LaFitte received a broken back, traumatic brain injury, shattered left shoulder, broken leg and ribs, and collapsed lung. He is paralyzed from the waist down.

Wright, who is affectionately known as Coach Wright, was a rising football star in his early years of college and was attending Jackson State University when his football fame was shortened on February 2, 1997 in a terrible motor vehicle accident. He suffered a spinal cord injury when he was thrown from the car, and is paralyzed from the waist down. Wright said he could have easily become bitter about his injury, but instead, he took on a spirit of strength and determination to help others in the same condition. Wright later returned to Jackson State and coached football there for four years. He then

coached football at his high

school alma mater, Provine High School, for three years, and has coached football at several other high schools in Mississippi. He is a spokesman for the Fellowship of Christian Athletes and is very involved in the Mississippi Association of Coaches. In 1996, Governor Haley Barbor appointed Wright to the State Rehabilitation Council.

In addition to being a coach and teacher, Wright is a certified personal trainer, a strength conditioning coach, motivational speaker, and an ordained minister.

His love of sports and passionate desire to mentor youth and help others in his situation led Wright to form the MACE Foun-

"We started MACE in 2011 with three individuals," said Wright. "Over the past four years we've been able to assist over 20,000 people to participate in wheelchair sports and have provided over 40 clinics."

The Jackson Rollin' Tigers Wheelchair Sports and Recreation was the first program established by MACE, which gives wheelchair users the opportunity to participate in the sport of basketball. Within the first year, MACE added wheelchair deepsea fishing, and other recreational activities to their list of programs. In 2012, the Deep South Hurricanes wheelchair softball team was added, and the team competed in the 2013 Wheelchair Softball National Championship in Chicago, Illinois, and the 2014 World Series in Minneapolis, Minnesota. In April 2013, MACE hosted its first USTA certified Tennis tournament, "The Catfish Classic." MACE has also created" The Wheel Cats," MACE's prep wheelchair basketball team. The Wheelcats are Mississippi's first youth teams of wheelchair users. The prep team consists of young people ages 5 to 13. The Junior Varsity team consists of young adults ages 14 to 18.

The Wheelcats compete in wheelchair basketball tournaments across the country and has grown from 5 players in the 2013-2014 season to over 23 players in the 2014-2015 season.

Hosting the 2015 Wheelchair Softball World Series is a big undertaking, and expenses are estimated to exceed \$40,000. A minimum of 100 volunteers will be needed, at least 20 portable tents, as many outdoor fans as possible, and a plentiful supply of water to keep everyone safely hydrated and as cool as possible in the Mississippi summer heat.







Eight Bobcat teams qualified for postseason play with the men and women's tennis teams advancing to their respective national tourna-

The Lady Bobcat tennis team tied Itawamba in the MACJC/Region 23 Tournament and was declared region co-champions.

Overall, JCJC was 160-49-1 for a winning percentage of .765.

The official year in athletics was from July 1, 2014, to June 30, 2015.

WOMEN'S TENNIS

Head coach Mark Easley's Lady Bobcats went 13-0 during the regular season. They tied Itawamba in the state/region tournament and advanced to the NJCAA Division I National Tournament in Tucson, Arizona, in May where they finished 16th. They also finished 16th in the final ITA poll.

Shelby Gilliland won the MACJC/Region 23 title in No. 2 singles and Krissy Stutts claimed the state/region title in No. 4 singles. Gilliland and Jenna Hegwood won the No. 1 doubles MACJC/Region 23 championship. Gilliland, Stutts and Hegwood are all from Petal.

Stutts and Laurel's Tymeka Hunter won the national title in the No. 3 doubles consolation

Easley was named the MACJC Coach of the Year, Region 23 Coach of the Year, MAC Coach of the Year and the Wilson/ITA Coach of the Year for Women's ITA Region III.

WOMEN'S SOCCER

The Lady Bobcats had a remarkable year, cruising to the MACJC South Division title.

They ended the year with a 16-0-1 record, but Pearl River edged them on penalty kicks in the MACJC/Region 23 Tournament semifinals.

The Lady Bobcats had a fantastic season, but came up short in the MACJC and Region 23 Tournaments at the end of the season.

Head coach Chris Robinson's team had a 41-6 record, including a 39-2 regular season mark. JCJC was the preseason No. 1 team in the NJCAA Division II poll, was No. 2 in the final regular season poll and was never ranked below No. 3 all season. They captured the MACJC South Division crown.
