The Opossum

North America's only marsupial is our opossum. Their babies migrate to the pouch when they are the size of a bee and mature over eighty days. They are not a rat. Their tails are fifth limbs. They have higher intelligence than most pets and groom themselves often. As scavengers, they eat our garden pests without damaging the garden: slugs, snails, rats, mice, snakes and thousands of ticks, berries and seeds.



They are generally immune to rabies, venomous snakes and lyme because of their low body temperatures. Though they may hiss and growl they are not aggressive. An involuntary defense causes them to faint when scared, emitting a foul odor to keep predators way. They can remain in this state for hours.

They only live a couple years or so and are so beneficial to our environment. If you had lyme disease just once, you'd want many of them out there destroying ticks.

So please, give them safe passage when they cross your path. Learn more about them. Don't judge them by their cover! Mark Schneck
