

JCSD Lt. Tony Stiles, Jones 12, Retires

Lt. Tony Stiles has been forced to make the choice to end his career of 16 years as a law enforcement officer, one that he loved and graciously served. The injuries Stiles received July 30, 2012, when he was shot in the abdomen, elbow, and wrist during a domestic incident in Shady Grove, has forced him to take a medical retirement from the Jones County Sheriff's Department after serving seven years with the department. Friday night, June 12, Sheriff

Alex Hodge and the members of the Jones County Sheriff's Department honored Stiles with a retirement dinner.

The night gave Stiles and his family of law enforcement brothers and sisters an opportunity to be together, and celebrate his dedication to serve. Sheriff Hodge presented him with a plaque and a shadow box containing all of his patches and badges of his law enforcement service since his career began in 1999, serving as a Patrolman with the Bay Springs Police Department.

Stiles served with the BSPD until July 4, 2002, when he joined the Ellisville Police Department. After a year with the EPD, Stiles returned to the BSPD, and served another three years until becoming a contract officer for the Department of State, and was assigned to work in Iraq in 2006.

During his tenure in Iraq, Stiles was sent on 86 combat missions. In March 2007, Stiles and his unit were occupying a building in a small village west of Fallujah when a suicide bomber blew up the building killing some of the men in his unit and critically injuring him. He spent a week in the hospital in Balad with injuries consisting of mild brain damage, and a broken neck. He returned to Camp Fallujah after leaving the hospital, and eventually returned to full duty, serving another six months before coming home.

Upon his homecoming in 2008, Sheriff Hodge brought Stiles onto the team, where he served as a SWAT Leader, Patrolman,



see." Smith was instantly blinded by the shotgun shot to his face.

"Lying face down in a pool of blood, fighting for my life, so many thoughts began racing through my mind," explained Smith. He said he thought about his mom, who died of an incurable disease on his 10th birthday, and he thought about his daughter, Kim, who was also 10, and wondered if she would be 10 when he died. But, Smith obviously survived the blast.

"I was instantly cast into total physical darkness, and into a world of darkness you can't begin to comprehend," exclaimed Smith. "I didn't know it was going to be so difficult." He explained how he told everyone he was doing fine, but inside, he was dying.

Ninety days after the incident he lost the career he loved. His wife of 27 years, a former Miss Louisiana, couldn't handle his blindness and left him. But, through it all he tried to remember what his mother shared with him when he was a little boy. "She said, 'When the storms of life roll in, don't focus on the darkness of the storm, you look for the ray of sunshine in the midst of your storm."

Two years after the shooting, he married a woman he's never seen. Went

Narcotics Investigator, Criminal Investigator, and assisted with many other duties and obligations with the Department.

When Stiles turned his badge in to Karen Bustin, executive assistant for the Sheriff, he said "It was like getting hit by a sledgehammer. I felt like I was turning my life over to her."

Friday night, was not a happy occasion for anyone, and tears were shed. But, it was a night filled with encouragement, too, especially from a person that well knows the battles and struggles that Stiles has been through since that hot July night in 2012. Guest speaker, Dr. Bobby Smith, a retired Louisiana State Trooper, shared his experience in dealing with the trials and tribulations that life can send your way.

"How was I to know that as I stepped out of my State Trooper's car, at 11:35 p.m. on March 14, 1986, for a routine traffic stop, that not only would I be faced with a 12 gauge shotgun, but that a blast from that shotgun would be the last thing I would ever back to school and received a master's degree in education, and later a doctorate degree in psychology. He now travels the country speaking to millions of people, and has written three books. But, he has had to continue to look for that "ray of sunshine in the midst of storms."

He has lost both of his children. Kim was killed in a car crash by a drunk driver at the age of 22. His son, Brad, also died at age 22 of an accidental drug overdose.

"Tony, listen to me. Tina, listen to me," exclaimed Smith. "God don't make no mistakes. Things happen to you that don't make sense. As I understand it, something good can come from the losses in your life, no matter how devastating they have been, if you will let them. It just may not be good for you, it may have to be good for your brother. It's okay for big boys to cry. It's okay to hold your brother's hand when he's hurting, because we're a family. Tony and Tina, don't forget to lean on your brothers. We're a family, but they can't help you if you won't let them. There is no Superman, nor Wonder Woman.

I am so thankful for the 10 years I could wear that badge. But, God had a different plan. And, now I wear another badge today. Like you Tony, I wear a badge of honor and integrity."

As Stiles stepped up to receive his plaque and shadow box filled with his badges, Stiles replied, "Knowing what I know today, and what I've been through, I would go through those doors of that house, and do the same exact thing, protect the people that stood behind me in that line. I'd do it over again, one hundred times. It's been one of the greatest honors in my life working with you men and women. I'm proud of every minute God gave me to work with you. I just wish it hadn't been snatched away so early."







cars in the summer heat By Kelly Atwood, SCAR Board member

It's a hot summer's day. You step out of your car into a store parking lot and see a dog inside a car with its tongue hanging out. You're burning up just standing there, and the animal you're looking at is in what is the equivalent of the inside of an oven. What do you do?

Right now, 16 states have statutes that prevent people from leaving an animal in a parked vehicle in situations that may endanger the animal's life. Although Mississippi has yet to pass such a statute, we definitely have the extreme hot temperatures that can endanger pets' lives.

In states that do not have a specific law regarding pets in vehicles, people have still been convicted of animal cruelty. An example is Texas, where a man left his dog in a hot car while he went to watch a movie. Although Texas doesn't have a specific statute regarding dogs in cars, this man was convicted under the state's anticruelty law. Leaving an animal in a car in the Mississippi heat could be described as an act of animal cruelty.

On an 85-degree day, for example, the temperature inside a car with the windows opened slightly can reach 104 degrees within 10 minutes. After 30 minutes, the temperature will reach 120 degrees. A pet trapped in excessive heat can suffer nerve damage, liver damage, brain damage and even death.

Signs of a heatstroke in a dog can include heavy panting with exaggerated long tongue, glazed eyes, extreme drooling, dark tongue, intense scratching or digging at the doors as if trying to escape, lack of coordination, trouble breathing, vomiting or diarrhea, rapid heartbeat, lethargy, seizure or unconsciousness.

How to treat a pet suffering from heatstroke

If a dog is suffering from any signs of a heatstroke, it should be moved out of the vehicle and into a shady or air-conditioned area. Cool, wet towels should be placed on its head, neck, chest and paws

or cool water should be poured over the dog. If the animal will drink, let it have small amounts of cool water. In a situation of heatstroke, always take your pet directly to a veterinarian. Do not wait hours or days before doing so.

What to do if you see a pet in a hot car

Not everyone is aware of the danger a hot vehicle can pose to an animal, and it's going to take everyone in our community working together to help educate and inform others. If you see an animal in a car on a day when the temperature is over 60 degrees, there are some things you can do to help it before it gets overheated:

-Take down the make, model and tag number of the car

-If you are in the parking lot of a business, ask the business to make an announcement and/or page the person to their car

-Call the non-emergency number of your local law enforcement. Keep an eye on the dog and don't leave the scene until the situation has been resolved. If you must leave, make sure when you call the police that you leave your name and number with the person who answers the phone so the officer who responds to the call can contact you if they need more information. 
