The National Baseball Hall of Fame had been on my bucket list for years. In September of 2013, I finally decided to take an overnight trip to see it. The plan was to get an early start, drive down via Route 20 with some quick photo stops along the way, arrive in Cooperstown around noon to explore and see the Hall Of Fame, do a bit more exploring the next morning, and head back home that afternoon. Well...I love being retired and having the flexibility to change plans on the fly! My estimated 5-6 hour drive (with photo stops) turned into 10 hours because of all the amazing things I took the time to stop and see along the way. I had a reservation at a lovely Bed and Breakfast in downtown Cooperstown that was happy to accommodate me for a second night so I could do everything I wanted to do and not be rushed. So, my overnighter turned into a two night, three day adventure that I'll never forget. Taking the scenic route is the best way to go. The thruway would have gotten me there quicker, but I would have missed so much long the way. Some of my stops along the way included: breakfast in Canandaigua, the Montezuma Winery, a couple hours exploring Seneca Falls and the history of Women's Rights, Skaneateles, Cazenovia Lake, and Chittenango Falls. Just about 10 hours and lots of memories later, I arrived in Cooperstown in time to check into my Bed & Breakfast and walk downtown for some dinner. I loved Cooperstown. It is an awesome small town on Otsego Lake with all the small town charm and appeal. Of course, it takes full advantage of the Baseball Hall of Fame with lots of baseball themed shops, restaurants, and attractions, but there is so much to love for everyone - regardless of their interest in baseball.

After I explored a little and had some dinner, I went to the Baseball Hall of Fame. It was getting late, so I wasn't sure how much I could see, but I discovered that the purchase of a ticket that late in the day also included access the next day. I spent about an hour and a half that first evening and barely made it through the first floor. The next morning, I returned and spent another three hours going through the second and third floor and revisiting parts of the first floor. It was really amazing! The hall of plaques of those inducted into the Hall of Fame was quite an experience. There were several people wandering through looking at the plaques, but no one spoke more than a whisper - it was a respectful and emotional room. I thoroughly enjoyed all the time I spent there. If you're going to visit the HoF, you should definitely allow at least 3-4 hours to see it all - more to really do it justice.

On or after March 28, 2023, New York State Homes & Community Renewal (HCR) will submit a request to the U. S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) for the release of \$300,000 of HOME funds under Title II of the Cranston-Gonzalez National Affordable Housing Act (NAHA) of 1990, in accordance with section 288 (42 U.S.C. 12838), to authorize Rural Housing Opportunities Corporation to undertake a program known as RHOC Regional 00 2023, for purposes of providing funds for the cost of rehabilitation of single-family homes on scattered sites in Genesee, Monroe Orleans, Ontario, Wayne, and Wyoming Counties, with an estimated total project cost of \$300,000. The 2022 HOME LPA Program will use HOME funds from 2022 awards to fund a variety of activities through partnerships with counties, municipalities and non-profit community-based housing organizations, which are referred to as Local Program Administrators (LPA). Each LPA works within a specific geographic area - usually a county or municipality. The Program provides funds to acquire, rehabilitate or construct housing or to provide assistance to low- and moderate-income home-buyers and renters. Funds must be distributed in accordance with needs and priorities identified in the State's Consolidated Plan. The proposed activities that are the subject of this Notice are Categorically Excluded from National Environmental Policy Act requirements under HUD regulations at 24 CFR Part 58(a)(3)(i). The specific LPA Programs that are the subject of this Notice do not constitute every LPA Program that is proposed for inclusion within the 2022 New York State HOME LPA Program. A full listing of the 2022 HOME LPA Programs is available at http://www.hcr.ny.gov/Funding/ Awards/. This is the first tier of review in a 2-tiered process. The specific addresses of homes are not known at this time because the participating property owner identification process is ongoing. Therefore, under 24 CFR Part 58.15 (Tiering) and 24 CFR Part 58.32 (Project Aggregation), HCR will use a tiered approach and Tier 2 site specific reviews will be completed for those laws and authorities not addressed in the Tier 1 broad review for each address under this program when addresses become known. No physical work will begin on properties until all levels of environmental review are complete and found to be in compliance. Tier 1 review addresses specific environmental factors for which compliance has been documented, regardless of specific site locations. It prevents repeating the same compliance factors on a Tier 2 site-specific basis, once all participating homeowners are known. An Environmental Review Record (ERR) that documents the environmental determinations for this Program is available and may be obtained by emailing John.leahy@hcr.ny.gov. Tier 2 Site Specific Review: The site specific reviews will cover all the laws and authorities not resolved in the broad Tier 1 review as discussed in the ERR that is available for public inspection. Mitigation Measures/Conditions/Permits (if any): Template Tier 2 forms are included in the ERR that is available for public inspection. The Templates include the mitigation measures, conditions and/or permits that will be complied with, if applicable, at each project site that is chosen.

All comments received by March 27, 2023, will be considered by HCR prior to authorizing submission of a request for release of funds.

ENVIRONMENTAL CERTIFICATION

HCR certifies to HUD that Mr. John Leahy in his capacity as Certifying Officer consents to accept the jurisdiction of the Federal Courts if an action is brought to enforce responsibilities in relation to the environmental review process and that these responsibilities have been satisfied. 


OBJECTIONS TO RELEASE OF FUNDS

HUD will consider objections to its release of funds and HCR's certification received by April 12, 2023 or for a period of fifteen days following its actual receipt of the request (whichever is later) only if they are on one of the following bases: (a) the certification was not executed by the Certifying Officer of HCR; (b) HCR has omitted a step or failed to make a decision or finding required by HUD regulations at 24 CFR Part 58; (c) the grant recipient or other participants in the project have committed funds or incurred costs not authorized by 24 CFR Part 58 before approval of a release of funds by HUD; or (d) another Federal agency acting pursuant to 40 CFR Part 1504 has submitted a written finding that the project is unsatisfactory from the standpoint of environmental quality. Objections must be prepared and submitted in accordance with the required procedures (24 CFR Part 58) and shall be addressed to the following HUD office and sent via email.





Clifford Wise Third Graders Bridging the Digital Divide at AT&T Digital Enrichment Field Trip

On January 19th and 26th, third-grade students from Clifford Wise Intermediate School in Medina had the opportunity to visitExplore & More - The Ralph C. Wilson, Jr. Children's Museum in Buffalo, NY. The field trip was part of the AT&T Digital Enrichment Field Trip, a program designed to address equality issues in technology education and help local students in the WNY region impacted by the digital divide, the gap between those who have and do not have access to technology, gain digital literacy knowledge and skills.

According to AT&T Issue Briefs, "AT&T is committed to bridging the digital divide through efforts that promote broadband affordability, availability and adoption. We are also investing our resources and knowledge to advance the digital skills needed to thrive in the classrooms and workplaces of today and tomorrow." AT&T's partnership with Explore & More - The Ralph C. Wilson, JR. Children's Museum made this amazing digital literacy field trip possible. The field trip aims to narrow the digital divide by improving student readiness and helping them build skills and confidence using technology and the internet in safe and educational ways. The program offered age-appropriate technology-focused digital enrichment stations, covering computer programming, robotics, and digital safety.

During their visit, third graders participated in unique hands-on digital literacy enrichment-focused stations, designed to integrate STEM (Science, Technology, Engineering, & Math) education. Wise students are familiar with this type of learning because they have been immersed in it this year with our Full STEAM Ahead Day and STEAM Centers (Virtual Reality expeditions, Dash Robots, Cubelets, and Snap Circuits). "Within the Medina CSD, we believe in including the Arts in STEM education, therefore we refer to it as STEAM, which is Science, Technology, Engineering, Art, and Math", says Medina CSD Technology Integrator Jason Klein. "The inclusion of arts in STEM education encourages students to think creatively, come up with innovative solutions to problems, enhance communication skills, improve visualization skills, and promote interdisciplinary learning."

The four digital literacy enrichment stations allowed students to learn about digital literacy, digital safety, computer programming, and robotics in fun and interactive ways. In addition to these exciting activities, each student received a digital superherothemed passport to take home, which highlighted the activities and four principles that Digital Enrichment Superheroes live by.

At one station, students became coders, programming robots to knock down cups in the Cooking Gallery. Students learned that when we have a job to do on the internet, we guide the computer to where we want to go. This is like being a programmer to a robot! We can be successful when we use technology properly. As Digital Enrichment Superheroes, we must check our sources to make sure the information is factual.

Another station had students take a closer look at the electrical circuit of a scribble bot that powers a motor. Once students completed the electric circuit, they put VanGogh Bot 2.0 to work to create works of art right before their eyes. The lesson learned at this station is never forget that when you post something on the internet, it is permanent, just like their artwork with VanGogh Bot 2.0! A Digital Enrichment Superhero must think twice before posting things online. The third station involved students planning, designing, constructing, testing, and adjusting a device to clean up a chemical spill in the Tinkering Tank. The lesson learned at this station is that if we stay organized with computer tools, such as folders and bookmarks, we are going to be more successful on the internet! A good Digital Enrichment Superhero keeps their items organized for quick reference. Finally, students looked at the insides of how robots work by exploring Snap Circuits. Students used the Snap Circuits to build electrical circuits. Students learned that everything on the internet is connected in some way. Once we put something on the internet, almost everyone can see it. A good Digital Enrichment Superhero checks their references because everything on the internet can be fact checked, if you follow the sources.

"In today's world, digital literacy has become the new way of life," says Klein. "The ubiquity of technology demands our ability to assess it, navigate it, and integrate it; all of which digital literacy encompasses. Many work forces struggle to find skilled workers, especially in ground-breaking fields. It is essential to teach the youth the necessary skills and tools to compete in this innovation economy, especially with the high demand for STEAM and digital jobs in the United States. To address the diversity shortage in the tech industry and bridge the digital divide, programs like the AT&T Digital Enrichment Field Trip are necessary. These programs will equip students with the digital literacy knowledge and skills needed to succeed in the digital age."

From observations and conversations with students at the museum, third-graders had an unforgettable experience, immersing themselves in hands-on exhibits that made meaningful connections to their lives. Through digital literacy and STEAM education, they were able to design and create, discovering the joy of meaningful play that they may not have had the opportunity to experience outside of school. With a strong connection to digital literacy, these students can be well on their way to becoming the next generation of innovators and creators.

In addition to the four stations, students were able to explore other exhibits at the museum, including an automotive shop, carwash, doctor's office, grocery store, farmhouse play kitchen, construction site, and more

"This museum visit was an enriching experience for students, as they not only had the chance to learn about digital literacy, but also explore various reallife job exhibits, from doctors and scientists to auto mechanics and construction workers," says Klein. "The purposeful play and life-like experiences helped to instill valuable skills for the future and fostered a love for lifelong learning. These opportunities also emphasized the importance of community connections and opened up new possibilities for students to explore their interests and passions."

The experience ended with a fun live virtual Zoom call with Mrs. Annie Savinon, Explore & More - The Ralph C. Wilson, Jr. Children's Museum's STEM Educator. The students shared their favorite experiences about the museum, reviewed what they had learned, and had the opportunity to ask Mrs. Savinon questions about her background, job and educational philosophies. Students learned that prior to working at the museum, Mrs. Savinon was a teacher for 5 years at Salamanca's Middle School, where her passion for teaching all things Science and STEM bloomed.

Mrs. Savinon stated, "Now I am happy to share my passion for STEM and educating students in a new light, at a museum that offers enriching resources and opportunities for elementary level children to learn through play and grow an interest in STEM at an early age! This field trip has been a fun experience for myself, and the students have really taken to the content taught; it has been a lot of fun for all involved! With the amount of technology in the hands of younger students these days, a field trip like this is so important to introduce students at an early age to the importance of safety while on the internet. We are very thankful for our amazing sponsor, AT&T, to make this all happen!" Klein had this to say about the trip, "Overall, the students had a great time and learned valuable lessons from this one-of-a-kind field trip sponsored by AT&T. The museum's Digital Enrichment Program is an excellent way for students to learn about digital literacy while having fun and exploring new technology. 

Commons Symptoms of Engine Control Module Problems

The notion of vehicle maintenance often conjures images of greasedstained hands and car hoods propped up. While professional and amateur mechanics are still no strangers to getting their hands dirty, vehicle maintenance in the 21st century also involves diagnosing issues that might arise with a car's engine control module.



What is an engine control module?

An engine control module, or ECM, serves as the primary computer system for many critical components in modern vehicles. ECMs essentially serve as the brains behind the engines, controlling everything from fuel mixtures to emissions controls. Sensors within the engine send signals to the ECM, and the ECM then uses that information to help the car run smoothly. Issues that arise with the ECM can make driving difficult and, in some cases, impossible.

What are some potential signs of ECM issues?

The automotive service provider Aamco notes that a faulty or failing ECM will exhibit various symptoms. However, it's important to note that these symptoms are not always indicative of issues with the ECM, so when they arise drivers may want to schedule appointments with their mechanics so the true culprit can be identified and the problem can be fixed.

• Check engine light comes on: Many drivers have experienced the dreaded check engine light, which indicates some type of issue with the engine. That issue can be a failing engine component, or it may indicate a failing or bad ECM. A mechanic can determine why the light has come on.

• Engine performance issues: Even though the ECM is a separate entity from the engine itself, a bad or failing ECM can affect engine performance. That's because such ECMs throw off the timing and fuel settings of the engine, leading to a sudden and noticeable reduction in engine performance. Engine power may be affected, and the vehicle may experience a drop in fuel efficiency and issues with acceleration.




• Vehicle will not start: A failed ECM means the vehicle won't start, as there's nothing controlling the engine to tell it do so. Failing ECMs may lead to struggles starting the vehicle, and whenever drivers experience these issues, they should consult their mechanics immediately so the issue does not escalate to the point where the engine won't start at all.

• Erratic engine behavior: A malfunctioning ECM can lead to stalling or misfiring. These issues are often sporadic, which may give drivers the impression that nothing is seriously wrong. However, erratic engine behavior is a strong indicator of problems with the ECM, and these issues should be addressed immediately.

Identifying ECM issues and promptly addressing them can help drivers keep their vehicles on the road.




My most earnest gratitude goes to all the police teams, Medina, Niagara sheriff. As well as my neighbors that only see one another through passing while walking to or from our houses.



`Berry'Bountiful Muffins



Blueberries are tiny powerhouses of nutrition and eating more of them can be an easy way to get the antioxidants necessary to fend off many different diseases. While blueberries are nutritional allies, they also happen to taste delicious, whether it's all on their own or mixed into various cereals or baked goods.

This take on muffins pairs blueberries with whole grains and chips for a go-to breakfast or any-time-of-day snack. Enjoy "Blueberry Bran Chocolate Chip Muffins" from "The Brain Boosting Diet" (Whitecap) by Norene Gilletz and Edward Wein, PhD. This make-ahead batter yields a big batch, but leftover batter can be refrigerated up to three weeks, so feel free to bake up as many or as few muffins as you'd like.

Blueberry Bran Chocolate Chip Muffins

Makes 30 muffins

- 3 cups all-bran cereal
- 1/3 cup canola oil
- 1/3 cup plain Greek yogurt
- 1 cup hot tea
- 2 large eggs

2 tablespoons lemon juice + enough milk (skim or 1%) to equal 2 cups

- 1/2 cup firmly packed brown sugar
- 1/2 cup molasses or honey
- 21/2 cups whole wheat flour
- 2 teaspoons ground cinnamon
- 2 teaspoons baking soda
- 1 teaspoon baking powder Zest of 1 orange
- 11/2 cups fresh or frozen blueberries
- 1/2 to 3/4 cup chocolate chips (semisweet or sugar-free)

 5. Either let batter stand for 30 minutes, until thickened, or cover and refrigerate for up to 3 weeks.
 6. Preheat oven to 375 F. Spray compartments of a muffin pan (or muffin pans) with nonstick spray.
 7. Scoop batter into the muffin pan(s), filling each compartment about two-thirds full.
 8. Bake 22 to 25 minutes, or until tops spring back when lightly touched.
