## Jones County EMA remembers Katrina

Jones County Emergency Management Agency Director Marda Tullos, who served as Deputy Director during Katrina, led an unveiling ceremony of a plaque marking the date of Hurricane Katrina. The plaque is located at the base of the flag poles in front of the Jones County Emergency Operations Center in Laurel, and contains the words, "Honoring the people of Jones County and the events that occurred August 29, 2005 Hurricane Katrina."



"Ten years ago, three to four times a day, we met in the Operations Room listening to the National Weather Service tell us what we could be facing on Monday, August 29, 2005," described Tullos, "a hurricane in comparison to Hurricane Camille, something we did not want to hear. At 5:30 a.m., Monday morning, a transformer blew, and the EOC is on generator power. At noon, sustained winds are at 60 miles per hour with gusts of 100 miles per hour, and this goes on for several hours. The storm shutters on the EOC go down. At four o'clock, sustained winds are at 90 miles per hour with gusts of 120 miles per hour. The South Tower has blown over,

held radios, and inundated with calls - trees down, gas leaks, power outages. We cannot get communication to MEMA about

our situation. For days and weeks

after, the EOC was a hub of activity, and the center of all decision making. But, I don't have to re-live the events, you lived them, and you worked them. Response and recovery could not have happened without you responders in the field, in an office, or on the telephone. You were important. We will have more hurricanes, and we will meet for more weather briefings, which we will prepare for and respond to. I thank you every day for what you do, and your dedication."

"We certainly want to remember the seven Jones County lives that were lost due to Katrina," continued Tullos, choking up as she said the words. Gathering herself

## Life Church thanks Jones Co. Fire Service

Pastor David Hagan, and the members of Life Church, showed their thanks to the Jones County Fire Service for their service to Jones County during Katrina, and every day, with a banquet for all the volunteers on Saturday night, August 29.

"What a beautiful day we had today. The skies look a whole lot different today, than they did ten years ago," exclaimed Hagan when welcoming the volunteers. "When remembering the people that made a difference, you were the first to come to mind. We want to thank you for being there then, and thank you for what you do today."

Jones County Fire Coordinator Dan McKenna thanked Hagan and the Life Church members for hosting the banquet for the volunteers as did Jones County Fire Council President Stacy Brownlee, and Powers VFD firefighter and emergency medical responder Lance Chancellor. Also on hand for the banquet were Jones County Emergency Management Agency Deputy Director Rodney Parker, and the City of Ellisville Fire Department Fire Chief Ronnie McGilberry.

"Pastor Hagan, I was not the Fire Coordinator during Katrina, Mike Hodge was," explained McKenna. "But, I've heard all the stories. In my fire career I've fought California forest fires, and dealt with earthquakes, and I hope I never have to experience a hurricane like Katrina."

Chancellor, who worked very closely with former EMA Director Don

McKinnon during Katrina, shared a few stories of his Katrina experience, and personally thanked his fellow volunteers for what they did then, and continue to do today on a daily basis.

Pastor Hagan also invited the volunteers to return to Life Church Sunday morning for the church services where all first responders were recognized, and Hagan delivered his message, "Ten Years Later – What did we learn?"

she said, "There are key words we would like not to remember such as ice, water, fuel, fuel lines, the sound of generators, food spoiling in refrigerators and freezers, hot temperatures, and most of all, love bugs!"

Tullos invited Laurel Mayor Johnny Magee and Jones County Board of Supervisors President Andy Dial to say a few words on behalf of the city and the county.

"Saturday marks ten years that our community changed forever. There were a lot of hours spent in that building during that time," exclaimed Magee referring to the Jones County EOC. "And, really, the person that should be representing the City of Laurel this morning, about Katrina, is the man standing over there, Mayor Melvin Mack, because, he had just been elected into office when Katrina hit. His first term was pretty much defined by Katrina; by the storm and by the recovery. He spent his first term trying to get us back to where we needed to be. And we are still not there, yet. We still have blue roofs. Before Katrina, I didn't know what a blue roof or a blue tarp was. But, after Katrina they stayed around for quite a while, and there are still a few blue roofs left from Katrina. One thing about Katrina is that no matter what color you were, what religion you were, what your education was, or what your bank account said,


your power went out. So, for just awhile, we were all equal, whether you were with Mississippi Power or Dixie Electric, you were in the dark like everyone else. But, we were fortunate that we came together to help our recovery. Not just the people in this area, but we had people from all over the United States converge on Jones County, Mississippi. We were so blessed to have so many people show up, and out of the goodness of their hearts, help get Jones County rolling again. We are still not where we were before the storm, but we are so much more fortunate than we were on August 29, 2005. We are blessed that we have recovered as much as we have. So, as we remember Katrina, remember all the blessings that we were fortunate enough to receive."

meeting, Huff was able to help Jones County out along with providing 18 million dollars

to Harrison County. "We were blessed with those efforts, and didn't have to pay that off with our tax dollars. So, yes we were blessed."

"If you were here during that time, you played an important part in the recovery of Katrina. And, I'm glad to know we are going to have people in place if it happens again. People that know what to do, and will do it in order that our county can overcome."


A lot of stories were shared afterwards including stories of sleeping on floors and cots in the EOC for weeks, without returning home. Of the feeling of fear, as the winds blew continuously, and cars started slowly jogging away from their parking space under the pressure of the winds. Watching tin wrap around power lines, and debris role through the streets. And, the feeling of isolation from the world with no outside communications. Stories that are repeated throughout the county, by so many people. Everyone has a story to tell. If you lived in Jones County at the time of Katrina, or the entire state of Mississippi for that matter, you have your own story to tell; a story that will never be forgotten, and one that everyone hopes will never be repeated.





- An unusual oily smell.





## Royals Western Wear celebrates 80 years

Royals Western Wear, one of the oldest continuous retail businesses in Jones County, is celebrating 80 years of business. Still at its original location in downtown Soso, present owners Reon and Judy Wade recently remodeled and expanded the building into a now 5,000 square foot store, with pine interior, a new store front, and new sign. On Friday, September 5, Reon and Judy, along with their son, Derek, will hold a Boots, Blue Grass, and Barbecue Grand Opening Celebration and 80 Year Anniversary Sale.

"It's going to be an all day celebration, and we invite everyone to stop in, see our new store, and tell us your memories of the old store," exclaimed Reon. "Come and enjoy Blue Grass music with local pickers, including myself, delicious barbecue from Hog Heaven, and a fantastic boot and storewide sale. We are very appreciative of our customers. Many are loyal customers, who come by often. We appreciate everybody; we couldn't have done it without them."

"Bootsy is coming back, too," exclaimed Judy, chuckling. Bootsy is the store cat, who had to stay at home during the remodeling process.

Wade added that Hog Heaven owner, Chris Lindsey, will donate 100 percent of the proceeds to the Texas Longhorn Association Scholarship program that awards scholarships for college to youth exhibiting Texas Longhorns in shows throughout the country. The Dixie Texas Longhorn Association was recently organized in Jones County, and will hold its inaugural Deep South Longhorn Show on September 12, at the Magnolia Center in Laurel. According to Lindsey, there will be approximately 60 Longhorns with exhibitors from all over the south.

In 1935, the Royals family first opened the business as Royals Mercantile, a grocery and dry goods store. Being located across from the cotton gin, their main business came from the cotton pickers and workers at the mill. Reon said that he can remember Stubby, who was one of the sons of the Royals and the previous owner of Royals Western Wear, telling him about how Stubby's mother would make him and his brother get up at 4 a.m. every morning to help open the store to sell to the cotton pickers who were on their way to the cotton fields. "In the fall of the year, during the ginning season, the cotton gin ran 24 hours a day, and Mrs. Royals would stay open 24 hours for

the workers to buy their snacks and drinks. They probably didn't make five dollars a day, but she stayed opened 24 hours a day."

In 1977, when the big grocery store was built in Soso, Stubby, who now owned the business, transformed the grocery store into a boot store. In the 1980's, when the movie "Urban Cowboy" hit the big screen, the Urban Cowboy fad spread, and Stubby stocked the, now, Royals Western Store to the ceiling with all types of western boots and accessories, and work boots. The oil industry was also booming in the eighties, and the oil workers had plenty of money to spend.

During that same time, the Laurel Impact was created by Dr. Frank Buckley, a retired journalism professor from the University of Southern Mississippi, who along with his family, owned and ran two newspapers in Smith County. Reon was the first sales representative for the Laurel Impact, and Judy helped in laying out the new paper.

"Stubby bought my first ad," exclaimed Reon. "He bought an ad every week. He believed in advertising. One day when I came by, he told me he was on track to do a million dollars that year. I told him I didn't believe it, that there wasn't a mom and pop shop in Laurel or Jones

County that had ever done a million dollars in sales in a year. He said, 'Well, we're going to do it this year, right here in Soso.' That was 1984, I think. He had the store packed to the ceiling with merchandise. He had so much inventory he didn't have enough places to store it. The little house he lived in behind the store was packed with inventory. Every closet was packed. He even had shirts stacked under his bed. He had all types of western style boots including high dollar boots like Alligator Boots, all types of western shirts and belts, as well as the steel toed work boots, and he had a booming business."

Reon said when Stubby died in 1993, the ownership transferred to his step-daughter, Sylvia Cochran, who, by 2001, wanted to sell the business, and move to Alabama.

Reon knew how well the business had done in the past. "We were looking at the Impact one day, and I saw where Royals Western Store was for sale, and was having a going out of business sale. I told Judy I couldn't believe that someone hadn't snatched up that business. She looked at me and said, 'Why don't we buy it.' I hadn't even thought about that. But, I said, 'why not.' It was right after 9/11.
