EPA Section 608 Certification

EPA regulations (40 CFR Part 82, Subpart F) under Section 608 of the Clean Air Act require that technicians who maintain, service, repair or dispose of equipment that could release ozone depleting refrigerants into the atmosphere must be certified. Starting on January 1, 2018, this requirement will also apply to appliances containing most substitute refrigerants, including HFCs.



The Livingston County Center for Nursing and Rehabilitation was included among 127 award recipients to receive grant funding through the Statewide Health Care Facility Transformation Program after New York State Governor Kathy Hochul announced more than \$658 million to strengthen and transform how healthcare is delivered across the state.

"New Yorkers deserve access to quality health care and a strong, stable, and equitable health care system," Governor Hochul said. "These grants will provide critical funding for improvements at hospitals and other facilities throughout our state to ensure they deliver the top rate care New Yorkers deserve."

In total, the CNR is set to receive over \$653,000 for improvements to its overall infrastructure including its nurse call system, which is a vital communication tool located throughout the facility and regularly used by both residents and staff.

"I'd like to thank Governor Hochul and the New York State Department of Health for seeing the value in making these critical upgrades throughout of facility," said Shari Hutchison, Director of Long-Term Care at the CNR.
