





The word grounded has different meanings, such as: 1. Someone who is grounded




makes good decisions and does not say or do stupid things. 2. Someone who is sensible and reasonable, and that they understand the importance of ordinary things in life.

ground path and may cause shock or electrocution.



BAKED ONION DIP

4 Servings

Ingredients

- 3 cups shredded cheese*
- 4 ounces cream cheese, cubed
- 2-3 small Vidalia onions, diced
- 1/2 cup mayonnaise

Instructions

- Place the cubed cream cheese in a large bowl and microwave for about thirty seconds, just until soft.
- 2. 4 ounces cream cheese, cubed
- 3. Add diced onion, cheese, and mayo to the mixing bowl with cream cheese. Stir to combine.
- 3 cups shredded cheese*,2-3 small Vidalia onions, diced,1/2 cup mayonnaise

Spoon into a greased baking dish (8x8 works fine).

- 4. Bake at 375 for 25 to 30 minutes or until bubbly and lightly brown on top.
- 5. Serve with corn chips or crackers.

ONION DIP FROM SCRATCH

Yeild 1 batch

Ingredients:

- 2 tablespoons olive oil
- 1 1/2 cups diced onions



- 1/4 teaspoon kosher salt
- 11/2 cups sour cream
- 3/4 cup mayonnaise
- 1/4 teaspoon garlic powder
- 1/4 teaspoon ground white pepper
- 1/2 teaspoon kosher salt

Directions

- 1. In a saute pan over medium heat add oil,
- 2. heat and add onions and salt. Cook the onions until they are caramelized, about 20 minutes.
- 3 Remove from heat and set aside to cool.
- 4. Mix the rest of the ingredients, and then add the onions. Refrigerate and stir again before serving.

HERB-ROASTED ONIONS

Yield: 3 servings Ingredients:

- 2 red onions
- 1 yellow onion
- 2 tablespoons freshly squeezed lemon juice
- 1 teaspoon Dijon mustard
- 1 teaspoon minced garlic
- 1/2 tablespoon minced fresh thyme leaves
- 3/4 teaspoon kosher salt
- 1/4 teaspoon freshly ground black pepper
- 1/4 cup good olive oil
- 1/2 tablespoon minced fresh parsley leaves
- 1. Preheat the oven to 400 degrees F.
- 2. Remove the stem end of each onion and carefully slice off the brown part of the root end, leaving the root intact. Peel the onion. Stand each onion root end up on a cutting board and cut the onion in wedges through the root. Place the wedges in a bowl.
- 3. For the dressing, combine the lemon pepper in a large bowl. Slowly whisk in the olive oil. Pour the dressing over the onions and toss well.
- 4. With a slotted spoon, transfer the onions to a sheet pan, reserving the the onions for 30 to 45 minutes, until tender and browned. Toss the onions once during cooking. Remove from the oven, and drizzle with the reserved dressing. Sprinkle with parsley, season to taste and serve warm or at room temperature.

VIDALIA ONION PIE

Ingredients

- 3 cups Vidalia onions, thinly sliced
- 3 tablespoons butter, melted
- 1 (9-inch) prebaked deep dish pie shell
- 2 eggs, beaten
- 3 tablespoons all purpose flour
- 1/2 cup milk
- 1 1/2 cups sour cream
- 1 teaspoon kosher salt
- 4 slices bacon, crisply cooked and crumbled

Directions

- 1. Preheat oven to 325 °F.
- In a medium saucepan, melt the butter over medium heat. Add the onions and sauté until lightly browned.
- 3. Put the pie pan on a sheet pan. Line the bottom of pie crust with the onions.
- 4. In a small bowl, beat the eggs and the flour together to combine. Add the milk, sour cream and salt. Mix
- well and pour over the onions. Garnish with the bacon and bake until firm in the center, about 30 minutes.
- 6. Transfer to a serving platter and serve.

QUICK PICKLED RED ONIONS

Ingredients

- 1 large red onion
- 1 c. apple cider vinegar
- 1/2 c. red wine vinegar
- 1/4 c. sugar
- 1 tsp. kosher salt
- 1/8 tsp. ground allspice
- pinch of red pepper flakes

Directions

- Slice the top and bottom off the onion and then slice onion in half, from top to bottom. Remove the outer peel. Lay the cut surfaces of the onion onto the cutting board, and then slice into half moons about 1/8" thick using a very sharp knife. I also recommend using a mandoline for slicing the onions, especially if you like super thin or very even slices.
- In a medium saucepan, whisk together apple cider vinegar, red wine vinegar, sugar, and salt. Place over medium-high heat and bring mixture to a boil. Whisk until sugar and salt dissolve, then remove pan from heat and whisk in allspice and red pepper flakes.
- Carefully add sliced onion to the pan and gently stir to combine. Let mixture cool completely at room temperature, stirring occasionally.
- 4. Pour into a glass container (I like to use a large canning jar), cover tightly with a lid, and



refrigerate until thoroughly chilled. The pickled flavor will intensify over time, but it's good to go after resting overnight in the refrigerator. This recipe is for refrigerator pickling only and needs to be stored in a refrigerator. Enjoy for up to one month.

TENNESSEE ONIONS

Ingredients

- 2-3 whole Vidalia onions or any sweet onion will do
- 4 tbsp stick unsalted butter
- · Garlic salt to taste
- Pepper to taste
- 1 Cup sharp cheddar cheese the better quality, the better taste
- 1 Cup mozzarella Cheese
- ½ cup Parmesan cheese
- Fresh oregano or other herbs for garnish

Instructions

- 1. Using non-stick cooking spray, prepare a 9x13 baking dish.
- 2. Heat over to 350
- 3. Slice the Vidalia onions in 1/4 to 1/2 inch slices and separate the rings.
- 4. Lay the rings in the prepared baking dish
- 5. Sprinkle the onion rings with garlic salt (about 1 tsp), pepper (about 1/2 tsp).
- 6. Cut the butter into pats and place around the dish on top of the onions.
- Spread the cheddar and mozzarella cheeses on top of the onions and then top with the grated Parmesan cheese.
- 8. Bake at 350 uncovered for 30 minutes or until bubbly and the cheese has started to brown (browned cheese bits is one of the best parts!)
- 9. Remove from the oven, allow to cool for a few minutes, garnish with some fresh herbs (oregano, chives, thyme all work well) and then serve.


"I Did It My Way"

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

Hello Gardeners,

May this find your spring gardens well under way, whether they be flowers, veggies, fruit trees or potted herbs or whatever you are growing. It is the time when I get overzealous looking at all the things I want to plant, and then wind up with a very crowded garden due to the lush growth of the mature plants ("It's small, it won't take up much space." NOT.). I get fooled every time! Come the inevitable drought periods and all my time is spent trying to keep up with the watering.

However, this year I have discovered the delight of sharing the overgrowth with appreciative friends...PLUS making green smoothies (In your blender or juicer, add some kale, chard, an apple, cucumber, celery, a bit of ginger, plus a smidgeon of honey—a real pick-me-up!}

Love Letters From Grandpa, Literally


