# Pitching key to Bobcats' sweep of Mineral Area (Missouri) By Shawn Wansley, JCJC Sports Information Director

Through the early stages of the 2016 season, the Jones County Junior College offense has been receiving high marks and deservedly so.

But here Saturday afternoon at Community Bank Park, it was the Bobcat pitching staff that was front and center.

Calder Mikell and Mason Strickland combined on a 3-0 shutout over Mineral Area College (Missouri) in game one. In game two, JCJC took a shutout into the final inning before the Cardinals scored. But the Bobcats completed the sweep with an 8-4 victory.

The Bobcats have outscored their opponents 100-21 through eight contests.

JCJC is now 8-0 and will travel to Brewton, Alabama, to take on Jefferson Davis Community College in a noon doubleheader on Thursday.

Mineral Area, 2-6, will go to Pensacola, Florida, and play four games in a tournament on Friday-Saturday.

Last year the two took home top honors in the 2015 Great Southern Youth Rodeo Association series, competing against 30 other boys and girls in the finals. Smith was the GSYRA series Champion calf rider and bareback rider in the seven to nine year old category, and finished fourth in the All-Around Cowboy competition. Landrum was the GSYRA series Champion in the seven to nine year old category in the Goat Throw competition, and finished eighth in the All-Around Cowboy competition. Additionally Landrum was the overall Goat Throw Champion at the second day Rodeo finals.

Landrum and Smith are the children of Doug and Kelli Landrum of Soso, and are both honor students at West Jones Elementary School. In addition to their pursuing their rodeo aspirations, the boys enjoy volunteering at Horses for Handicapped and Camp Sunshine for Individuals with Disabilities, and are active members of Open Door Baptist Church.

Kelli, said the entire family is involved in the rodeo scene in one way or another. Their dad, Doug, is the Wagon Master for a Dixie National Wagon Train, and she teaches horseback riding and spends a lot of time with teaching the handicap to ride. In her younger days she competed in horseback barrel racing. and carried the flag on horseback for Harper Morgan Rodeo Classic and Dixie Nationals. Even their 16 month old daughter, Kylee, received her first belt buckle last year for being the 2015 Youngest Cowgirl.

"She looks at it all the time, and carries it around with her," exclaimed Kelli. "She loves her pony, too. We have to wait for her to literally fall asleep before we can get her off. Otherwise, she would be screaming to get back on. I think we're in trouble with her, too."

Kelli said the decision to enter the national scene were the boys' idea. "We were watching the National Rodeo Finals on TV last year, and they started out with the Mini Bareback Rider World Championship competition," explained Kelli. "Kross looked at me and said, 'I want to do that." But, son, I said, that is on a whole different level. He said he didn't care that he wanted to do that. Lane was all for it, too. So, here we go. This year we will be traveling to Kentucky, Tennessee, Alabama, Oklahoma, Louisiana, and Arkansas. And, hopefully, we will be in Las Vegas in December for the World Championship." She added that the boys will also be attending a couple of professionally taught rodeo schools throughout the year.

"It's going to be a lot of traveling, and a lot of hard work," exclaimed Kelli. "And the boys have to maintain an A average in school, or we don't rodeo." She added that the boys spend a lot of time training and working out. "They have to work on balance training, and strength training. They have to exercise, and work out just like other athletes."

More than 150 contestants, ages 18 and under, from all over the Southeast entered in the Great Southern Youth Rodeo Series last year. "I have to say, that those involved in the sport of Rodeo are the nicest group of parents and kids. They are all so supportive of each other, even though they are in competition with one another. You can watch the older boys helping out the younger ones, and they all cheer for each other. It's amaz-

ing how well they all get along. It's a great positive experience for all of






