

Veteran's Memorial Museum celebrates Veteran's Day

People from Laurel/Jones County and surrounding areas gathered at the Veteran's Memorial Museum in Laurel Wednesday, November 11, to celebrate our veterans, past and present.

Veteran Rob Ruffin, who volunteers at the museum, welcomed everyone, and Rev. Gene Douglas, Senior Pastor at Highland Baptist Church in Laurel, gave the invocation. Northeast Jones Golden Horizons sang the "National Anthem," and the colors were presented by members of Trail Life USA Troop 38 with Troop Master John Robertson. Ruffin recognized Gold Star Mothers and families of veterans and Golden Horizons sang "America the Beautiful."

Keynote speaker for the celebration was Lt. Col. Joseph Worley, who served 26 years in the military, five of those on foreign soil. He served in peace times and in war. "The volunteer military is our nation's strength; past and present," stated Worley. "Their families have served, also, and deserve our respect and appreciation."

Serving as a logistician, in 2010, Worley worked on developing a system to move the thousands of pounds of mail being sent to our troops in Afghanistan. "We had to make it (the packages and mail) move fast and efficiently. It moved on contract trucks, contract aircraft, Army trucks, Air Force aircraft, and we even moved it by donkey at the most farthest points in Afghanistan. There were some days we had over 100,000 pounds of mail coming in." He said they were able to work out a system that would deliver the thousands of pounds of mail within 14 days.

Back home in Jones County, the real world

Don't you love the cooler weather? I feel like I could sleep all day...wishful thinking. Before you get too comfortable thinking there are no garden chores to take care of during November...think again!



We spent most of today sprucing up the yard. We trimmed the leggy blackberries, cleaned up the many flower beds and trimmed brown tops from perennials.

During the drought this summer, I decided that at least one flowerbed had to go; too much to water. In the chosen flowerbed, I dug up all the iris to replant somewhere; husband removed dead bottlebrush, and we transplanted the confederate rose(although it did not bloom at all this year). After filling in the holes, we leveled the soil and mowed over it.

After that, we removed some straggly crepe myrtles from the front of the yard. Had to use and axe on one of them. We cut back a few more things then called it a day. All this was in the front yard, we'll tackle the side and back next, after we rest up from today.

Lets just talk about bulbs for a while. Now is the time to plant spring flowering varieties, my absolute favorite is yellow daffodils. When buying bulbs, select the biggest and firmest ones in the pile, the flowers will be prettier. According to Felder Rushing, whose gardening knowledge and style I greatly admire, daffodils are narcissus and vice versa. Different species sometimes have distinct common names -- paper whites and jonquils, for example, but they are all daffodils. And narcissus.

I recently planted paperwhite narcissus for forced blooming indoors. This means I'm forcing them to bloom now, instead of their usual bloom period, which is spring. The simplest way to do this is to put a few bulbs close together in a small pot or shallow bowl, fill in around them with gravel to hold them upright and fill halfway up the bulbs with water. Keep in a cool place indoors until they begin to sprout then move to a sunny window and keep them watered. You can expect flowers in three to four weeks. You may have to tie the greenery together loosely with twine, to keep them from flopping over. After being forced to bloom in water, the bulbs will not survive outdoors, compost them.

Ever wonder why your daffodils don't bloom? Felder says the usual culprits are:

- Too much shade in the spring
- Poor drainage, bulbs rot
- Too much nitrogen fertilizer, or no fertilizer at all
- · Crowded bulbs may need lifting and dividing
- Leaves are cut off too early in the spring
- Plants are moved when in flower
- Varieties planted are not suited for the South

Go buy some paperwhites and "force" them to bloom for you. They smell "delectable" (a very good word I heard from a precocious grandchild).

"There are other ways other than shaking their hands and telling the stories that we can do to honor our military," said Worley. He suggested supporting a military foundation or military program, and suggested supporting USM which has an excellent Army ROTC program. "I ask that you support organizations such as Operation Heal Our Patriots, which is a program within Samaritan Purse that serves couples, and helps them in their marriage. I would also ask that you encourage businesses and other community organizations to hire military veterans and their family members."

Following Worley's keynote address, members of the Jones County Rosin Heels, Camp 227, Sons of Confederate Veterans presented a 21-Gun Salute, followed by the playing of "Taps" by South Jones High School freshman band student Jarod Bush. Following the program, refreshments were served inside the museum, and cups of Jambalaya, prepared by Rev. Douglas, was also served.

LCS freestyler Kash Eason signs with D2 National Champs Drury University

Laurel Christian School senior Kash Eason has signed a Letter of Intent to attend Drury University, a Division II school, as a member of the Men's Swimming and Diving team starting next summer. Eason and his parents, Ronald and Meg Eason, signed the paperwork in front of the entire LCS senior class Friday morning, November 13.

From 2005 to 2014, Drury University Men's Swimming and Diving claimed 10 consecutive Men's Swimming and Diving D-II National Championships; the longest streak in NCAA-II history. DU is only the eighth school at any level to win 10 straight titles in any sport in the history of NCAA.

"They're the best," exclaimed Eason. "Their times are better than most of the Division I schools."

According to Eason's father, Kash had 50 colleges and universities interested in him. But, after visiting DU he told his parents, "That's the place I need to be." "I liked the campus and the coaches," said Eason.

Eason is receiving an Academic and Athletic Scholarship. He has been on the honor roll every year since the 1st grade and the Headmaster's list this year, and is a member of the Honor Society. He received an English II award, and competed in the ABC competition for Algebra II.

Eason is a member of the Laurel Swim Association and has been working with Coach Warren Holladay since age four. Since age five, he has been top five in multiple events in the state, and has been number one in Mississippi since age 13 in the 1500y free, 1650y free, 800y free, and 1000y free.

"Kash is a hard worker," stated Holladay. "He's always swum hard, but when he was 13 or 14 years old, is when he started really caring about where he was and what his times were doing. Swimming is a hard sport. They have to work a lot. He'd come in at 5:30 in the morning, and we would swim five or six thousand yards, which is three or four miles in the morning. Then he would come back in the afternoon and we'd swim eight thousand or nine thousand yards, which is another five or six miles. If you're going to swim at a high level, it requires a time commitment and a personal commitment." Holladay said he has been coaching his entire life. He began coaching when he was 18 years old, and he

is now 62. In his long career, he has coached several Olympic swimmers. "I think Drury is a good match for Kash. They have long tradition of competing at a high level, and they've always had a good long distance program, which is what Kash does. I think Kash's future is bright in swimming. I see him getting bigger, faster, and stronger."

Eason said that being selected to the USA Olympic Swim Team has been a goal of his since watching the 2012 Olympics on TV. He said he looks up to the career of a lesser known long course swimmer, Conner Jaeger, who was a member of the 2012 USA Olympic Swim Team, and has set a national record in the 1500 free.

Eason's father said that since the 10th grade, Kash has been taking online courses with the goal of having more time to spend toward swimming in his senior year. "He works out six hours a day, six days a week," exclaimed Ronald. "I bet he swims 60 or 70 miles a week. He's six foot, four inches tall, and only weighs 146 pounds; and that's all muscle, no fat.

Friday night, Eason was back in the pool competing with the Laurel Swim Association at the Laurel Sportsplex Natatorium. Three weeks ago, he broke the 17 and over 1650 free record for the State of Mississippi with a time of 15:56. Friday night, he broke that record with a time of 15:49. When he knocks off 3 tenths of a second more to his time, he will qualify to compete in the Junior National Championship in December in Austin, Texas.
