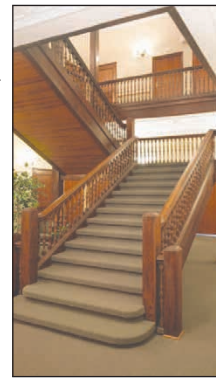

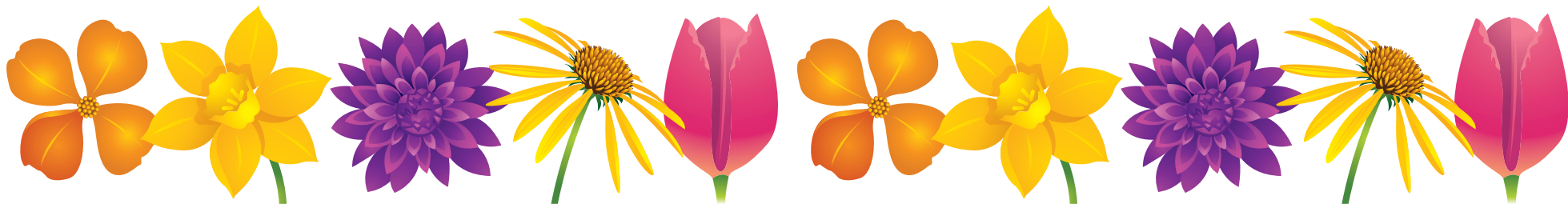

Travel Thoughts By Kim

Let's go on an adventure together.... flash back to my first cruise!



A beach somewhere in Jamaica. Since I couldn't find the photo album from the cruise, I found this representative photo on the internet.

My very first cruise...and my first major vacation...and my first time out of the country a few years ago when I was in my early 20s. I don't remember the date and sadly can't find the photo album (it must be packed away somewhere), but it was in January in the late 1970s - maybe 1978? So, just a few years ago. My great aunt Betty offered to take me on a cruise and I was thrilled at the chance. We planned and prepared and the anticipation built into a frenzy. I remember she came over one day and presented me with a gift. When I opened it, I found a new pair of adorable pajamas. I think that may have been the start of a lifelong habit of always purchasing a brand new pair of pajamas every time I plan a trip - it's just something I always do and never really made the connection until I was recently remembering this trip with my aunt.

The cruise line she booked us on was Carnival and the ship was the Mardi Gras. It was a two week cruise with stops at Cozumel Mexico, Georgetown Grand Cayman, and Ocho Rios Jamaica. We sailed out of Florida - don't remember which port, but thinking

it was Tampa. It took some getting used to being on a ship for the first time. After we left Cozumel, we sailed through a tropical storm - a bad one! The ship rocked and rolled and drastically pitched and we learned later that oil rigs near where we were sailing were evacuated. I was so ill. I learned on that first cruise that you should never go lie down when sea sick - a mistake I made that I will try to never make again. The best thing to do is stay out in the fresh air, if at all possible, and focus on the horizon. I also learned that apples and saltine crackers are the best things to eat when sea sick. Our room steward brought a basket of apples and saltines to the room for me when he heard I was ill. It was the only thing I could keep down. I am shocked I ever got on another cruise ship after that experience. But - once we got through the storm, it was smooth sailing and all was good, again. Luckily, I have never experienced rough seas to that extend since....so far....knock on wood!

In Cozumel, we shopped at a local market and visited a nearby beach. At night, we went to a dinner show - a traditional Mexican meal and folk dancers. It was

amazing. The show included some flamingo dancers whose amazing talents caused me to be sorely disappointed in the flamingo dancers I saw in Barcelona years later.

Grand Cayman in the Cayman Islands was gorgeous. We took a bus tour that took us all over the island. We visited a turtle farm and even spent some time in Hell! Hell is famous for its limestone and lava rock formations along the shoreline and even has a post office where you can have your post cards postmarked from Hell. Very interesting and bazaar sight for a young girl who had never seen anything like it before. I was surprised to see turtle meat on the menu at a restaurant where we had lunch. I didn't try it.

I loved Jamaica. We docked in Ocho Rios. After shopping in the markets near the port, we hired a taxi to take us around to see the island. We must have been there two days - not sure - but that took a whole day and we also took a bus tour to Dunn's River Falls, so I'm thinking we were there more than one day. We also spent some time on the beach where I tried conch - don't remember if I liked it or not - and got the worst sunburn I've ever had in my life! For many years, I had a jar with white sand and shells from that beach. Sadly, it got broke and the sand was lost on my move back to Albion in 2011.

I loved my great aunt Betty and have been grateful to her for opening my eyes to the world through this cruise. I have been thinking a lot lately about going back to Jamaica. I had booked a cruise that had the same stops with the Royal Caribbean cruise line in May 2020 - it was leave out of Galveston, TX, but it got canceled due to Covid. I've also been looking at an all-inclusive resort in Montego Bay that I may do at some point. We'll see if and when I ever get back to Jamaica so that I can do a blog post with all the details and photos.

Advanced Manufacturing and Engineering Program Shoots for the Stars!

The Advanced Manufacturing and Engineering students, at the Orleans Career and Technical Education Center, will have their names in space next year!

Teacher Bill Rakonczay's students signed a locker that will be going to the International Space Station (ISS) thanks to their partnership with NASA's HUNCH program. The students made a part for the stowage lockers and to recognize their hard work - Gene Gordon, a NASA HUNCH mentor - stopped in to have the seniors sign one of the lockers. The HUNCH mission is to empower and inspire students through project based learning program where high school students learn 21st Century skills and have the opportunity to launch their careers through the participation in the design and fabrication of real world valued products for NASA.

Space flight equipment is one of HUNCH's largest programs allowing students to create high quality hardware items for the International Space Station. Since the projects are likely to fly to the ISS, they need to be of the highest quality and meet stringent tolerances applied to all hardware for the ISS.

What a great experience for the students and something pretty amazing to put on their resume! Mr. Gordon thanked everyone for their hard work and told them how much he enjoys working with high school students who are passionate about career and technical education. He also gifted a video screen to Mr. Rakonczay so that he could show the students' work to visitors to the building.

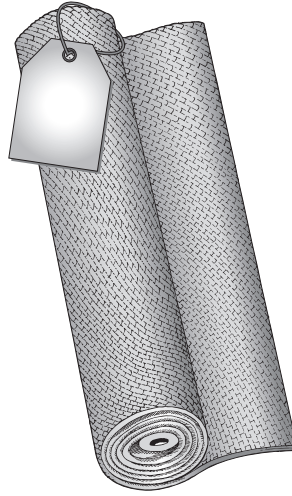

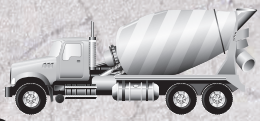

Of the 29 projects it studied for its 2017 "Cost vs. Value Report," Remodeling magazine found that the average payback in resale value was 64.3 cents. The lone project in the 2017 report to return a higher value than its cost was the installation of loose-fill insulation in an attic, which provided a return of 107.7 percent. Homeowners who replaced an existing entry door with a 20-gauge steel unit recouped 90.7 percent of their investment at resale, placing that project second on the list. What helps homeowners who finance such projects recoup their associated costs is the relatively low sticker price of the projects, which both rank among the five least expensive projects examined in the 2017 report. But a recovering real estate market has helped homeowners recoup more of their investments on some expensive projects as well. For example, the 2017 report saw the biggest year-over-year percentage increases in value on expensive projects like upscale bathroom remodels, upscale master suites, two-story additions, grand entrance installations, and family room additions. The increase in value on those projects ranged from 5.6 percent to 7.4 percent from a year earlier.

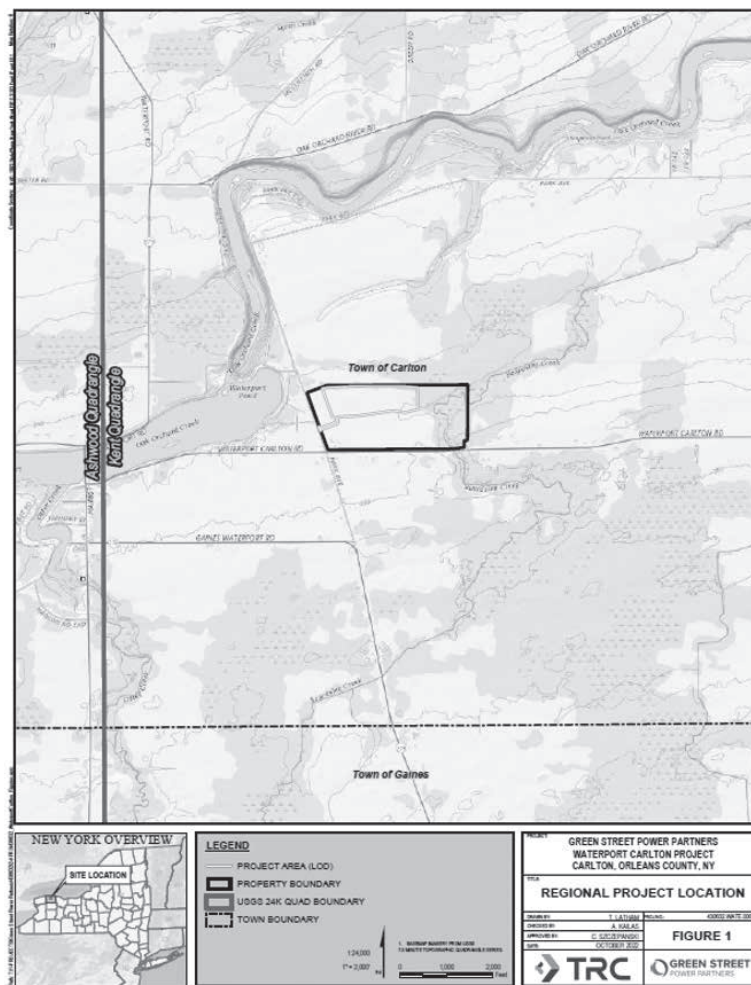
