September and October are two months we get calls on the coverage gap or "donut hole". This happens because there is a temporary limit on what your drug plan will pay while you are in the gap. The good news is not everyone will enter the coverage gap. The coverage gap begins after you and your plan have spent a certain amount on covered drugs. In 2023 once you and your plan combined have spent \$4,700 you will enter the coverage gap.

Here's the way the coverage gap works. Imagine you have a prescription that retails for \$400 per month. Your copay, hypothetically, is \$30. This means your plan would pay the rest of the cost or \$370. Medicare will track what you paid (\$30) and what your plan paid (\$370) and count the cost of the drug as \$400 for that month. Let's also say that the other prescriptions you are taking equals \$100 per month. You are now at \$500 per month. In this example you would reach the coverage gap sometime in September.

Under most plans in 2023 once you have reached the coverage gap your plan will temporarily stop paying anything on your drugs. This means you will be responsible for the entire cost of your prescriptions. The silver lining around this very dark cloud is Medicare has negotiated a discount on the drugs you use. For name brand drugs and/or generic drugs you will pay 25% of the retail price.

If you are eligible for Medicare but still on employer coverage you may wonder why you have never reach the coverage gap. This is because employer coverage does not have the "donut hole". The coverage gap only applies to Medicare prescription drug plans. Also remember that Medicare drug plans can vary which means your coverage in the gap can vary.



announces the release of Cobb's first published work, *Black Folktales of the Muscle Shoals*. This historical memoir, coauthored with Rickey Butch Walker, captures the history and heritage of the Black individuals of northwest Alabama.

This book explores the long history of Black people in the region from the 18th century frontier and antebellum slavery to the rise of Jim Crow segregation and the civil rights movement. Section. The SFMNP provides eligible seniors with a \$50 benefit card to purchase fresh fruits and vegetables from certified farmers at farmers markets and farm stands in the state of Alabama. Senior applicants must be 60 years of age or older, and the gross household

income must not exceed \$2,096/mo for a household of one or \$2,823/mo for a household of two. Sign-ups are online only which can often be confusing.

A FEW YEARS AGO, A NEW SOCIAL MEDIA APP stormed into the digital world called TicTok. TikTok is a Chinese-owned video-sharing app. Users can shoot, edit, and share short videos jazzed up with filters, music, animation, special effects, and more. Like other social

media apps such as Facebook and Twitter, users can also follow, like, and comment on everything they see. That sounds like fun except that security

experts have been sounding the alarm that TicTok could be used by the Chinese government to spy on Americans.

These experts are concerned that TikTok could be used to collect sensitive personal data

including location data and other information that could be used for nefarious purposes. Additionally, there are concerns that the Chinese government could use TikTok to spread propaganda or influence public opinion. This was a big issue with Facebook and Twitter during the past two presidential elections and will be an even bigger issue in 2024.

Some other concerns are that TikTok's vast amount of user data could be used to gather intelligence on individuals, organizations, and governments including sensitive information such as personal contacts, and political affiliations. Chinese

authorities could use TikTok data to track the movements and activities of people of interest, including political dissidents, human rights activists, and other individuals who are seen as a threat to Chinese interests.

In response to these concerns, the US government has taken steps to restrict the use of TikTok by government employees and contractors and has also attempted to force the owners of TicTok to divest its ownership to a US-based company.

However, it's important to note that TikTok is just one app in a vast, commercial surveillance ecosystem. If you

have a smartphone and don't use other social media platforms. any social media apps at all, vast numbers of people still know everything about you; your location, name, address, where you work, shopping habits, income level, and whatever else wireless phone companies can glean from your phone. If you use social media apps, then Facebook, Twitter, and even weather apps know even more about you than you and they share that data with others. So from that standpoint, TicTok is no more of a threat than any other app.

Experts have scoured the data that TicTok gathers and there is currently no conclusive evidence that TikTok is being used to collect sensitive data or engage in malicious activities. It's possible that the concerns about TikTok are overblown, and that the app is no more of a threat to national security than

But it is owned by a Chinese company, and China and the US currently have an adversarial relationship. That should give any American some pause.

Ultimately, the question of whether TikTok is a threat to national security is a complex and multifaceted issue that requires careful consideration of all the available evidence. However, I won't be installing it as long as it is owned by a Chinese company.



A February TimesDaily article, entitled, "City approves over \$33M in bonds" details how the Florence City Council plans to spend the approved \$33.38 million bond issue. The largest chunk would be for parks and recreation projects. The projects listed include McFarland Park \$10.6 million; Sportsplex bog \$8.7million: Sportsplex synthetic turf field - \$2.1 million; pickleball and tennis courts at Veterans Park \$10.9 million; Seminary Street - \$1 million; and the proposed College Street bridge - \$2.5 million.

It is disappointing that this item was not shown on the agenda posted on the internet prior to the meeting. This means the item was added at the meeting which is unfair to citizens. The proper procedure would be to provide the projects and cost to the *TimesDaily* for inclusion in a Sunday beforehand article or even in Tuesday's paper, the day of the nighttime meeting. The city did not provide the TimesDaily with the annual payments, length of bond issue, or the total interest to be paid. All council members voted in favor of the bond issue except for council

member Simmons, in District 1, who stated, "West Florence (her district) wants a piece of the action."

Why ignore one sixth of our citizens? City will be in elections August of 2024.

The \$10.939.125 allocation for pickleball and tennis courts at Veterans Park deserves attention.

review Let's prior history:

The following item appeared on the Council's Agenda for the July 11, 2017 meeting: Resolution to request the Public Park Authority of the Shoals approve the redevelopment plan for Veterans Park, including the construction of the tennis facility complex and request the release \$2,000,000 reserve funds to be used to construct the proposed improvements, sponsored by Bill Musgrove. The resolution did not receive immediate consideration. Therefore, it will be presented at the next City Council meeting on July 18, 2017.) The resolution appeared on the agenda for the July 18 meeting, but it was later removed. At the August 1 Council meeting, a vote was taken on the resolution and it failed. President Jordan and then-member Betterton voted yes. Members Simmons. Bradley, Eubanks, and Edwards voted no.

Alabama's(RSA) chief executive, asked that the money be turned over for renovations of the Conference Center in Florence. RSA had taken over management of the conference center and of the adjacent Renaissance Center. There was an agreement that called for the construction of an attraction in Veterans Park to help drive guest to the Marriott. This is being met with the work on the Heritage Trail that begins at Marriott plus \$2M for convention center. Remember. too, that the Tennessee Valley Authority, which owns the Veterans Park and leases it to Florence, allow would not commercial activity

there. The other article was entitled, "Council gets dozens of ideas." Mayor Holt called for a meeting of citizens on how Veterans Park could best be used. At the September 5, 2017 council meeting, all members voted to give the \$2,000,000 to RSA for improving the Convention Center and ignoring citizens!!

Once again, city elections will be in August 2024!

Issues To Consider In An On The Job **Injury Settlement**

Workers compensation pays for medical bills related to an on the job injury, temporary total disability benefits, vocational disability, future medical services and permanent partial or permanent total disability.

Those are a lot of issues to consider. Often there are other issues that an employer will want to consider such as a voluntary resignation and occasionally confidentiality of the terms of the settlement. Another consideration is the inclusion of "social security language" which can and does

protect social security benefits from being reduced if the njured worker obtains social security disability also.

It seems difficult and overly complicated, and it can be. One of the difficulties that lawyers occasionally encounter are judges who have different standards or approving a settlement. Some judges just will not close future medical benefits and other judges require uture medical benefits be handled by a third party dministrator. All judges advise injured workers of their ights in a settlement. Some judges do it very simply by elling the injured worker that if they get better, they keep the money, but if they get worse, they don't get any nore and advise them about their rights to keep their future medical benefits open for life. I've never seen a udge do a bad job, but I have seen different standards applied by different courts.

In my opinion, sometimes it's extremely advantageous to close future medical benefits simply because there is no future medical treatment related to the injury. If someone is on expensive medication or has hardware that can potentially cause problems, then absolutely leave medicals open. On the other hand, the next time somebody has a fall or a car accident, the workers compensation carrier will deny treatment and the injured worker won't get medical treatment and may not be entitled to it.

There are other ways to get settlements approved, but the important point is that the injured workers understand their rights and make the decision that is best for them.






