Those insects will also draw in various birds and other animals. Woodpeckers will chisel away, creating cavities that other critters will use as homes! Squirrels, chickadees, owls, and other cavity nesting animals will use the dead tree. The root system is also important, feeding ground insects, fungi, and bacteria. This will decompose those systems and help to reintroduce nutrients back into the soil! White it is important to remove dead trees if they are near a building or power line, sometimes it is important to leave them standing!




Street E and construct a pedestrian multi-use trail along the west side of Highway 25 from 10th Avenue NE over the new bridge to 28th Street E.


