Laurel Mayor Johnny Magee performed a swearing-in ceremony Monday morning, September 14, for five Laurel Fire Department firefighters who were awarded a promotion in rank. Laurel Fire Chief James Brown also announced the addition of three new firefighters to the department.

The five firefighters became eligible for promotion after taking an exam, and finishing in the top percentile. Kerry Holifield was promoted to Battalion Chief, Richard Davis to Captain, Joseph Purvis to Captain, Jeffrey McLain to Lieutenant, and Mitch Brown to Lieutenant.

Holifield, a 24-year veteran of the Laurel Fire Department, said, "I'm glad to be able to step up and have the opportunity to serve." Holifield's Uncle Ken Keyes, who retired from the LFD, held the Bible during the swearing-in. As Keyes pinned the new badge

JCJC's Bobcat Math League teams launch into action

High school mathletes wasted no time battling for the first place spot in the first week of Jones County Junior College's Bobcat Math League competition. As the fourth season begins, the four new teams to the League didn't get a warm welcome from the League's high school math teams. The Leagues' perennial winners easily rose to the top-of-the-ranks in their respective divisions.

In the Einstein Division, Sacred Heart secured the top spot beating newcomers, Wayne Academy 86 to 9. Helping the Crusaders with the win was mathlete Matthew Gallardo who scored a perfect, 100-percent on his individual performance. The Mustangs of West Jones stomped on their new opponents, Heidelberg High School with a 32-20 win. Wayne County's War Eagles had a tough time with the Cougars of Lawrence County, suffering a 29-44 loss to the Lawrence County Cougars. Wayne County secured the third place position in the Einstein division while Lawrence County also landed in third place in the Euclid Division based on their cumulative points compared to their division's teams.

The Red Devils of Stringer whipped up a big win against the Seminary Bulldogs, 108 to 15 and secured the first place slot in the Euclid Division. The Laurel Tornados handed the Bay Springs Bulldogs a 44-21 loss in this first week of competition.

As expected, the Oak Grove Warriors of the Fibonacci Division wasted no time taking the top slot. The Warriors slaughtered newcomers, the Greene County Wildcats, 118 to 18. Oak Grove scored the most cumulative points overall in a match with two mathletes, Allen Huang and Peter Liang performing perfectly with 100-percent accuracy. The Perry Central Bulldogs chewed up the Heidelberg Academy Rebels with a 21 to 7 victory which was good enough to take the second place in

the division. The Richton Rebels also began the season wounded with a solid win by the Northeast Jones Tigers of the Pythagoras Division, 58 to 13.

The Tigers of Northeast Jones are first place in the Pythagoras Division with the Columbia Academy Cougars on their heels. Columbia Academy defeated the Mt. Olive Pirates with a 39 to 20 triumph. Collins' Tigers jumped past the Sylva Bay Saints with a narrow win, 21 to 15.

The Bobcats of Presbyterian Christian High School had no trouble trouncing on BML novices, the Enterprise Bulldogs in their first match of the season. PCS's 100 points sent Enterprise packing with its 32 points. Taylorsville's Tartars turned out a win against Quitman's Panthers, 47 to 10. In third place in the division, the South Jones Braves narrowly escaped the jaws of defeat from the Raleigh Lions, winning, 25 to 23.

Perfect scorers, Matthew Gallardo of Sacred Heart, Key'Shawn Johnson of Stringer, Allen Huang of Oak Grove and Peter Liang of Oak Grove share the Most Outstanding Player title with a four-way tie amongst the perfect scorers. Five students tied with 80-percent accuracy in their competitions.

Next week's matches won't get any easier for the four newcomers as Heidelberg faces Sacred Heart, Wayne Academy will duke it out with county rival, Wayne County, Enterprise will try to knock off South Jones and Greene County will try to get a win from Mt. Olive.

All about Alpacas at the Y

Scarves, sweaters, hats, and socks are just a few of the items made from the alpaca fleece fiber. Mary Ann Stroka, owner of the Stringer Alpaca Farm, presented a program at the YWCO, Tuesday, September 15, explaining and demonstrating how the alpaca fleece fiber is spun into yarn, and used to make several clothing items, as well as other useful products.

Stroka said the alpaca resembles a small llama in appearance, and was first imported to the United States from Peru in 1984

and was stopped six years later; making it a more profitable business model. They are now being successfully raised throughout North America. The alpaca's fleece is one of the world's finest and most luxurious natural fibers, and is comparable to cashmere. It is three times warmer, and ten times softer than wool. The alpacas are sheared once a year and their fleece fiber is prepared for use by Stroka, or shipped to an alpaca fiber mill for processing.

"One of the first questions people ask is do the alpacas spit at you. "They will spit at each other, usually over food, but they don't spit at people," explained Stroka.

Stroka mentioned another interesting product produced by the alpaca. "The alpaca poop is great for plants," said Stroka. "It is non-acidic and can be used directly on pot plants. It won't burn the plants and it has no smell. I had one customer tell me she used it in her garden, and it kept the deer away."

Stroka and her husband, Terry, moved to Stringer from New York State in 2012 with their herd of 31 alpacas and two Great White Pyrenees dogs, Snow and Ice, who protect the herd. The first Mississippi alpaca, Ginger, was born shortly after arriving in Stringer. In the past three years, Stroka has acquired more animals and the herd has now grown to approximately 50 animals, plus

two young Great White Pyrenees, Thunder and Lightning, who are learning the guard duties from Snow and Ice. In addition, the farm includes two llamas, and more than 25 "Easter egger" chickens, and guineas. Stroka's daughter, Dawn Stoll, her husband, Rob, and two children, Alex and Austin, live nearby and help out on

the farm. Dawn also raises Angora goats and rabbits.

Stroka said there is always something happening at the farm. She and her daughter offer crocheting and spinning lessons. They have organized a Fiber Arts Club that meets at the farm the third Saturday of each month. And, they have farm tours and a Farm Store filled with Stroka's and Dawn's personally handmade items as well as items imported from Peru. Two festivals are held each year at the farm which includes 30 to 40 vendors participating; one in March to allow people to see the alpacas in full fleece before shearing, and one in November, the Saturday before Thanksgiving. 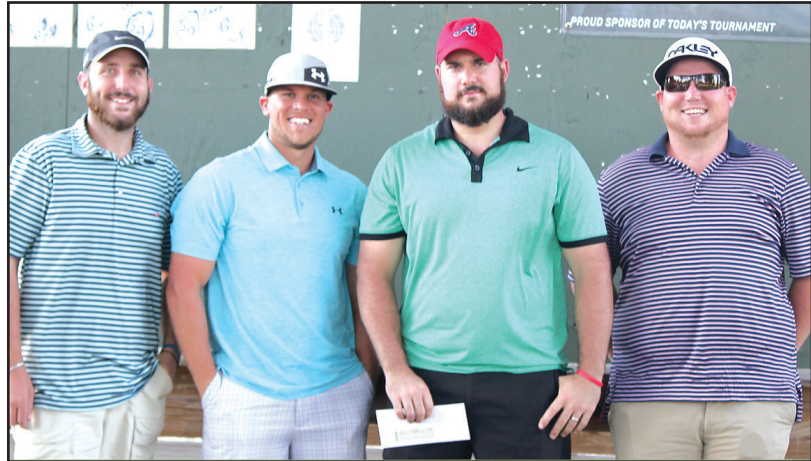
Lewis is married to her husband Tim, and they have two sons Jake 15, and Rob 12.

Brett Favre is among the 108 nominees for the Pro Football Hall of Fame class of 2016 announced last week. The NFL's career leader in several passing stats when he retired after the 2010 season and winner of the 1997 Super Bowl with Green Bay leads this year's field.



Another first-year-eligible nominee is Laurel native Clinton Portis, and the late Ken Stabler is also on the senior ballot. The nominees consist of 93 players and 15 coaches. They will be trimmed to 25 semifinalists in November and from there to 15 finalists in January. Voting will culminate Feb. 6, the night before the Super Bowl. While there is no set number for any class of enshrinees, the selection process by-laws provide that between four and eight new members will be selected. He finished up with Minnesota for two seasons following 16 in Green Bay and one with the Jets. He spent his rookie season with Atlanta before being traded to the Packers. Portis played for both Denver and Washington.

Delta State and William Carey will play on March 9 at MGM Park.

Ole Miss to play USM and MSU at Trustmark

The Rebels will also head to Trustmark Park in Pearl, Miss., for two games versus in-state foes. Ole Miss will face Southern Miss April 5 before battling Mississippi State April 26. The contest with the Bulldogs will be the annual Governor's Cup contest.

Local officers learn ways to combat animal cruelty and fighting

Local law enforcement officers have taken another step in combating the increasing problem of animal cruelty and fighting in our area by recently attending a seminar hosted by the Humane Society of the United States and the Jones County Sheriff's Department. The all-day seminar was held at the JCSD's Training Center with approximately 30 local law enforcement officers attending. The seminar was presented by HSUS animal cruelty and fighting investigations trainer and consultant Sgt. Ken Sullivan with the Rankin County Sheriff's Department, and HSUS Mississippi State Director Lydia Saddler.

The officers were instructed on ways to combat animal abuse, proper procedures for investigation, current laws, and the connection between animal fighting and other felony crimes. In addition the officers received training on collecting interviews and evidence as it relates to animal cruelty and fighting.

"Animal cruelty is a crime in the State of Mississippi, and people need to understand that they will be held accountable for it," exclaimed Saddler. "Our main focus is targeting the root cause of cruelty and putting a stop to it." Saddler said the HSUS does this by providing education, seeking changes in policy, and assisting local law enforcement in cases that exceed their resources.
