The purpose of the program is to remind people that doing something as simple as planting a tree can help prevent soil erosion and run-off into our streams, save energy, provide homes for wildlife, and make our community more attractive. This is a service provided to the landowners in Jasper County. Proceeds from tree sales help support youth and adult educational programs throughout the year.

You may come by the office to place your order Monday through Friday between 8:30 a.m. and 4:00 p.m. or call the office at 601-764-2025 ext. 101. A list of trees will be provided to you at the office. The Jasper County Soil and Water Conservation District is located in the USDA Service Building at 20 B East 8th Avenue, Bay Springs, MS.







#### **Offensive Player of the Week Nomination:**

Junior QB Nick Mullens (6-1, 196, Hoover, Ala.): Quarterback Nick Mullens threw for a career-best 447 yards and added a pair of touchdown throws on 26-of-41 passing against Nebraska. It was just the fourth 400yard passing day ever for a Golden Eagle quarterback and Mullens is the only Southern Miss player to have done it twice, after throwing for 426 at Middle Tennessee last season. He hit senior Casey Martin on touchdowns of 21 and 19, the first on a 3rd-and-20 and the second score on a 4th-and-4. Mullens led a 21-point fourth-quarter scoring outburst that enabled Southern Miss a chance to tie the contest on the game's last possession. He also tallied 10 passing plays of 20 or more yards, including one of 50 and another of 53 yards. Mullens has now thrown for over 200-yards in 18-of-20 career starts, which ranks third on the Golden Eagle chart, while his seven 300-plus passing yards ranks second on the Golden Eagle career chart.

#### **Defensive Player of the Week Nomination:**

Junior DB D'Nerius Antoine (6-0, 215, New Iberia, La.): Led the Golden Eagles with eight tackles (three solo) at Nebraska of which one was for loss. He tallied his first career interception that was returned 30 yards deep inside Nebraska territory, which was turned into the first touchdown of the day for Southern Miss. He added a forced fumble of which he recovered in the third quarter. He leads the team in tackles this season with 25 and has two forced fumbles to his credit during

#### Notes

- After producing 10 passing plays of 20-or-more yards against Nebraska, the Golden Eagles now have accumulated 28 offensive plays of 20-plus yards in 2015 (5 rushing, 23 passing), seven of which have gone for touchdowns.
- The Golden Eagles have enjoyed quick-strike scoring this season, producing 13 touchdowns that have taken less than two minutes off the game clock.
- · Southern Miss registered its first game in which two receivers had at least 100 yards receiving - Mike Thomas five catches for 121 yards and Casey Martin with eight catches for 102 yards – since Thomas (7-104) and Markese Triplett (6-114) last year against Louisiana
- · Senior WR Casey Martin tied a career-best with eight catches at Nebraska, posting his second-straight 100-yard receiving game and third of his career.
- Fellow senior Mike Thomas enjoyed the first 100yard receiving contest this season at Nebraska and third of his career.
- Redshirt sophomore Xavier Thigpen registered the team's lone sack at Nebraska for 12 yards and added three tackles as well as recovering an onside kick in the fourth quarter.
- Sophomore Picasso Nelson, Jr., in his first start of the year, tallied seven tackles against the Huskers.
- The Golden Eagles blocked a Nebraska field goal in the final minute of the contest and Southern Miss now has a pair of blocks this season.

# Mississippians in New York for Heisman?

Mississippi could have three players receive Heisman Trophy consideration this December. Ole Miss quarterback Chad Kelly and defensive lineman Robert Nikemdiche along with MSU quarterback Dak



Prescott are all having great seasons, and if their teams keep winning, one may be heading to New York for the prize possession as being the best player in college football in 2015. The SEC is loaded with talent as always, and Georgia's Nick Chubb, LSU's Leonard Fournette and Alabama's Derrick Henry will also receive consideration come voting time.

The sports world lost a great one last week. We lost the beloved "little man" of the New York Yankees in Yogi Berra. I was able to see Yogi play in person several times in my very young days as a lad in Baltimore and Kansas City. Yogi played for several of the greatest New York Yankee baseball teams of the 1950s. The Yankees were like a rock band with every visit a sell out. Everyone wanted to see the great Yankees of that era in Yogi, Mickey, Whitey, Bobby Richardson, Roger Maris, Ellie, Moose and the rest of the boys. Berra was a three-time MVP, but he might have become more famous after his playing days. His popularity spanned decades. His many Yogism's are legendary. "It ain't over 'til it's over" may be his most quoted saying of all.

#### Mississippi's Best Coach Ever?

If he is not the best high school basketball coach ever, he is definitely on the short list. Former Gulfport coach Bert Jenkins passed away last week. The Richton native wrecked havoc on the high school basketball scene for 28 years. His Gulfport teams won 866 games and lost only 180, a winning percentage of 82.8 percent. His teams enjoyed three 40-win seasons, eighteen 30-win seasons, and twenty-five 20-win seasons. His successes came before integration and after. It was my pleasure to see several of his teams play over the years, and his teams always won. I never saw his teams lose. One of the best teams ever in Mississippi high school circles was his 1975 team. He led that team to a 40-0 perfect season. The 1975 team was an exceptionally talented team that scored over 100 points 14 times that year and ended the season by averaging over 91 points per game. His best coaching effort might have been in the 1983 state championship season. He had to suspend several starters that year and was coming off a losing season the year before. Jenkins coached one of the best high school players ever in Chris Jackson. He was a tough taskmaster on Jackson. Chris reached his full potential because of Jenkins and his coaching methods. Coach played his high school football and

basketball at Starkville High. He was a war hero under George S. Patton in Europe, and his experience in WW II was not forgotten on him.
