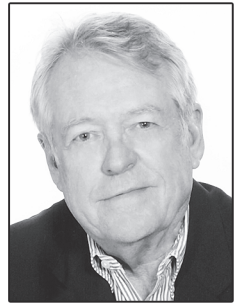

THE MAN BEHIND THE POSTERS

Tumbleweed Smith

You see posters of wildflowers in stores, homes and offices. Rick Vanderpool of Lubbock did them.

"You only see the big flowers at 70 miles an hour," he says. "If you get out of your vehicle you find the little jewels in the bar ditch. And you can find as many as 25 different flowers you would never see driving by."

Rick has traveled Texas taking photos of different things for his posters. "Cactus blooms, hamburgers, coffee, barbecue joints, spurs, all kinds of stuff."

He has made dozens of posters with his photos. The first one contained images of the word Texas.

"I photographed the word Texas made with rattlesnake rattles, barbed wire, horns, bottle caps, tattoos: you name it I've photographed it. That was a very popular poster."

He lived in his pickup while taking photos.

"I'd usually drive some place where I knew there would be a nice sunset or sunrise. I wanted to sleep among my subjects so I slept with the cactus, the windmills, the old signs that said Texas, ranch gates or whatever else I was looking for. I slept in the cab and sometimes during the night I'd turn on the light to put on paper a line for a poem or words for a song."

Rick has written books, songs, poetry, was a newspaper publisher in Commerce and a judge at the Miss Texas competition. He has made speeches before large audiences. I first met him years ago in Commerce where he had arranged the Bois d'Arc Festival. His home had layouts of different posters he was making. He sold them at Canton and other places around the state. Some of his posters were used to make bolts of material.

He is one creative individual with plenty of energy and a curious mind. When he sees a courthouse clock that doesn't work he wants to find out why it stopped. In one South Texas County he found out.

"They hanged a man and before he died he pointed at the clock and said the clock would never tell the right time from this point forward. And it broke when he died."

He spent six months photographing crosses in the United States. On the 500th anniversary of Columbus finding America he photographed every city in the country named Columbus. He did it on his own, no sponsors. He just wanted to do it. He did a few showings of his photos to different groups.

"I've done a lot of things. I saw this phrase written somewhere: a thousand words are worth a picture."

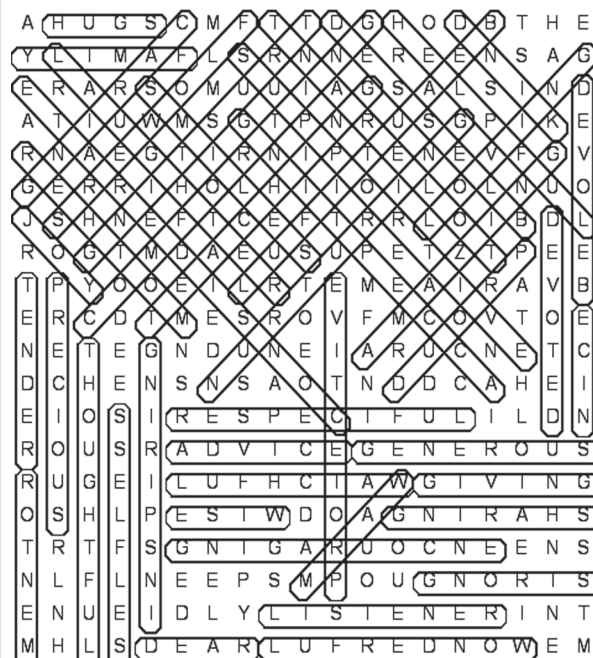

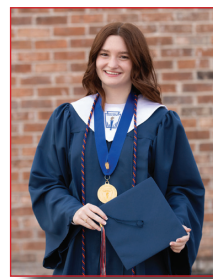

Patrick Swayze's Mother - Patsy Swayze

Yvonne Helen "Patsy" Swayze (February 7, 1927 – September 16, 2013) was an American film choreographer, dancer, and dance instructor, and the mother of actors Patrick Swayze and Don Swayze. Her credits include choreography for *Urban Cowboy*, *Liar's Moon* and *Hope Floats*. Swayze grew up in Houston, the daughter of Gladys Mae Karnes, a nurse, and Victor Elliott Karnes, a World War I pilot and geologist.

When she was 10 years old, Swayze was hit by a car and her mother enrolled her in dance classes for therapy. She eventually trained in both jazz and classical ballet.

While in high school, she met and married Jesse Wayne "Buddy" Swayze, a mechanical engineer. The couple had five children, including actors Patrick Swayze and Don Swayze. The family lived on Wakefield Street in the Garden Oaks neighborhood of Houston. They later moved to another home on Del Norte Street.

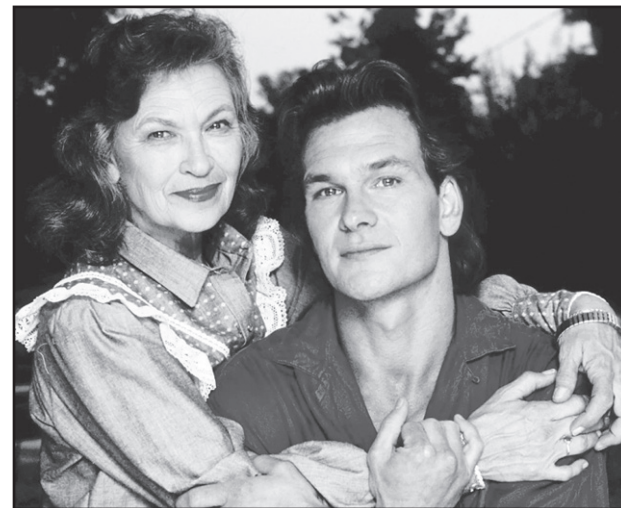
Career

In the 1960s, Swayze founded and directed both the Houston Jazz Ballet Company, and her own Houston dance studio, the Swayze School of Dance. All five of her children became dancers and actors, and Patsy's training has been credited for leading her son Patrick to his starring role in *Dirty Dancing* in 1987. Patrick met his future wife, film director and actress Lisa Niemi, while they were Patsy's students at the Swayze School of Dance. In addition to her own dance studio, for eighteen years Swayze taught dance and choreography at the University of Houston.[1] Her most famous students included future Emmy Award winner Debbie Allen, Randy Quaid, Jaclyn Smith and future ten-time Tony Award winner Tommy Tune.

Patsy Swayze transitioned to film by choreographing her first movie, *Urban Cowboy*, starring John Travolta and Debra Winger.[1] The success of *Urban Cowboy* essentially launched her career as a film choreographer.

In 1981, Patsy Swayze moved from Houston to southern California. She choreographed numerous films over the next three decades, including *Liar's Moon* in 1982 and *Hope Floats* in 1998. She teamed with her daughter-in-law Lisa Niemi to choreograph the 2003 film, *One Last Dance*, which starred Niemi, Patrick Swayze and George de la Peña.

She planned to retire from teaching and focus on film work, but instead opened a dance studio in a Simi Valley shopping center that operated for more than twenty years.

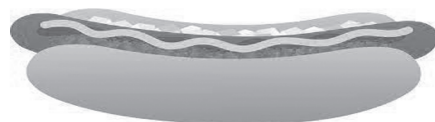

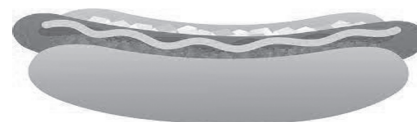
