**Enough about** 

birds. The days are short, and nights are often cold and long. Most insects are dead or dormant. Water can be hard to find, and food needed to provide the energy to keep birds warm might

limited natural evergreens or shelter, birds may seek manmade houses or habitats that can provide refuge from the winds, rains and ice of winter. By the way, did you know that adult birds do NOT sleep in their nests; unless they are incubating eggs or feeding young chicks. Birds roost in thick brush, wood piles, dense shrubs and some like evergreen trees. Walk near a

cedar or sweet olive or big gardenia at dusk; you may be

be scarce. Finding shelter may not be easy. If there are

startled by birds flying out to check on the commotion. Birds are warm-blooded. This means that they maintain their body temperature within a certain range even when the temperature around them changes. The maintenance of body temperature within a normal range depends on the amount of heat the bird produces. On cold, wintry days, most birds fluff up their feathers, creating air pockets, which help keep the birds warm. The more air spaces, the better the insulation. Some birds perch on one leg, drawing the other leg to the breast for warmth.

To keep up their high metabolic rate, most backyard birds eat rich, energy foods such as seeds, insects and suet. You can feed the birds at any time of year. A feeder simply attracts birds in close so that you can watch them. Birds get their food from a variety of sources and migrate on their own schedule, so your feeding doesn't have much impact.

The birds around our house are enjoying sunflower seeds, except for the bluebirds (yes we're partial), they get wax worms that we order on-line. They also enjoy a nice buffet of nandina and wild yaupon berries and seeds on the ornamental grasses. Our birds are currently loving the small fruit on our eleagnus (autumn olive).

According to those "in the know", wait until mid to late February to prune your roses. A Master Gardener friend said she follows the rule to "prune by Mardi Gras and have roses for Mother's Day". This sounds good to me; and easy to remember. This year Mardi Gras is February 9 which is real early, be sure to remember Mothers on

Soil pH should be tested at least every three years. Since winter is pretty slow for yard work, this might be a good time to start collecting soil samples from various spots around your lawn and gardens. Call the Extension office for information on the best way to label your samples and send them in for testing. If you do it now, there will be time to amend the soil as needed before you start planting for spring

If you plan to grow your own transplants from seed, now is the time to develop your schedule. We need to get started on this, my husband bought seeds of some heirloom vegetables to try this year. We haven't been very successful with seeds, but we keep trying.

Enjoy your slothful life while you can. Things are about to get very busy in the garden!

## National Wear Red Dress Day in Laurel

Mayor Johnny Magee signed a proclamation Tuesday morning, February 2, declaring Friday, February 5, as National Wear Red Dress Day in Laurel, and encouraged all citizens to educate themselves about the risk factors of heart disease in women, the seriousness of the impact of heart disease on women and their families, and the importance of women taking actions to protect their heart health.

Joining Mayor Magee for the proclamation signing were Faye Jackson, her mother, Mary F. Jones, and members of the Golden Star Chapter #26 of the Eastern Star, Bobbie Whitfield, Florence McCormick, Cynthia Arrington, Dariah Harrison, and Earline Hosey.

Jackson expressed the importance of women staying aware and paying attention to the risk factors of heart disease. "Know your numbers; heart rate, blood pressure, cholesterol, glucose, and weight," said Jackson. Her daughter, Kaila Porter, died in 2006, at the age of 23, as a result of heart disease, and her father is presently suffering from a condition associated with heart disease.

Red Dress Day is a program which was begun in 2001 when seventy leading experts in women's health sought to develop a national action plan to reduce the toll of heart disease on American

women. The first Friday in February of each year has been designated as Red Dress Day by The Heart Truth, which is the national campaign for awareness of women's heart health sponsored by the National Heart, Lung, and Blood Institute (NHL-BI), part of the National Institutes of Health, U.S.

Department of Health and Human Services (DHHS).

The proclamation states, "Heart disease is the number one killer

of women, causing one in every four deaths among women. Women's risk of heart disease begins to increase between ages forty and sixty. Women historically, have failed to make the connection between risk factors such as high blood pressure and high cholesterol, and their personal risk of developing heart disease. Research reveals that most wom-

en underestimate their personal risk and do not fully understand the devastating impact that heart disease has on one's life and family. Red Dress Day is de-

signed to get attention, to convey the seriousness of heart disease, and to change the perception that heart disease is only a man's issue." A luncheon will be held at the Eastern Star Golden Star Chapter #26, located on Buchannan Street, at noon on Friday.

February is American Heart Month, a campaign to bring awareness to women about the risk of heart disease. Friday, February 5, women attending the monthly South Central Regional Medical Center Speaking of Women program were encouraged to wear red for the "Go Red for Women" day in celebration of American Heart Month. SCRMC staff member Dr. David Sullivan, a cardiologist with Jefferson Medical Associates in Laurel, was the guest speaker.

"Why do women need to know about heart disease," asked Sullivan, "because, between the ages of 45 and 64, in this country, one in nine women will have some type of heart problem. After age 65, it goes to one in three. Generally speaking, on average, women are ten years older than men when they come down with their first heart problem."

"Heart disease is the number one killer of women. It is a surprise to most women that heart disease, and its brothers and sisters, like stroke and heart failure, kill more women than breast cancer, or in fact, all cancers."

Sullivan said heart disease can permanently damage the heart even without a failed event, such as a heart attack. It is for this reason that the American Heart Association, the National Heart, Lung, and Blood Institute (NHLBI), and physicians across the country have joined in the "Wear Red" campaign to bring awareness to women of the dangers and causes of heart disease.

"Most women underestimate their risk of heart disease," stressed Sullivan. "Heart disease is largely preventable. In our country, we are just starting to think about diet in its entirety as a risk factor. In the 80s and 90s, we heard saturated fats are bad. What did food manufactures do; they replaced the fats with sugar. That didn't really do us a whole lot of good. The three bad things in your diet are fats, sugar, and salt. So, you can't have a fat-free candy bar, which is loaded with sugar and sodium, and say you did something good for yourself."

There are two types of heart disease -

coronary heart disease (CHD), which affects the blood vessels of the heart, and coronary microvascular disease (MVD), which affects the tiny coronary arteries.

"Coronary artery disease leads to a heart attack, and occurs over a long period of time," said Sullivan. "By starting now to watch our diet and increase our exercise we can delay or prevent the occurrence of heart disease."

According to the NHLBI The Heart Truth literature, a healthy heart diet consist of "putting together an eating plan that offers the balance of calories that is right for you, including vegetables, fruits, whole grains, and low-fat or fat-free dairy products. The number of calories you need each day depends on your age and how physically active you are. Add seafood, lean meats, poultry, beans, eggs, and unsalted nuts for protein. Limit saturated and trans fats, sodium (salt), and added sugars. Grill, steam, or bake instead of frying, and flavor with spices, not sauces."

There are two types of risk factors associated with heart disease – those you can't change and those you can control. You can't change your family history of heart disease

or your age. What you can do something about is smoking, high blood pressure, high blood cholesterol, overweight and obesity, lack of physical activity, unhealthy diet, diabetes and prediabetes, and metabolic syndrome.

"There is zero acceptance of these risk factors," said Sullivan. Meaning having any one of these risk factors can lead to heart disease.

Other risk factors include sleep apnea, stress, depression, and excessive alcohol consumption.

"Controlling your numbers is the best way of preventing a heart attack," exclaimed Sullivan. "That is why you hear all of us preach and preach about getting those numbers down, and controlling those numbers."

According to the NHLBI The Heart Truth literature, a normal blood pressure is 120/80. Your are at risk of coronary heart disease if your total cholesterol level is greater than 200 mg/dL, LDL ("bad") cholesterol level is greater than 100 mg/dL, and HDL ("good") cholesterol is less than 50 mg/dL. You are also at risk if your triglyceride level is greater than 150 mg/dL.

"Another number you need to know is zero, for cigarettes," said Sullivan. He added that women, who smoke, lose their 10-year advantage over men in having heart problems show up, and are at the same risk as men. "Don't smoke. If you smoke, quit."

Sullivan said the signs and symptoms associated with having a heart attack include chest pain (squeezing and tightening in the chest), shortness of breath, nausea and vomiting, breaking out in a cold sweat, or light headiness, dizziness and passing out.

"The main number you need to know is 9-1-1," exclaimed Sullivan. "If you think you are having a heart attack call 911. Don't call your sister to come get you, and take you to the doctor's office, and don't try to drive yourself. Call 911."

Karen Vanderslice, SCRMC Community Education Coordinator and director of the Speaking of Women program said next month will be "Go Blue" month in recognition of Colon Cancer Awareness. Guest speaker for the March Speaking of Women, Friday, March 4, will be Dr. Stephen Johnson, gastroenterologist with Jefferson Medical Association.



## No. 23 tennis Bobcats excited about upcoming season

Mark Easley likes the squad he has assembled to comprise his 23rd-ranked 2016 Jones County Junior College men's tennis team.

"It's a good group of guys we have," said Easley, who is in his 16th season as head coach. "They all get along well together, they work hard and they are a pleasure to coach. Not only do we try to recruit good tennis players, but good kids, too. They like to be around one another and it's just one big family

"They can practice together, go out and eat together and hang out in the dorm together. Team camaraderie plays a big part in the success of a team."

The Bobcats return only two sopho-

mores from a squad that finished third in the MACJC/Region 23 Tournament and No. 20 in the final ITA rankings last year.

JCJC finished No. 22 in the NJCAA Division I Tournament in Plano, Texas. It was the fourth appearance in seven years in the national tournament for the Bobcats.

Back from last year are Josh Hester from Florence and Taylor Tamberg from South Jones.

Hester and Tamberg teamed to win a match in No. 3 doubles at nationals.

"Last year, they were our No. 6 and No. 7 players, but they have really improved a lot," Easley said. "Taylor and Josh have been through a season, so there is a world of difference in those guys from last year to this year."

Tamberg has show tremendous improvement since his freshman year.

"Taylor has really come on and picked up his game a lot," he said. "He's played a lot of tennis since last year and has gotten a lot better. He will be in the lineup and do well for us.

"It's a difference between night and day in the way Taylor is hitting the ball between last year and this year. He is a lot more confident and that comes from just being here for a year."

Hester was 11-2 in regular season singles play last

"Josh played No. 6 singles and No. 3 doubles last year," Easley said. "He had success last year and is just

so steady. He is a 4.0 student in engineering. He has to balance a busy schedule with his studies and practice, but he is able to do that. He is a top-notch guy and you know what you are getting with him.

"He is a great leader and he pushes the guys when it comes to conditioning."

International players are allowed again this season in the MACJC/Region 23 and the Bobcats will have two foreign students.

Taquel Lewis is from St. Lucia and Diego Leal arrived from Colombia during the Christmas holiday break.

Easley expects both of those players to do well.

"Taqel and Diego are very competitive players," he said. "They are very good players and will help us. They will be the No. 1 doubles team and will be the top two players in the singles lineup, depending on how they do head to head. They are really pushing each other and we are very fortunate to have those guys here."

Three players from the Jackson metro area will boost the Bobcats.

Chase Pennington is from Madison-Ridgeland Academy, Luke Armstrong is from Hartfield Academy in Flowood and Blake Taylor is from Northwest Rankin.

"Chase has a great mind for the game," Easley said. "His father is a tennis coach and he's been playing a lot of sports growing up. But now he's devoting all of his time to tennis and he knows what he wants to do on the court. He is a quality student and person.

"Luke was mainly a doubles player in high school and knows the doubles game well. As of now, he and Chase seem to be pairing together well in doubles. Luke works hard and makes adjustments during the match. He finds a way to give himself a chance to win.

"Blake has great strokes. The biggest thing he needs to overcome is the confidence factor in not getting down when he makes mistakes. He is a lefthander and strokes the ball well."

Three local players round out the roster. John Leggett is from Laurel Christian

Easley is pleased with what that trio brings to the court.

"We knew John was a good player and he has gotten better in the semester that he has been here," he said. "Brandon and Peyton have really come a long way in the fall. Hitting every day against competitive players has really raised their game.

"John is a good singles players and has good strokes. Again, he has to stay positive throughout a match. He just has to learn to move on from point to point. But he is going to get there and he is a real solid player for us."

The Bobcats have 10 players on the roster battling for playing spots in singles and doubles.

Easley said practice and early season matches would determine the lineup heading into MACJC/Region 23 play.

"All of the players are fighting for positions," he said. "It's very competitive and that's good. We are using drills, practices and head to head matches to see how where we stand."

In MACJC/Region 23 play, Easley believes it will be another competitive season.

"Meridian has a singles guy from New Zealand who, from all reports, is out of this world," he said. "Gulf Coast will be strong. We played them in the fall and they are very solid. They have their No.'s 1 and 3 players returning. Itawamba is always good, Co-Lin has a number of players back and Hinds is

"It's a well-balanced league. It should be an interesting year and a great tournament at the end of the season."

Mississippi Gulf Coast will host the MACJC/Region 23 Tournament April 20-23. The top three teams from there will advance to the NCJAA Division I National Tournament May 16-20 in Plano, Texas.

JCJC's first home match will be at 2 p.m on Feb. 18 vs. Hinds.
