Celebrating National Red Ribbon Week

In celebration of National Red Ribbon Week the Jones County Sheriff's Department and Dying to Live Ministries have teamed up to bring drug awareness to the youth of Jones County by visiting with high school and elementary school students across the county in assemblies and pep ral-

Wednesday afternoon, October 21, they led an assembly for 8th and 9th grade students at South Jones High School.

"This is the beginning of National Red Ribbon Week," said Lt. Robert Little, Narcotics Supervisor with the Jones County Sheriff's Department. "Red Ribbon Week is Drug Awareness Week that started in 1985 as a tribute to DEA agent Kiki (Enrique) Camarena, who was killed in Mexico by a drug cartel. He was tortured for two days. They had a doctor with him to make sure he didn't die while they tortured him. He was eventually killed."

Major Jamie Tedford, JCSD Chief of Operations, added that Camerena's pilot, Captain Alfredo Zavala-Avelar, was also taken the same day and tortured to death. "They found their bodies a month later," said Ted-

"It was during the time of the war on drugs when Reagan was President. That cartel was eventually dismantled because of what happened to Camareno," said Little. Tedford added that then First Lady Nancy Reagan was very active in the Red Ribbon Campaign as was President Reagan. In 1988, Red Ribbon Week was recognized nationally with the Reagans serving as the

Honorary Chairs.

Jade Patrick, Director of Dying To Live's Z.A.C. House, a recovery center for women, said, "We talk to the students about the destructive phases of drug addiction - how it starts and how it ends. We do this because kids at this age are faced with so much

temptation. They don't understand that the choices they make, right now, are going to affect where they are 18, 20, or even 40 years from now. We give testimony of our own lives, and how we got caught in addiction. With Dying to Live being a very predominate drug and alcohol recovery ministry in our community, we want to make a mark in the community and let people know that there is hope for people caught in addiction, and that no drug addict is hopeless."

The students heard from Kim, who, with her husband, ministers to the youth at Christ's Church, and LA Will, a Christian Rap artist from south Louisiana. Both grew up in very different environments, and found themselves entangled in the world of drug addiction. Each shared their story with the students.

Kim said she was one of those kids who people would say would never do drugs, but she got caught up in the drug addiction world after first trying marijuana at a party

JCJC's Bobcat Math League's post season play-offs feature familiar faces

The Warriors of Oak Grove High School are leading the pack of 26 high school math teams to the post season play-offs in Jones County Junior College's Bobcat Math League. The consistent and continual domination in the Fibonacci Division by Oak Grove places the Warriors as division and play-off leaders. In the final week of competition, the Warriors hammered Richton Rebels to a 126 to 24 win, giving the Warriors a total of 595 points for the season. Oak Grove also maintained its 50-plus point lead against its nearest competitors.

In individual scoring accuracy accomplishments, four of the Warriors have been named to the All-League Team: Allen Huang, Ruby Liang, Peter Liang and Marli Bryant. Sacred Heart High School's Matthew Gallardo earned the overall title of Most Outstanding Player for the season. He has been the top player every week except for one, when Huang beat him by three points. Stringer's Key'Shawn Kennedy and Jackson Dale are also All-League Team members. Presbyterian Christian High School's Alicia Brown was the only PCS Bobcat to earn a spot on the All-League Team.

Post-season competition with the final play-offs and regular season team honors and recognitions will be held on Wednesday, November 4, in the Fine Arts Auditorium of JCJC. Division leaders headed to the play-offs are ranked in order: Oak Grove, Presbyterian Christian High School, Stringer Attendance Center, Northeast Jones High School and Sacred Heart. Teams earning a wildcard spot are: Taylorsville, Lawrence County and Columbia Academy.

In its final match-up this week, Heidelberg High School managed to upset the Wayne County War Eagles record and ended any hopes at post season play. The Oilers beat the War Eagles in a close match, 28 to 25. West Jones lost to Sacred Heart, 22 to 85, which also ended any possibility of a wildcard invitation for the Mustangs. Wayne Academy took a tough blow from the Seminary Bulldogs in a squeaker. The Jaguars lost 23 to 26.

In the Euclid Division, Stringer keeps its title as Division Leader blowing out the Laurel Tornadoes, 105 to 14. The Red Devils tallied up 518 points on the season to place them in third place overall. Lawrence County's Cougars pounced on the Bay Springs Bulldogs, ending the season with a 63-14 win and a seventh seed in the play-

Newton division leader, Presbyterian Christian gained a total of 542 points on the season. The 95-point-margin thrashing it imposed on the South Jones Braves helped PCS hold on to their second seed ranking. The Bobcats beat the Braves, 120 to 25. The Taylorsville Tartars', 60 to 37 victory over the Enterprise Bulldogs ensured post season play for Taylorsville, while also keeping South Jones and Enterprise out of contention for a wildcard spot. The Raleigh Lions outsmarted the Quitman Panthers with its mauling of Quitman, 42-

Northeast Jones maintains the leader position in the Pythagoras division and earns the fourth place seed overall, despite the Tiger's tie with Columbia Academy 52-52. The Cougars will get another chance at the Tigers in post season action since they managed to earn a wildcard berth. Mt. Olive got the victory in its match with Seminary, 22 to 12. Since Collins held on to win against Perry Central, 20 to 19, it forced the Bulldogs to drop from its second place in the Fibonacci division, allowing Greene County to move up. The Wildcats of Greene County celebrated a victory against Heidelberg Academy's Rebels by shutting them out, 23 to 0.


