During his sterling career in the Army, he advanced to Chief Warrant Officer (CW5) and Master Aviator, qualifying for several aircraft including the Blackhawk and Apache helicopters, and Mohawk fixed wing airplane. He participated in Operation Iraqi Freedom and as the flight operations officer for the 82nd Cavalry Airborne, he also served in Operation Enduring Freedom in Afghanistan. His experience and expertise led him to becoming the first warrant officer to be certified as a Mishap Investigation Board President. After more than 36 years of active duty service, Jon was selected to serve as the Program Manager for Aviation Mishap Prevention at the Combat Readiness Center as a Department of the Army Civilian, serving in this position for over 10 years. With more than 47 years of service in peacetime and in combat, Jon was awarded the Gold Order of Saint Michael.

Jon's dedication to duty, competence and leadership has touched countless lives in Army Aviation. The Army was Jon's life. He was a faithful soldier of God and a rock for his family. His parents preceded Jon in death, as did his brother Steve Daly, other extended family and too many friends and





Iowa State University Extension and Outreach is cohosting educational hands-on Pasture Walks in O'Brien and Monona counties on June 22 and June 26, respectively. Both walks will begin at 5:30pm with supper, followed by the program from 6:00 to 8:45pm.

After three years of drought, Iowa pastures are in need of some first aid, according to Beth Doran, beef specialist with Iowa State University Extension and Outreach. "Livestock producers can't change the weather, but we can enhance

forage recovery, control weeds, and improve soil fertility," Doran said. "So put on your walking shoes, come with your own questions, and attend a Pasture Walk with us. During the evening workshops, participants will condition score a paddock

There will be hands-on identification of desirable plants and weeds, evaluation of soil cover, and monitoring of grazing severity. Two topics (pasture supplementation and common forage insects) will vary by site.

10:30am. Enjoy coffee & conversation with like-minded individuals in a beautiful setting - the Maser Monarch Lodge. This is a free adult program offered through the Dickinson County Conservation Board.

In June we will learn about Blanding's turtle research from Drew Howing, a professor in Environmental Studies at Iowa

Lakes Community College. He has researched and developed a successful survey protocol for detecting Blanding's turtles in northwest Iowa.

Blanding's turtles are found throughout the Midwest. Depending on the state they can be listed as threatened or endangered. Blanding's turtles can range from five to 10 1/4 inches long. It has a hinge on the plastron (lower shell), allowing the shell to be closed partially. Its bright yellow chin and throat are distinctive. They can be found in wetland areas.

Community Relations Coordinator Jackie Jerge said," I am excited to hear about the latest research findings on these unique reptiles"!

Kenue Coffee Hour is a free adult program held on the first Thursday of the month. The program starts at 10:30am and typically runs for an hour and a light beverage bar is served. Looking for outdoor adventure? Look no further than kayaking! This summer, the Introduction to Kayaking program is

perfect for beginners and those looking to improve their skills. The program will run on June 13th, June 20th, and July 18th, with two sessions available each day. Each class will have a maximum of four students, ensur-



ing ample individual instruction.

Mark Foss, an ACA Certified Instructor, will teach a series of strokes, maneuvers, and kayaking safety to help participants become more efficient and safer paddlers. All classes will be conducted in a safe learning environment, with weather conditions carefully monitored to choose the best location for each day's class.

The Level I class is for adults aged 18 years and older, with a fee of \$40 per person. Participants must register and pay the fee at dickinsoncountynaturecenter.com and sign a liability waiver prior to participating in the class. The instructor will provide safe 12 ft. recreational kayaks and paddles, but students may bring their own kayaks, which must be 10 ft. in length or longer.







ATTENTION RESIDENTS & VISITORS OF ARNOLDS PARK

On November 9, 2022, the Arnolds Park City Council passed an Ordinance that requires all golf carts operated within the City of Arnolds Park to be registered with the City. Permits will be issued through the Arnolds Park City Hall.

Applications will be available beginning January 3, 2023 for permits valid for the calendar years of 2023 and 2024. Owners information, address, and proof of insurance will be required on each application. Permits are \$50 per golf cart and are good for up to two years, with the expiration date of December 31 of evenly numbered calendar years. There will be no proration or refund of the registration fee.

A registration sticker will be issued for each application/permit. The sticker shall be placed on the front of the golf cart near the driver's side and visible to oncoming traffic. Each sticker is specific to the golf cart registered and is non-transferable. If a new golf cart is purchased after the permit is issued, a new application must be completed, the \$50 fee paid for the new cart, and a new sticker will be issued.

All golf carts that operate within the City limits of Arnolds Park must have a valid City of Arnolds Park issued golf cart permit. This applies to all residents and visitors alike whether you are here for a day, a weekend, a month, the summer, or year-round. Permits issued by other cities are not recognized by the City of Arnolds Park.

The Arnolds Park Police Department will be strictly enforcing the new ordinance. Failure to follow the rules as outlined by the new ordinance will result in the issuance of a municipal infraction of not less than \$100 per violation.

The operation of a golf cart within the City of Arnolds Park requires the driver to possess a valid driver's license and to be at least 16 years of age. Operation of golf carts by an underage person within the City of Arnolds Park may result in the issuance of a Uniform Citation under Iowa Code 321.219 issued to the parent/guardian for allowing an unauthorized minor to drive.

Please also be aware you must follow all State Laws and City Ordinances when operating a golf cart and park within the designated parking locations in the City of Arnolds Park. Golf carts cannot be operated on U.S. Hwy. 71, bike trails, or sidewalks. You may cross the highway at a 90-degree angle, preferably at a location where there is a stoplight.
