BORDERLINE: A STORY OF COURAGE

Tumbleweed Smith

Jayson Woodward was postmaster in Terlingua at a time when people didn't bother locking their doors because everybody knew everybody in the small community. She lived next door to the post office. One afternoon when she returned home from a shopping trip an intruder was in her house. He captured her, took her outside, tied her hands and blindfolded her and held her captive for fourteen hours. She was tortured and criminally assaulted. Even though she says it was a very horrible experience, she was incredibly calm during the episode. Toward the end of the ordeal the man told her he had to be in Mexico by sunrise, just a few hours away and had no transportation.

"When I realized that, I told him that was no problem, that I had a truck and could take him. The main thing was to get out of the desert, get back to my house, then get in my truck. Those were the steps for my escape."

They got in the truck. Jayson was driving and looked down to see the man holding a knife by his side. She headed the pickup north toward a store owned by a friend of hers who lived in a trailer behind the building. She was not going toward Mexico.

"When he realized we were going in the wrong direction, he started screaming and yelling 'this is not right, turn around, turn around now.' I did turn around in the parking lot of the store where there were some gas tanks. I hit the accelerator, aimed for the gas tanks and jumped out of my truck. The last thing I saw was him lunging for the steering wheel of the truck. I ran to the trailer behind the store banged on the door and practically ripped it off getting inside. My screaming and yelling get your gun, get your gun woke him up. It was about four o'clock in the morning by now. He saw that I was hysterical and took me to the deputy sheriff's house."

The man missed the gas tanks and drove to Ojinaga across the border. Law enforcement had been alerted and he was found and jailed in Ojinaga. Efforts to get the man back to this country for trial were futile because Mexico was reluctant to release him. News media picked up the story and it was on international radio, television and newspapers.

"Three men from Texas broke into the Ojinaga jail, kidnapped the man and brought him back to Texas. That made a bigger story and Mexico stepped up efforts to get him back. But our sheriff, George Jones, said 'we don't know how he got here and we don't care. He's here and he's going to trial.'

"We had a trial in San Angelo in 1986. He was found guilty and given 75 years in prison. He's still in prison today."

Jayson lives in Alpine today and has written about the experience in a book titled Borderline. She also has a six-episode podcast.

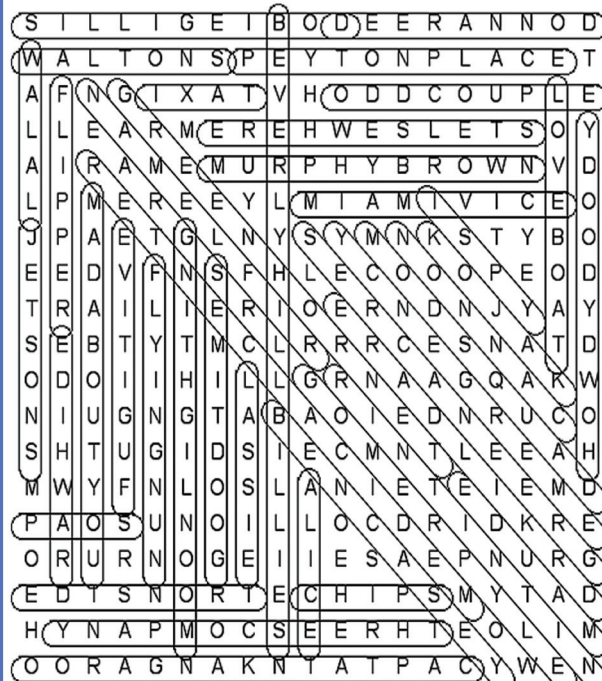

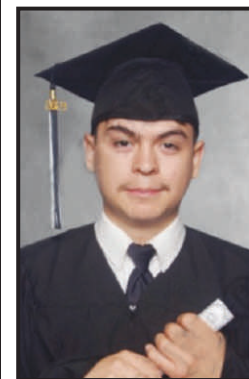
